How Ukraine's Kursk incursion is a bold Queen's Gambit

Ukraine's incursion into Russia's Kursk region is nothing short of a bold Queen's Gambit. The strategic move has started many observers, flipping the board on Moscow, which has long believed it held the initiative. By striking deep into Russian territory, Kyiv has demonstrated not only its audacity but also its capability to extend the war beyond the contested frontlines in Donetsk and Luhansk. However, like any gambit, this carries promise and peril. The assault on Kursk caught the Kremlin off guard, delivering a psychological blow to Russia's carefully cultivated narrative of invulnerability. The penetration into one of Russia's key military districts with significant gas reserves signals that Ukraine is far from the defensive. The attack reaped immediate, if symbolic, gains—a breach in Russia's heartland, undermining the myth of its impregnable defences, and a jolt to the Kremlin's confidence. Yet, these gains may be fleeting, as Ukraine's long-term success hinges on far more than just a momentary disruption. In response, Russia finds itself increasingly cornered, running out of the proverbial red lines it has so often drawn to deter further escalation. Each new Ukrainian advance erodes Moscow's strategic posture, pushing the Kremlin closer to a point where its threats of severe retaliation might either ring hollow or, worse, necessitate a dangerous escalation. This is a troubling prospect, not only for Ukraine but for the broader international community, as the unpredictability of an increasingly desperate Russia grows. Yet, the real battleground remains in Donetsk, where the Ukrainian forces are engaged in a gruelling, attritional fight—a "do or die" struggle that will determine the fate of Kyiv's war effort. While the audacious strike into Kursk has gained headlines, the hard reality is that Ukraine's resources are stretched thin. The recent losses of vital military assets, including Centurion tanks and HIMARS systems, have taken a toll on Ukraine's ability to sustain its offensive in the east. The Kursk operation, though symbolically powerful, may have diverted critical resources from where they are needed most. The chessboard in Ukraine is cluttered with debris of conflict, and the players are showing signs of strain. Zelensky's government, emboldened by this daring foray, must now reckon with the strategic implications. Putin's carefully orchestrated image of strength and control has been pierced. But in this dangerous game, a gambit is only as good as its follow-up.

WHERE ARE FOOTPATHS?

Pedestrians are forced to share the roads with speeding vehicles. No doubt, the authorities are forced to reduce the space for footpaths as the vehicular traffic has also increased. But, There are no footpaths despite the area being the hub of the city due to its location. A person has to walk on the sides of a road and when two or three vehicles from the opposite directions come it is quite difficult for a pedestrian to give way to the vehicles. Is this not a strange situation in Indian towns and cities? All over the city, builders are too converting footpaths into parking places or approach roads for their buildings. Cities have no systematised footpaths for easy flow of pedestrians. One may walk along one footpath in an area, which simply vanishes at the next turn. City's biggest affliction is that footpaths are encroached on by shops, STD booths, bus-stops, garbage dumps, you name it, they have. Most of the city bus shelters in Indian cities are on footpaths. Most of them even use it as a permanent address for

business by placing mobile tiffin centers, chat-banders, pan shops, puncture repairing shops, etc. For old people it becomes very difficult and unsafe if they have to walk on the road as footpaths hardly exist. It does not matter, if only a few people per day take it but the footpath is an entitlement of all citizens. They have to be kept clean, stumble-free and devoid of any obstructions. Residents living in the cities says that the footpath is direly needed. With no walkways, pedestrians end up walking on drain covers, which are dangerously uneven. It's just that, the footpaths are less for man and more for manholes. They become the street dwellers' accommodation, the street vendors' outlet, the public garbage dumping ground and a lot more except a pedestrian's freeway. Pedestrian footpaths in most parts of the city are under illegal occupation by shopkeepers and vendors or are used as parking area for vehicles by people visiting commercial establishments. Corporation officials says that encroachment eviction drives

are held periodically but encroachers return quickly. Why? One of the main reasons for pedestrian casualties is encroachment of footpaths by not only commercial establishments and hawkers, but also by motorists. There are incidents that two wheelers ride on footpath during peak traffic on roads and most of the two wheelers who drive on footpath sound horn on pedestrians who walks on pavement. Pedestrians are losing space on roads and on-street parking often takes precedent over pedestrian infrastructure like paved sidewalks. Absence of adequate numbers of public toilets facilities in Indian cities is also creating public urinal problems. Pedestrians have no choice but to walk on the road, thereby disrupting traffic flow. If we look at the percentage of fatalities in accidents, pedestrians come first, followed by two-wheeler riders. On the road, the right of the pedestrian should come first. Commuters' timetable disrupted due to heavy rain

Vadodara, The state has been receiving heavy to very heavy rains for the past three days. Public transport across the state has been severely affected when flood conditions have arisen, especially in Vadodara city and district. While as many as 22 trains bound for Vadodara, Anand, Mumbai and Bhuj were canceled yesterday, more trains were canceled due to excessive waterlogging on Itola Bridge No-561 and Dwarka-Gorinji section of Vadodara division. Gujarat Express from Mumbai Central to Ahmedabad on August 29, Saurashtra Express from Dadar to Porbandar on August 30 has been cancelled.

More trains canceled due to red alert

More than 20 trains were canceled yesterday due to heavy rain while some trains were diverted on other routes. More trains were canceled today due to red alert while Bhuj-Gandhinagar Capital, Dadar Bhuj Express and other trains bound for Bhuj were also canceled due to waterlogging in Malia Miana section of Bhuj due to heavy rain. After 48 hours, Gujarat will get relief from extremely heavy rains. According to the forecast of the Meteorological Department, the threat of rain disaster over Gujarat has reduced as the deep depression moves towards Pakistan. A red alert has been declared in the districts of Central Gujarat and South Gujarat amid the possibility of heavy rains during the night and very heavy rains in Saurashtra-Kutch. So, the minimum temperature will drop across the state including Ahmedabad during the night as well, due to which cold weather is spreading. Now in 36 to 48 hours the deep depression will weaken and move towards Pakistan and transform into a cyclonic circulation so that after 48 hours, Gujarat will get relief from very heavy rains and the skies of the state will again be clear of rain clouds. out of total 14512 routes, 1104 routes and 4029 trips out of 40515 trips are closed. Also 203 routes and 363 trips are operational. Mainly Vadodara, Bhuj, Godhra, Dahod, Mahisagar, Anand, Kheda, Junagadh, Porbandar, Dwarka, Rajkot, Morbi, Surendranagar, Ahmedabad districts have been mostly affected due to rain. Apart from this, in all other districts, there has been general disruption of operations. All closed operations of Vadodara, Padra, Kheda depots of

Sky views of state's third Kadana Dam in Mahisagar district

Water is being released by the dam administration to maintain the rule level of the dam. Then the delightful views of the opened gate of Kadana Dam came into view. The aerial view of the water falling from the Kadana Dam into the Mahisagar River from the drone camera is mind-blowing.

Mahisagar river to maintain the rule level of the dam. In which 20 thousand cusecs of water is being released into the river through the power house. In which 4 turbines are working to generate electricity. On the other hand, by opening 6 gates of the dam up to 1 foot, 10 thousand cusecs of water is being released into the Mahi river. Along with this, the current level of the dam is 415 feet.

While the total level of the dam is 419 feet. Water from Kadana Dam supplies water to 8 districts of the state, so this dam is considered very important for the state.
