#### CHESS GRANDMASTER DUO R PRAGGNANANDHAA & R VAISHALI

# Vaishali is more aggressive on the board, says brother Pragg

To truly realise the popularity of R Praggnanandhaa and R Vaishali, one may need to visit a chess tournament outside the country. The siblings chuckle as they recollect instances of fans bringing them home-cooked Indian meals as they compete in faraway lands.

In a freewheeling interview with Amit Kamath in Stavanger, where they're competing at the Norway Chess tournament, India's only brother-sister Grandmaster duo opens up on what they appreciate about their sibling, pick out moments from their careers that instilled self-belief in them, and reveal who wins a majority of their private chess games at home. Excerpts:

What is the one quality of your sibling that you really admire and wish you had when it comes to chess?

**Praggnanandhaa:** Maybe being more aggressive over the board, trying to checkmate often.

**Vaishali:** His positional play, his patience, how he gets over his losses during tournaments. He takes everything the same way, wins or losses, that's something I admire...He's really passionate about his chess. Watching him closely, he's thinking about the game almost all the time. I get tired and at some point stop looking at chess, but he keeps on going.

And it takes you longer to get over your losses?

**Vaishali:** Yes. I am definitely getting better in this aspect, as happened at the Candidates also. But it definitely takes longer for me than he needs to recover.

So what's your secret of getting over a defeat so quickly, Pragg?

Praggnanandhaa: Obviously, it's tough. But as a chess player, I've been doing this for the last 13 years or something. I think I'll continue doing this. So it doesn't make too much sense to be very upset for each

and every loss. It's going to come often, so it's not something that you should be upset about.

And what's the one quality you admire about each other away from the chess board?

**Praggnanandhaa:** I'm a bit of a messy guy. And she's more organised. My mother would tell you the same.

Vaishali: He's just very

easy-going. Very fun. It's easy

to approach him and have a conversation with him. That's something I appreciate about him.

At tournaments like Norway Chess, how much of your day involves chess preparation? **Praggnanandhaa:** On rest days

during tournaments, it's more chill. We do look at chess, but it's not the main thing. But on match days, we do prepare seriously. At Norway Chess, we get more time because the games start at 5 pm. At other times, games start at 2 or 3, so it is different at each tournament. Depends on how much time you get in the morning. I try to look at what my opponent does and

be ready for that.

When we asked Magnus (Carlsen) if there was a particular Indian player he likes playing against, he named you stating that you guys have had great duels. Do you enjoy facing Magnus, or does he feel like a tricky opponent to have across the board?

**Praggnanandhaa:** I always enjoy playing against Magnus, as I enjoy playing against top players in general. The games are very exciting. It's a challenge any time I play any top player. With Magnus, as he said, the games are very exciting. That's one

thing to look forward to whenever I am playing.

Vaishali, world champion Ju Wenjun recently said you are one of the most creative players at the Candidates this year. Where does that onthe-board aggression and creativity come from?

**Vaishali:** It's good to know that she mentioned this. I don't know, maybe the way I trained in my earlier days. When I started, this was the way my trainers influenced me.

Your longtime coach RB Ramesh talks about training drills you would do where you had a chess board in front of you, but you would not move the pieces at all, instead you would call out moves. How much did those drills help your visualisation skills? Praggnanandhaa: It is impor-

tant. We would make a position on the board and then start calculating from there. And we would be past move 15 but would still have the same position on the board. We had to then visualise in our mind. It was not just about visualisation but also about finding good moves there. That helps obviously when we're playing some complicated game trying to calculate ahead.

there are usually plenty of fans turning up. We saw that one fan brought home-made food for Vidit Gujrathi at the Candidates. What's the sweetest or craziest thing some fan has done for you? And how used to it are you to this attention in every country you go to? **Praggnanandhaa:** That (Indian

fans bringing them home-cooked food when they're playing in foreign countries) has happened many times.

**Vaishali:** Out of love, fans do whatever they can to support us. It feels really good when our people come around to cheer for us.



# सभी नर्सिंग होम के पंजीकरण की होगी एसीबी जांच पानी के अधिक इस्तेमाल पर हो सकता है चालान

नई दिल्ली, 28 मई (भाषा)।

दिल्ली की जल मंत्री आतिशी ने मंगलवार को आरोप लगाया कि हरियाणा एक मई से दिल्ली के हिस्से का पानी नहीं दे रहा है। उन्होंने कहा कि इसके चलते दिल्ली सरकार राष्ट्रीय राजधानी में पानी की आपूर्ति को तर्कसंगत बनाने सिहत कई उपाय लाग् करेगी। आतिशी ने संवाददाता सम्मेलन में लोगों से पानी का विवेकपूर्ण उपयोग करने की अपील की। मंत्री ने यह भी चैतावनी दी कि अगर लोगों ने इस अपील पर ध्यान नहीं दिया, तो आने वाले दिनों में सरकार को पानी के अधिक इस्तेमाल पर चालान काटना पड़ सकता है। उन्होंने कहा कि दिल्ली सरकार इस मुद्दे पर लगातार हरियाणा से बात कर रही है और अगर अगले कुछ दिनों में इसका समाधान नहीं निकला, तो वह इस मामले को लेकर उच्चतम न्यायालय का दरवाजा खटखटा सकती है।

आतिशी ने कहा कि हरियाणा ने दिल्ली के हिस्से का पानी छोड़ना बंद कर दिया है। एक मई को वजीराबाद में जल स्तर 674.5 फुट था। यह औसत स्तर है, जिसे बनाए रखा जाना चाहिए। पिछले साल



अप्रैल, मई और जून में न्यूनतम स्तर 674.5 बनाए रखा गया था। आंकड़े साझा करते हुए मंत्री ने कहा कि आठ मई तक वजीराबाद में जल स्तर 672 फुट रह गया और 20 मई तक यह 671 फुट था तथा मंगलवार को यह और घटकर 669.8 फुट रह गया। उन्होंने कहा कि जो बोरवेल पहले छह से सात घंटे काम करते थे, वे 14 घंटे तक काम कर रहे हैं। हमने पानी के टैंकरों की संख्या भी बढ़ा दी है। आज से, हम उन क्षेत्रों में पानी की आपूर्ति कम कर रहे हैं, जहां इसकी आपूर्ति दिन में दो बार की जाती है, वहां अब यह दिन में एक बार की जाएगी। जल संकट से जूझ रहे क्षेत्रों में तर्कसंगत तरीके से पानी की आपूर्ति की जाएगी।

दिल्ली के उपराज्यपाल वीके सक्सेना ने राष्ट्रीय राजधानी में निजी नर्सिंग होम के पंजीकरण और नियामक प्रबंधन की भ्रष्टाचार

निरोधक शाखा (एसीबी) से जांच कराने का आदेश दिया है। राजनिवास के अधिकारियों ने मंगलवार को यह जानकारी दी।

पूर्वी दिल्ली के विवेक विहार के एक अस्पताल में आग लगने से छह नवजात शिशुओं की मौत के बाद यह आदेश दिया गया है। निजी अस्पताल में आग लगने की घटना के संदर्भ में मुख्य सचिव को लिखे अपने पत्र में सक्सेना ने कहा कि मैंने इस मामले में बहुत सख्त रुख अपनाया है। व्यापक जनहित को देखते हुए और अधिकारियों के एक वर्ग द्वारा गंभीरता की कमी के कारण मुझे कदम उठाने के लिए

मजबूर होना पड़ा है। नोट में कहा गया कि आग लगने और नर्सिंग होम से संबंधित मामले में... एसीबी को शहर में नर्सिंग होम के पंजीकरण की व्यापक जांच करने का निर्देश दिया गया है. ताकि यह आकलन किया जा सके कि कितने नर्सिंग होम वैध पंजीकरण के बिना काम कर रहे हैं

#### क्या निरीक्षण के बाद हुआ नवीनीकरण, इसकी भी होगी जांच

पत्र के मुताबिक, जांच में यह भी पता लगाया जाएगा कि क्या स्वास्थ्य विभाग द्वारा पंजीकरण की मंजूरी या उसका नवीनीकरण 100 फीसद स्थल निरीक्षण के बाद किया गया है। सक्सेना ने पत्र में कहा कि 1,190 नर्सिंग होम हैं, जिनमें से एक चौथाई से अधिक बिना वैध पंजीकरण के चल रहे हैं। दिल्ली पुलिस द्वारा दर्ज प्राथमिकी के मुताबिक, विवेक विहार इलाके में एक शिशु अस्पताल में आग लगने से पांच ऑक्सीजन सिलेंडर फट गए थे। यह अस्पताल बिना लाइसेंस और दमकल विभाग के अनापत्ति पत्र के बिना संचालित किया जा रहा था। इस घटना में छह नवजातों की मौत हो गई थी।

और क्या जिनके पास वैध पंजीकरण है वे दिल्ली नर्सिंग होम पंजीकरण अधिनियम, 1953 के तहत निर्धारित मानदंडों का अनुपालन कर रहे हैं या नहीं।

दिल्ली पुलिस विवेक विहार के बच्चे के एक अस्पताल में लगी आग के सिलसिले में उसके मालिक डा नवीन किची और डा आकाश के काल रिकार्ड की जांच करेगी। किची की पत्नी से पूछताछ होगी, जो हादसे के समय ड्यूटी पर मौजूद थीं। इस हादसे में सात नवजात बच्चों की मौत हो गई थी। पुलिस अधिकारी ने बताया कि हम डीजीएचएस अधिकारियों से भी पृछताछ

करेंगे जिनके न्यायाधिकार क्षेत्र में यह

अस्पताल आता है। उन्होंने कहा कि अस्पताल में कई सुरक्षा मानकों की अनदेखी होने की बात सामने आ रही है। जांचकर्ता पहले ही आरोपियों के मोबाइल फोन जब्त कर चुके हैं। जांच से जुड़े पुलिस अधिकारी के मुताबिक जांच के तहत हमने उनके मोबाइल फोन जब्त कर लिए हैं ताकि उनके बीच हुई बातचीत और मैसेज की जानकारी प्राप्त की जा सके। उन्होंने कहा कि अगर जरूरत पड़ी तो अन्य कर्मचारियों के मोबाइल फोन की भी जांच की जाएगी। इस बीच, दिल्ली पुलिस ने डा किची की पत्नी जागृति को समन जारी किया है।
