BCCI Secy Jay elected unopposed as ICC chief



Mumbai, Aug 28: In a significant development for global cricket governance, Jay Shah, the dynamic honorary secretary of the BCCI, has been elected unopposed as the Independent Chair of the International Cricket Council (ICC).

Shah will officially take the reins on December 1, following the conclusion of Greg Barclay's tenure in November.

Barclay, who has been at the helm of the ICC since 2020, surprised many when he announced on August 20 that he would not seek a third term. His decision cleared the path for Shah, who was the sole nominee, to step into the role without contest.

Barclay's tenure was marked by steady

leadership, but Shah's unopposed election signals a new era, one where his initiatives to further expand cricket's global footprint would be watched keenly.

Shah, the son of Union Home Minister Amit Shah, has been a key figure in Indian cricket administration over the past few years, with his tenure in the BCCI characterised by a push for modernisation and a strong emphasis on global

outreach. His election as ICC Chair is seen as a natural progression of his growing influence in the cricketing world.

In his first public statement following the election, Shah said: "I am committed to working closely with the ICC team and our member nations to further globalise cricket." Shah highlighted the importance of balancing the coexistence of multiple formats-a nod to the ongoing debate

about the future of Test cricket in the era of T20 dominance. He also emphasised the need to embrace advanced technologies, which could revolutionize how the game is played, watched, and officiated.

A particularly striking element of Shah's agenda is his focus on introducing cricket's marquee events to new global markets. With the sport's inclusion in the 2028 Los Angeles Olympics, Shah sees an unprecedented opportunity to elevate cricket's status worldwide. "The inclusion of our sport in the Olympics at LA 2028 represents a significant inflection point for the growth of cricket, and I am confident that it will drive the sport forward in unprecedented ways," he asserted.

Prannoy to take indefinite break to recover from chikungunya

New Delhi, Aug 28: Indian badminton star H.S. Prannoy has announced an indefinite hiatus from upcoming tournaments to expedite his recovery from the lingering effects of chikungunya, a mosquito-borne viral disease. The 32-year-old shuttler, who was diagnosed just before the Paris 2024 Olympics, has been struggling to regain his peak form since the illness.

Prannoy made his Olympic debut in Paris, advancing to the round of 16 in the men's singles event before being knocked out by compatriot Lakshya Sen in straight games. Despite recovering in time for the Olympics, the aftereffects of chikungunya have continued to hamper his performance, forcing him to withdraw from the Japan Open 2024 and Korea Open 2024.



In a statement shared on social media, Prannoy expressed his gratitude to fans and emphasized the importance of focusing on his health. "After careful consideration with my team, I've decided to withdraw from some of the upcoming tournaments to focus on recovery. Thank you for your understanding and support during this challenging time. I'll be back stronger," Prannoy stated, without specifying a timeline for his return to competitive play.

The Kerala-based shuttler has also faced a series of physical setbacks, including a stomach disorder and back injury, in the lead-up to the Olympics. His decision to take a break comes at a crucial time as he aims to fully recover and reclaim the form that made him one of India's top badminton players in recent years.

Since 2022, Prannoy has been a standout performer on the international badminton circuit. He famously

defeated two-time Olympic gold medalist Viktor Axelsen in the quarterfinals of the World Championships, securing a bronze medal in Copenhagen last year. At the Asian Games 2023, Prannoy clinched a bronze medal in the men's singles event and contributed to India's silver-medal finish in the team event. He was also a key member of the Indian men's team that won the historic Thomas Cup in 2022.

Meanwhile, Commonwealth Games champion Lakshya Sen will also be absent from the Japan Open this week. Sen is currently in Salzburg, Austria, undergoing a physical assessment to enhance his performance in upcoming BWF tournaments. He plans to focus on his fitness in Austria before returning to India.

SG Pipers prevail 9-6 over U Mumba in UTT

Chennai, Aug 28: Manav Thakkar beat his usual men's doubles partner, Manush Shah, at Jawaharlar Nehru Indoor Stadium today, two games to one, but his win wasn't enough to lead U Mumba TT to victory. Rather, IndianOil Ultimate Table Tennis 2024 debutants Ahmedabad SG Pipers made a solid recovery in the following matches, registering their second

win on the bounce. Captains of their respective teams, Manav and Manush headed to the table first to contest the opening match of the tie, a men's singles. Manav seized the advantage early, outfoxing Manush to win Game 1 and 11-2. He took the subsequent game 11-9, while Manush recovered to reduce the deficit with a Game 3 triumph.

Manush's victory in Game 3 was crucial, as it allowed Reeth Rishya to level the tie for Ahmedabad SG Pipers with a 2-1 win over U Mumba TT's Sutritha Mukherjee. Manush then partnered with Bernadette Szocs in the mixed doubles, and the pair swept away U Mumba TT's pairing of Manav and Maria Xiao, 3-0, sealing the final point of the thumping

triumph with a brilliant combination move.

Quadri Aruna gave U Mumba TT a way back into the tie with an important 2-1 win over Lilian Bardet. However, Szocs, despite losing her first game to Xiao, heaved the team from Ahmedabad over the line by winning the second. The league's highest-ranked player later took the third game, too, increasing the margin of victory.

For her win against Sutritha in Match 2, Reeth took home the Indian Player of the Tie and DafaNews Shot of the Tie honours. Meanwhile, Szocs, for her display in singles and doubles, laid claim to the Foreign Player of the Tie and the ACT Rally of the Tie awards.

Wednesday's sole tie will see the Dabang Delhi T.T.C take on Athlead Goa Challengers at 19:30, with both teams looking to bounce back from a defeat in IndianOil UTT 2024.

Harmanpreet to lead 15-member T20 World Cup squad

Mumbai, Aug 28: India on Tuesday announced a formidable 15-member squad led by all-rounder Harmanpreet Kaur for the upcoming ICC Women's T20 World Cup 2024, set to start on October 3 in the UAE.

Harmanpreet will be supported by vice captain Smriti Mandhana, who is expected to open the batting alongside the explosive Shafali Verma. The batting line-up is further strengthened by the inclusion of Jemimah Rodrigues, Deepti Sharma, and wicketkeeper-batter Richa Ghosh, forming a solid core at the top and middle order. Dayalan Hemalatha also provides a reliable top-order option.

The bowling attack will be spearheaded by Renuka Singh and

Pooja Vastrakar, with spin options coming from Radha Yadav and Asha Sobhana. Deepti Sharma, who plays a dual role as a key all-rounder, will offer both batting depth and spin variation. The squad also features several versatile all-rounders, including Sajana Sajeevan and Shreyanka Patil, whose abilities will be crucial in the multi-faceted challenges posed by the tournament.

Richa Ghosh has been named the primary wicketkeeper, with Yastika Bhatia as a backup, though her selection remains contingent on her fitness. Similarly, the fitness of all-rounder Shreyanka Patil will be closely monitored as the team prepares for the event. India has also named three traveling

reserves, ensuring they are well-prepared for any unforeseen circumstances during the competition.
