CM Dhama Instructs Officials To Expedite Work Going On In Vidhan Sabha, Bhararisain

Uttarakhand Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami inspected the development works going on in Vidhan Sabha, Bhararisain on Thursday morning during his two-day Sansam tour.

The CM instructed the officials to expedite the work and pay special attention to quality work.

The Chief Minister said that in Vidhan Sabha, Bhararisain, the government is continuously working for the development of this entire area through road and air connectivity. The CM also met the local people and took feedback and suggestions for the development work being done by the administration.

Earlier, a meeting was held in Vidhan Sabha Bhawan located in Bhararisain on Wednesday under the chairmanship of the Chief Minister regarding the implementation of land law in the state.

Uttarakhand DGP Abhinav Kumar Advocates For Transparent, Independent DGP Appointment Process

Uttarakhand Director General of Police (DGP) Abhinav Kumar has given a representation to the state's Home Secretary Shailesh Bagauli for a transparent and independent DGP appointment process in the state.

In his representation, he has drawn the attention of the government by referring to Section-20 of the State Police Act-2007, which states that the state government will appoint the Director General of Police through the Appointment Committee for the overall control, direction and supervision of the police force.

The DGP has said in his representation that since the police system is a state subject in List-2 of Schedule-7 of the Indian Constitution, it is important that the state of Uttarakhand also considers implementing similar rules, so that transparency and autonomy along with the decisive role of the state government can be ensured in the appointment of the Director General of Police. DGP Abhinav Kumar has said in the representation sent to the state's Home Secretary that at present, in the appointment of the Director General of Police, the state government is adopting a process in accordance with the decision given by the Supreme Court in Prakash Singh vs Others case, in this system, the Union Public Service Commission and the Home Ministry have a decisive role. The DGP has said in his representation that in his opinion this is not appropriate from constitutional and practical point of view. In his representation, he has drawn attention towards the

Uttarakhand Police Act-2007 and said that it would be necessary to consider the provisions regarding the appointment of the Director General of Police. DGP Abhinav Kumar has said in his representation that the Uttar Pradesh government has recently implemented new rules for the appointment of DGP as per the Supreme Court's instructions, so that the state government's decisive role in the appointment of the head of the police force remains in view of the constitutional system and the Supreme Court's decision.

DGP Abhinav Kumar has requested the Uttarakhand government in the representation sent to the Home Secretary that inspired by the progressive steps taken by Uttar Pradesh, to maintain the independence and integrity of the police force, the appointment rules should be notified as soon as possible for the state of Uttarakhand as per the law. Earlier, DGP Abhinav Kumar held a meeting with concerned officials and discussed issues related to crime, law and order, and traffic management in the state.

According to an official release from Police Headquarters, the meeting was held through video conferencing with Zone and District Incharges, Superintendents of Police, and officials from the STF and Railways.—ANI

Pithoragarh: Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami inaugurated the famous Jauljibi Mela-2024 on Thursday, calling it a "priceless heritage" for Uttarakhand, according to a statement from the state government.

On this occasion, the Chief Minister laid the foundation stone of 18 schemes worth Rs. 64.47 crore, which includes 13 inaugurations of Rs. 29.65 crore and five foundation stones of Rs. 34.72 crore and observed various products being made by women self-help groups, added the statement.

Chief Minister Dhami said that Jauljibi Mela is a priceless heritage for the state, which has been promoting mutual harmony between India, Tibet, Nepal, and the border areas for centuries. This fair serves to preserve our rich traditions. It has had cultural ties with Nepal and Tibet for centuries, read the official statement further.

Pauri Garhwal: Uttarakhand Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami inaugurated the Baikunth Chaturdashi Fair and Development Exhibition on Thursday, organised at Awasth Maidan in Srinagar area of Garhwal district.

Reportedly, the CM offered prayers at Kamleshwar Mahadev Temple and then inspected the departmental stalls at the venue and addressed the public.

Chief Minister Shri Pushkar Singh Dhami bowed his head at Lord Kamleshwar Mahadev Temple on the occasion of Baikunth Chaturdashi festival.

He prayed for the happiness and prosperity

of the state by offering water to Lord Shiva. Moreover, he offered lotus flowers to the Shivaling.

The Mahant of the temple, Ashutosh Puri performed the worship.

The students of Shri Jay Dal Sanskrit Mahavidyalaya Srinagar recited Swasti.

The CM welcomed the people who inaugurated the ceremony of Baikunth Chaturdashi Mela and said, "I am very happy to come to this mythological Dham situated on the banks of Patit Pavan Maa Alaknanda. The mythological temples of this area are the priceless heritage of our state."

Calling the fair a "symbol of faith" of the state and the rich traditions, he added, "this fair, organized every year on the occasion of Baikunth Chaturdashi, is a symbol of the faith of Devbhoomi as well as our rich traditions."

He further congratulated the cultural committee to bring forth the cultural heritage of the state.

"I also congratulate the organizing committee of this fair, because you people are working to take this cultural heritage to the new generation," the CM said.

Recalling how Prime Minister Narendra Modi called this decade as the "decade of Uttarakhand," he said, "PM Narendra Modi had said that the third decade of the 21st century will be the decade of Uttarakhand and today our double engine government is continuously working to fulfil the statement made by the Honorable Prime Minister." "Be it Kedarnath Dham or Badrinath Dham, master plan works are going on everywhere at a cost of crores. Rishikesh Karnaprayag Rail Project will strengthen connectivity in the hills including Srinagar," he added.

Referring to the on-going schemes in Srinagar area, the Chief Minister said that work is going on for a Critical Care Unit of more than 50 beds in the Medical College at a cost of Rs 25 crore.

"Roadways bus station and parking have been constructed in Srinagar at a cost of Rs 4.88 crore. Dr Dhan Singh keeps making efforts for whatever work is necessary for the development of the area and these works are also being done. By making Srinagar Nagar Palika into a Municipal Corporation, development works are being done rapidly," he said.

He added that emphasis is being laid on developing a new township in Belkandi Bilkedar area. On this occasion, the Chief Minister released a book on leopard and human conflict reduction prepared by the District Education and Training Institute under the direction of District Magistrate Dr Ashish Chauhan. This booklet related to aspects related to protection from leopards will be included in the curriculum of students from class 1 to 8.—ANI
