# 'Light-touch registration soon for FPIs investing in govt bonds'

**PRECISION BOOST.** Trade settlement errors reduced with the T+1 cycle: SEBI official

Error rates on the settlement of trades for foreign portfolio investors (FPIs) have reduced under the T+1 settlement cycle from the T+2 cycle, a top regulatory official said on Tuesday.

gistration process will be introduced for FPIs that only want to invest in government bonds," he said.

**FPI TRANSITION**  
Narayan said that earlier if an FPI licence expired, the FPI would stay in limbo forever and could not buy or sell anything.

"We have now allowed a one-time exercise for liquidating the portfolio and ensuring a smooth transition out of the country," he said.

Existing FPIs setting up a new FPI do not have to fill a new common application form all over again. Instead, some fields will be automatically repopulated based on available data.

"We have set aggressive timelines to do the registrations," said Narayan.

"Such delays were causing a huge amount of opportunity loss to FPIs. Consequently, custodians engaged the float income for an extra day, resulting in opaque, implicit charges stemming from the inefficiencies in the system. The less of implicit charges we have, the better it is for everyone," said Narayan.

**EASED REGULATIONS**  
The regulator is trying to make life easier for certain categories of FPIs, including insurance or pension funds and sovereign wealth funds.

"This could be achieved by allowing them to use the FPI license to invest in assets other than equities, reducing the KYC periodicity for such funds and doing away with wet signatures," Narayan said.

It reflects our growing confidence in the financial system and its regulatory underpinnings, improving financial literacy levels, and broader investment opportunities," Mohanty said during the session.

**AU SFB seeks RBI nod for transition to universal bank**

AU Small Finance Bank on Tuesday submitted an application to the Reserve Bank of India to seek approval for transition from a Small Finance Bank (SFB) to a universal bank.

"This application comes in the backdrop of Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman's announcement that Small Finance Bank amalgamating with and into AU SFB with effect from April 1, 2024, marking the first such consolidation in the SFB space."

"This strategic evolution will pave the way for our future growth, enhance our brand presence, reduce regulatory constraints, and improve operational efficiencies," said Sanjay Agarwal, Founder, MD & CEO of AU SFB.

In April 2024, the RBI issued a circular allowing the voluntary transition of Small Finance Bank to Universal Bank and AU SFB is the first bank to seek regulatory approval for the transition.

To qualify, as per the RBI guidelines, SFBs need a five-year track record, strong financials, and a stock exchange listing among various other parameters.

As of June, AU SFB's deposits and advances stood at ₹72,290 crore and ₹99,792 crore, respectively. The net profit at ₹503 crore in Q1FY25 grew 30 per cent y-o-y compared to ₹387 crore in Q1FY24.

# Grievances in the life insurance sector are about the product itself: IRDAI member

Insurance companies must reduce the number of policyholder complaints and ensure that the subscriber gets the facilities they expect at the time of buying the policy, said Satyajit Tripathy, Member (Distribution), IRDAI.

It has brought the attention of the policymakers. The policy makers are very concerned and they want this to be addressed."

**CUSTOMER FOCUS**  
Aarati Krishnan, Consulting Editor, *businessline*, said,

"The insurance industry cannot move on to the next level of penetration or growth without addressing the poor customer experience. The life industry needs to focus on protection products... To measure insurance penetration, instead of looking at premiums paid by GDP, we should be looking at the sum

**PRODUCT ISSUES**  
Speaking at CII's Financing 3.0 Summit, the IRDAI member said the grievances in the life insurance sector are not about the claim amount or the time taken for settlement, but about the product

"And if we talk about the boom (in the insurance sector) in the coming days... that we increase the penetration, we increase the sale of various products, and we make it affordable, then we must address the grievances," Tripathy said.

He noted that the complaint or the grievance in the non-life sector are operationally different.

"It is not about the mis-selling of a product; it is particularly about payment of claims, the claims being re-

# 6 women among 9 Naxals gunned down in Bastar

**PTI, DANTEWADA:** Nine Naxalites, including six women, were killed in a fierce encounter with security forces in Chhattisgarh's Bastar region on Tuesday, a top police official said, in the latest offensive against Maoists which has gathered pace after a change of government last year.

The gunfight broke out at around 10:30 am in forests along the border of Dantewada and Bijapur districts when a joint team of security forces was out on anti-Naxal operation, Inspector General of Police, Bastar Range, Sundarraj P told PTI.

Personnel belonging to the state police's District Reserve Guard (DRG), Bastar Fighters and 111th and 230th battalions of the Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF) were involved in the operation.

The operation was launched on Monday night based on inputs about the

presence of cadres belonging to Maoists' PLGA (People's Liberation Guerrilla Army) Company No. 2, west Bastar and Darbha division on the hills of inter-district border, he said.

The exchange of fire between Naxalites and security personnel took place multiple times in forests near Lohagaon, Purangel and Andri villages under the Kirandul Police Station area (Dantewada district). After the guns fell silent, bodies of nine Naxalites, including six women - all clad in 'uniform' - were recovered from the spot, informed the senior IPS officer.

Chief Minister Vishnu Deo Sai hailed security forces for their latest success against Maoists and asserted his government has resolved to end the Left-wing extremism by March 2026.

A cache of weapons, including one SLR (Self-Loading

Rifle), one 303 rifle, 12 bore rifle, 315 bore rifle, BGLs (barrel grenade launchers) and explosives, items of daily use and other Maoist-related materials were recovered from the spot, IPS officer Sundarraj said.

After the latest offensive, 153 Naxalites have been gunned down in separate encounters in the Bastar division, comprising seven districts -- Kanker, Kondagaon, Narayanpur, Bastar, Bijapur, Dantewada and Sukma -- so far this

year, he said.

During the same period, 669 Naxalites have been arrested, while 656 others have surrendered before police in the division, the officer added.

Preliminary investigation suggests the slain cadres belonged to the west Bastar division committee and PLGA Company No. 2 of Maoists, but their identity was yet to be ascertained, Dantewada

Superintendent of Police Gaurav Rai said.

Blood stains found at the encounter site indicate several other Naxalites may have been injured or killed in the gunfight, Rai said, adding reinforcement was sent to the spot for conducting further search operation.

Hailing security forces involved in anti-Naxal operations, Chief Minister Sai said after the BJP government assumed office in Chhattisgarh (in December last

year), it has been fighting resolutely against Left-wing extremism in the state.
