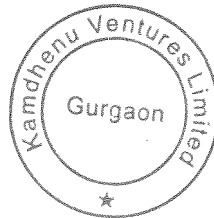

TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS AROUND RED FORT
The following roads will be closed for general traffic from 4:00 AM to 10:00 AM on 13.08.2024 and only labeled vehicles will be permitted:-

- Netaji Subhash Marg from Delhi Gate to Chhatta Rail.
- Lothian Road from GPO Delhi to Chhatta Rail.
- S.P.Mukherjee Marg from H.C.Sen Marg to Yamuna Bazar Chowk.
- Chandni Chowk Road from Fountain Chowk to Red Fort.
- Nishad Raj Marg from Ring Road to Netaji Subhash Marg.
- Esplanade Road and its Link Road to Netaji Subhash Marg.
- Ring Road from Rajghat to ISBT.
- Outer ring Road from ISBT to IP Flyover i.e., Salimgarh Bypass.

ROADS THAT MAY BE AVOIDED FROM 04:00 AM to 10:00 AM on 13.08.2024:

Those vehicles which do not have parking labels for the rehearsal may avoid C-Hexagon India Gate, Copernicus Marg, Mandi House, Sikandra Road, W Point, A Point, Tilak Marg, Mathura Road, BSZ Marg, Netaji Subhash Marg, J.L. EAST WEST ACCESS:

- NH-24 (NH-9) - Nizamuddin Khatta- Barapula Road- under AIIMS Flyover- Ring Road.
- DND- Barapula Road further as per 1 above OR via Ashram on Ring Road & proceed accordingly.
- NH-24 (NH-9) - Nizamuddin Khatta- Ring Road- Bhalron Road- Mathura Road- Subrahmanyam Bhatti Marg- Rajesh Pilot Marg- Prithviraj Road- Safdarjung Road- Kamal Ataturk Marg- Panchsheel Marg- SP Marg/Ridge Road accordingly and vice versa.
- Vikas Marg- IP Marg- DDU Marg- Minto Road then either via Connaught Place or Ajmeri Gate-DBG Road & proceed further.
- Pusta Road (Shastri Park)-GT Road- Yudhister Setu- ISBT Kashimiri Gate and proceed accordingly via Ring Road or Rani Jhansi Road.
- DND - NH24 (NH9) - Yudhister Setu- Signature Bridge- Wazirabad Bridge will remain open to reach Ring Road.
- Old Iron Bridge and Geeta Colony Bridge towards Shant Vihar will be closed.
- People are advised to reach early to avoid last minute rush & inconvenience.
- All RWAs are hereby requested to collect/purchase their essential commodities before 22:00 Hrs. on 12.08.2024 for citizens of Delhi.

SIGNAGES
Adequate informative signage will be displayed for the guidance of vehicular traffic destined for the Red Fort at all important traffic junctions.

RESTRICTIONS ON MOVEMENT OF COMMERCIAL TRANSPORT AND INTERSTATE BUSES:

- Goods vehicles will not be permitted between Nizamuddin Khatta and Wazirabad bridge from 12:00 Midnight of 12.08.2024 to 11:00 AM on 13.08.2024.
- Interstate buses will not be allowed between Maharana Pratap ISBT and Sarai Kale Khan ISBT from 12:00 Midnight of 12.08.2024 to 11:00 AM on 13.08.2024.

RESTRICTIONS ON MOVEMENT OF CITY BUSES APART FROM RESTRICTED ROADS:

Local city buses including DTC will not move on Ring Road from 12:00 Midnight of 12.08.2024 to 10:00 AM on 13.08.2024 between ISBT Kashimiri Gate and Ring Road - NH-24(NH-9)/NH 27 Point (Nizamuddin Khatta) and take available alternative route.

The following road shall also be closed for movement of Inter City/DTC buses from 12:00 Midnight of 12.08.2024 to 10:00 AM on 13.08.2024.

(A) Lothian Road from Chhatta Rail Chowk to Kashimiri Gate (Boulevard Road).

(F) Ashoka Road from R/A Windsor Place to 'C' Hexagon.

(G) KG Marg from Ferozeshah Road to 'C' Hexagon.

(H) Vikas Marg, beyond loop towards Delhi Secretariat.

(I) Mathura Road from Ashram Chowk to W Point.

Buses ordinarily terminating at Red Fort, Jama Masjid and Delhi Main Railway Station will be curtailed/diverted as below:-

- Opposite Ramlika Ground on J.L.N. Marg for buses approaching from South and West Delhi.
- At Mori Gate and Tis Hazari for buses coming from North, North West via Barafkhana and East Delhi via ISBT Bridge.
- At Boulevard Road opp. Maharaja Agrasen Park for buses coming from North Delhi side from Ring Road.

Normal bus service will be restored after 10:00 AM.

How to Approach / Reach Important places:-

1) OLD DELHI RAILWAY STATION:-

a) From West and South Delhi:- Mother Teresa Crescent - Park Street - Mandir Marg Panchkuan Road - Rani Jhansi Flyover - Azad Market - Boulevard - Mori Gate - Pul Dufferin - S.P.Mukherjee Marg to reach the Railway Station or Dhaura Kuan - Ridge Road (Vande Matram Marg) - Faiz Road - Rani Jhansi Road & thereafter as above & vice versa.

b) From North:- Mori Gate - Pul Dufferin - S.P. Mukherjee Marg to reach the Railway Station.

c) From East/North East:- Pusta Road - Yudhister Setu - Mori Gate - Pul Dufferin - SP Mukherjee Marg then proceed further accordingly.

2) NEW DELHI RAILWAY STATION:-

a) From East-Vikas Marg, DDU Marg, Bhambhuji Marg, ND Railway Station.

b) From North East:- Yudhister Setu, Rani Jhansi Road, R/A Rani Jhansi, DBG Road and reach ND Railway Station accordingly OR via Mori Gate, Pul Dufferin, SP Mukherjee Marg, Qutub Road and reach.

c) From North:- Rani Jhansi Road, R/A Rani Jhansi, DBG Road and reach ND Railway Station accordingly OR via Mori Gate, Pul Dufferin, SP Mukherjee Marg, Qutub Road and reach.

d) From West:- Pusa Road, R/A Hanuman Murti, Panchkua Road, Connaught Place, Chelmsford Road and ND Railway Station OR via DBG Road to reach ND Railway Station.

e) From South:- To reach Connaught Place, Chelmsford Road and ND Railway Station OR via DBG Road to reach ND Railway Station.

3) ISBT KASHMERE GATE

a) From New Delhi and South Delhi:- Mother Teresa Crescent- Park Street - Mandir Marg - Panchkuan Road - Rani Jhansi Road and Rani Jhansi Flyover - Boulevard Road.

b) From West Delhi:- Pusa Road, R/A Hanuman Mandir, Faiz Road, Rani Jhansi Road and thereafter as above.

c) From North Delhi:- There is no restriction.

d) From North-East Delhi:- Yudhister Setu, Boulevard Road, Mori Gate, Pul Dufferin, SP Mukherjee Marg, Old Delhi Railway Station.

4) J.P.N. HOSPITAL:- There is no restriction.

5) KASTURBA HOSPITAL:- Ajmeri Gate - Ajmeri Bazar - Chowk Hazu Quazi - Chawni Bazar - Chowk - Barshabullah - Urdu Bazar.

DIERSIONS

(A) FROM TRANS YAMUNA AREA
(I) G.T. ROAD/ISBT KASHMERE GATE BRIDGE:- Buses bound for Kauria Pul / Red Fort / Old Delhi Railway Station shall operate via ISBT Bridge (Yudhister Setu) and terminate at Boulevard Road - Near Mori Gate U Turn. Return route via Boulevard Road after taking 'U' turn from Mori Gate 'U' - turn for ISBT Bridge (Yudhister Setu).

Buses bound for New Delhi/Connaught Place/Central Secretariat shall operate via new ISBT Bridge - Boulevard Road Rani Jhansi Flyover - Rani Jhansi Road - Mandir Marg - Peshwa Road - Gole Market & Shivaji Stadium Terminal / Central Secretariat Terminal.

Buses bound for South Delhi shall follow the route above upto Mandir Marg and proceed further via Shankar Road - Upper Ridge Road, Simon Bolivar Marg - Dhaukuan.

(II) VIKAS MARG

- Buses bound for North Delhi shall proceed via Marginal Bandh Road (Pusta), G.T. Road, Shastri Park, ISBT Bridge, Boulevard Road and proceed further.
- Buses bound for South Delhi shall proceed via Mother Dairy Road, NH - 24, towards Nizamuddin Bridge - Ring Road towards Ashram Chowk.
- Buses bound for New Delhi shall deboard the passengers on Vikas Marg, New Secretariat. Bus stand and will take U turn from under IP Flyover for return journey towards Vikas Marg.

BUSES COMING FROM BARAF - KHANA

All Buses otherwise terminating at Old Delhi Railway Station/ Kauna Pul/Red Fort/Jama Masjid shall be curtailed as mentioned below.

- Buses coming from Roshanara Road for Old Delhi Railway Station shall terminate opposite State Bank of India inside Tis Hazari Courts. Return journey will be via Boulevard Road towards Barafkhana.
- Buses coming from Old Rohtak Road for Old Delhi Railway Station, Red Fort shall terminate at Mori Gate.
- Return journey will be via Gokhale Road - Zorawar Singh Marg.
- Buses coming from New Rohtak Road for Old Delhi Railway Station, Red Fort shall terminate on Gokhale Marg between Tikona Park and In Gate Tis Hazari Court.
- Return journey will be via Gokhale Road - Zorawar Singh Marg.
- Buses coming from Malka Ganj for Old Delhi Railway Station, Red Fort shall terminate on Gokhale Marg adjoining boundary wall of Tikona Park.
- Return journey will be via Gokhale Road - Zorawar Singh Marg.
- All metro and mini buses shall be terminated at MCD car parking (MORI GATE). Gokhale road shall be one-way from R/A Mori Gate towards P.S. Metro Station Kashimiri Gate & R/A Mori Gate to Gokhale Market 'T' Point.

BUSES COMING FROM AJMERI GATE/MINTO BRIDGE

- All Buses otherwise terminating at Old Delhi Railway Station, Red Fort, Bhal Mai Dass Chowk, Mori Gate, ISBT, Pragati Maidan and Ambedkar Stadium Terminal shall terminate Opp. Turkman Gate/Asaf Ali Road.
- Return journey by taking 'U' Turn on J.L.N. Marg and proceed further.

BUSES COMING FROM MALL ROADSIDE

- All buses otherwise terminating at Old Delhi Railway Station, Red Fort, Jama Masjid, Kauriya Pul shall terminate on Boulevard Road upto Mori Gate.
- Return journey will be via Boulevard Road, Ring Road and Chandgi Ram Akhara, IP College Light point.

BUSES COMING FROM SOUTH DELHI

Buses bound for Red Fort, Old Delhi Railway Station, Bhai Mati Dass Chowk (Fountain) from South Delhi will be diverted via Ring Road - NH - 24, Marginal Bandh (Pushpa) Road, new ISBT Bridge and shall terminate on Boulevard Road.

Return journey by taking 'U' Turn and proceed further via ISBT Bridge.

- Buses bound for Connaught Place from South Delhi shall be diverted towards Ring Road and further take Upper Ridge Road upto R/A Karol Bagh and reach Connaught Place via Jhandewalan Panchkuan Road Shivaji Stadium terminal.
- Buses bound for ISBT Maharana Pratap Terminal shall proceed Ring Road and further take Upper Ridge Road upto R/A Karol Bagh Faiz Road Filmistan Azad Mkt. Chowk, Boulevard Road and reach Mori Gate/ISBT.
- Buses bound for East Delhi from South Delhi shall proceed via Ring Road - Hazrat Nizamuddin Bridge (NH - 24) - New Patgar Ganj Road.
- Buses bound for East Delhi from South Delhi coming at Lala Lajpat Rai Marg will be diverted on Mathura Road towards the Ashram Chowk - Ring Road from Lodhi Fly over R/A Neela Gumbad.
- Buses bound for Red Fort, Jama Masjid, Kauriya Pul from Firozshah Road and going towards Mandi House shall take Barakhamba Road from Mandi House, Ranjit Singh Flyover and terminate Opp. Turkman Gate Asaf Ali Road.

Return journey via J.L.N. Marg, Ranjeet Singh Flyover by taking 'U' Turn and proceed further.

Mudrika Services (Buses) shall take route via new ISBT Bridge, Shastri Park, Pusta Kailash Gandhi Nagar - Vikas Marg - Mother Dairy Road - NH - 24 - Nizamuddin Bridge - turn left Ring Road for Sarai Kale Khan.

INTER STATE BUSES

INCOMING

- All buses coming from Ghaziabad towards Delhi shall move via Bhopura Chungi Road from Mohan Nagar for Wazirabad Road and then towards Chandni Ram Akhara - U turn ISBT and enter ISBT.
- All Buses coming from Dhaura Kuan shall be diverted on Ring Road for taking Punjabi Bagh - Azad Pur - Akhara Chandgi Ram - U turn ISBT and enter ISBT.
- All buses operating between ISBT and Faridabad (Badarpur) shall either terminate at Sarai Kale Khan or be diverted on Ring Road via Dhaura Kuan Punjabi Bagh - Azad Pur - Akhara Chandgi Ram - U turn ISBT and enter ISBT.

OUTGOING

- No bus shall be allowed to take 'U' turn at northern loop of Ring Road near Budh Vihar (Monastery) and would be diverted towards Wazirabad to go Trans Yamuna or take 'U' turn from Chandni Ram Akhara and take loop of ISBT Flyover to go towards Shastri Park and Buses bound for Dhaura Kuan shall take Boulevard Road, Rani Jhansi Road, Link Road and upper Ridge Road (Vande Matram Marg).
- Buses bound for Loni Border shall proceed via Wazirabad Bridge and those bound for Ghazalabad shall proceed via ISBT Bridge.

DTC RECOVERY VANS

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- General public is advised not to bring cameras, binoculars, Remote Control car keys, umbrellas, handbags, briefcases, transistors, cigarette lighters, tiffin boxes, water bottles, lunch boxes, etc.

As protests continue, Kolkata Police chief says probe 'absolutely transparent'

TWO DAYS after the rape and murder of a junior woman doctor at Kolkata's RG Kar Medical College and Hospital, the West Bengal government on Sunday removed hospital superintendent Sanjay Vashishth.

Prof Bulbul Mukhopadhyay, dean of student affairs, RG Kar Medical College and Hospital, has been given the additional charge of the superintendent.

Kolkata Police has also decided to remove an Assistant Commissioner-rank officer from the charge of RG Kar Hospital. Kolkata Police Commissioner Vineet Goyal conveyed this to the protesting students.

"The demand of the protesting doctors was that the local Assistant Commissioner of Police should be removed. Therefore, he has been removed," said Goyal.

Also, the post of Additional Officer in Charge (OC) at the police outpost inside RG Kar Hospital, which was lying vacant for a long time, has been filled. Inspector Subhanshu Mudli has been appointed Additional OC.

According to the officials, the hospital administration has also issued instructions -- all doctors should carry their identity cards with them and all other staff members should be in their respective uniforms inside the premises -- so that they can be identified as hospital staff.

The decision comes amid on-

going protests by junior doctors and medical students, staging a cease-work protest under the banner "No safety, no work" against the incident and demanding justice for the 31-year-old second-year postgraduate student. The strike has severely disrupted patient care, forcing the hospital administration to cancel leaves for all staff members. Medical services have been crippled since Saturday, causing immense hardship to patients seeking treatment.

Kolkata Commissioner of Police Vineet Goyal on Sunday said that the police are "absolutely transparent" with their investigation and the protesting doctors and medical students can contact the police in case they have any queries.

Police have arrested a person, Sanjay Roy, in connection with the crime.

"We hope that the protesters

are satisfied with the probe so far. If they have any question or any doubt, they can tell us and contact us. There are a lot of rumours circulating around. We are absolutely transparent as far as the probe of this case is concerned. We will also appeal to students that if they have something that they want to share with us we will probe that too from all possible angles. We have nothing to hide and no one to protect," Goyal said.

While the accused, a civic volunteer, was arrested on Saturday and sent to 14-day police custody, the protests show no signs of abating. A massive police contingent has been deployed on the campus to maintain order as the protests continue.

The incident has sparked outrage across the country. The Federation of Resident Doctors' Association has announced suspension of multiple services on Monday, while the National

Doctors' Association has called for a nationwide protest on Tuesday.

On Sunday, the resident doctors of RG Kar Medical College and Hospital demanded judicial inquiry into the case and capital punishment for the culprits. Along with a written apology, they have also asked that all relevant evidence should be shared with the committee. "The relevant evidence, including CCTV footage and post-mortem report should be shared with the committee representatives of the protesting resident doctors. Written apology and resignation of higher authorities (Principal, MSVP, Chest Medicine HOD and on-duty ACP, RG KAR Medical College Police Outpost) within 12 hours," read their demand letter.

Additionally, the doctors of RG Kar Hospital have demanded immediate announcement of adequate compensation for the family of the victim.

The residents appealed to the medical fraternity of the country and civil society to raise their voice against the incident. "Written progress of the investigation must be published by the investigating authority on a regular basis. We will continue our cease work of emergency as well as non-emergency duties until all our demands are met. We, the resident doctors of RG KAR MCH, appeal to the medical fraternity of the country and to the civil society at large to stand by us in this time of need, show unity to our cause and raise their voices for justice. Signed by all resident doctors of R.G.KAR MCH," said one of the protesters.

Sourav condemns: 'No forgiveness for such a crime'

FORMER INDIAN cricket captain Sourav Ganguly on Sunday condemned the rape and murder of a young doctor inside a Kolkata hospital.

Speaking to reporters on the sidelines of an event, Ganguly said that as the father of a daughter,

he was deeply shaken by the incident. He, however, added that West Bengal and India are considered safe, and no judge-

ment should be made on the entire system based on a single incident. "It is a heinous incident. There can be no forgiveness for such a crime," Ganguly said, adding that the authorities should take immediate action.

Though such incidents can happen anywhere, it is unfortunate that this particular case took place inside a hospital.

The former cricketer called

for stronger security measures in medical establishments.

The body of a woman post-graduate trainee, who was allegedly raped and murdered inside the RG Kar Medical College and Hospital, was found in its seminar room on Friday.

Ganguly, however, also said that it would not be right to criticize the entire system based on a single incident.

Order CBI probe, state BJP chief urges Nadda

STATE BJP president Sukanta Majumdar on Sunday in a letter to Union Health Minister JP Nadda demanded a CBI probe into the brutal sexual assault and murder of a woman doctor at RG Kar Medical College and Hospital in Kolkata and implement measures to avoid future tragedies similar to the recent incident.

This incident has sparked widespread outrage among the medical fraternity as well as the general public, leading to protests and candle march by students and staff of the medical college. "There is a growing demand for a Central Bureau of Investigation probe to ensure an unbiased investigation. Considering the gravity of the crime and the need for swift justice, I request you to advocate for a CBI probe and ensure that the case is fast-tracked to bring the culprits to justice," Majumdar wrote.

Additionally, he also urged that a team of National Investigation Commission should be sent to investigate the case. "I request to send a team of National Medical Commission to investigate the matter and take appropriate action. Also enforce stringent security protocols, including the installation of more CCTV

cameras, the presence of adequate security personnel, and the restriction of unauthorized access to sensitive areas within medical institutions," the letter stated.

"According to the news reports, the body of the young doctor was found in a partially-clothed condition in the seminar hall of the hospital, with signs of severe assault, including bleeding and injuries on multiple parts of her body, and evidence suggesting she was strangled and smothered. The autopsy report, further confirmed that the victim was sexually assaulted before her death," the letter further read.

Majumdar mentioned in the letter that "the medical community is deeply shaken by this incident. It is crucial to provide psychological and moral support to the doctors, nurses, and staff of RG Kar Medical College."

"I request the Ministry to collaborate with the state government to provide counseling services and create a safer working environment for healthcare professionals.... The fact that the victim was found in a seminar room, reportedly because there was no separate on-call room, raises concerns about the infrastructure provided to medical staff. It is imperative to review and improve the facilities available to doctors..." it read.

Harris backs ending taxes on tips for service industry staff

VICE PRESIDENT KAMALA Harris said she would seek to end taxes on tipped income for service industry workers — matching a proposal that her 2024 rival Republican Donald Trump has also made in a bid to court young people and working-class voters.

"When I am president, we will continue our fight for working families of America, including to raise the minimum wage and eliminate taxes on tips for service and hospital-ity workers," Harris said at a rally on Saturday in Las Vegas.

The Democratic nominee's pledge came in a battleground state critical to determining November's election outcome and where both parties are fighting to draw support from service-industry workers. Nevada's casinos draw millions of tourists a year and the state has the highest proportion of food service and accommodation workers in the US — employees who historically have relied on tips.

Trump made his pitch to remove taxes on tips during a rally in Las Vegas in June, part of an economic agenda that

aims to renew expiring tax cuts. The former president assailed Harris in a post on his Truth Social network on Saturday night, accusing her of stealing one of his proposals.

Harris "just copied my NO TAXES ON TIPS Policy. The difference is, she won't do it, she just wants it for Political Purposes!" Trump wrote. "She has no ideas, she can only steal from me." Ending taxes on tips would require legislation, according to a Harris campaign official who detailed the proposal on condition of anonymity. — BLOOMBERG

Trump's team says its campaign website was hacked by Iranians

REPUBLICAN NOMINEE Donald Trump said he was informed by Microsoft that one of his campaign websites was hacked by the Iranian government, but said the hackers were only able to access "publicly available information" in the breach. "Nevertheless, they shouldn't be doing anything of this nature," Trump said in a post

on his Truth Social network. "Iran and others will stop at nothing, because our government is weak and ineffective, but it won't be for long." The hack was first reported by Politico, which said it had begun receiving emails in July containing internal Trump campaign documents from an anonymous account. — BLOOMBERG

Maldives Oppn hails Muizzu's recalibration of its India policy

Jaishankar is on a three-day official visit to the Maldives to reset the bilateral relationship, the first high-level trip from India after the archipelago nation's pro-China President Muizzu assumed office last year.

Bangladesh warns media shutdown for false news

BANGLADESH'S INTERIM GOVERNMENT on Sunday issued a stern warning to media organisations, stating that they will be shut down if they publish or broadcast false or misleading news, in a move aimed at curbing the spread of misinformation.

"A nation falters when the media does not uphold the truth," the interim government's Home Affairs Adviser, Brigadier General (ret'd) M Sakhawat Hossain, said during his visit to injured policemen at Rajarbagh Central Police Hospital. He warned that the media outlets would face closure if they provided mislead-

ing news, the Dhaka Tribune newspaper reported.

Criticising the media for not presenting the truth, Hossain said, "A country deteriorates when the media fails to report honestly," and argued that had the media accurately reported events, the current situation involving the police might have been avoided.

"The media often ignores the truth... There is a lack of substantive discussion on talk shows, and the media fails to provide accurate information," he said.

Meanwhile, Nahid Islam, adviser for Posts, Telecommunications, and Information Technology, said action will be taken against officials involved in the internet shutdown during the recent student protests.

Refaat Ahmed takes oath as Bangladesh's chief justice

SYED REFAAT Ahmed was sworn in as Bangladesh's new chief justice on Sunday, a day after Obaidul Hassan stepped down as the top judge following an ultimatum by the protesters demanding a revamp of the judiciary. Hassan and five other judges of the apex Appellate Division on Saturday tendered their resignation. — PTI

Harris backs ending taxes on tips for service industry staff

VICE PRESIDENT KAMALA Harris said she would seek to end taxes on tipped income for service industry workers — matching a proposal that her 2024 rival Republican Donald Trump has also made in a bid to court young people and working-class voters.

"When I am president, we will continue our fight for working families of America, including to raise the minimum wage and eliminate taxes on tips for service and hospitality workers," Harris said at a rally on Saturday in Las Vegas.

The Democratic nominee's pledge came in a battleground state critical to determining November's election outcome and where both parties are fighting to draw support from service-industry workers. Nevada's casinos draw millions of tourists a year and the state has the highest proportion of food service and accommodation workers in the US — employees who historically have relied on tips.

Trump made his pitch to remove taxes on tips during a rally in Las Vegas in June, part of an economic agenda that aims to renew expiring tax

cuts. The former president assailed Harris in a post on his Truth Social network on Saturday night, accusing her of stealing one of his proposals.

Harris "just copied my NO TAXES ON TIPS Policy. The difference is, she won't do it, she just wants it for Political Purposes!" Trump wrote. "She has no ideas, she can only steal from me." Ending taxes on tips would require legislation, according to a Harris campaign official who detailed the proposal on condition of anonymity. — BLOOMBERG

Trump's team says its campaign website was hacked by Iranians

REPUBLICAN NOMINEE Donald Trump said he was informed by Microsoft that one of his campaign websites was hacked by the Iranian government, but said the hackers were only able to access "publicly available information" in the breach. "Nevertheless, they shouldn't be doing anything of this nature," Trump said in a post on his Truth Social network on Saturday. "Iran and others will stop at nothing, because our government is weak and ineffective, but it won't be for long." The hack was first reported by Politico, which said it had begun receiving emails in July containing internal Trump campaign documents from an anonymous account.

Brutal selloff skims froth from Japan's \$6-trn market

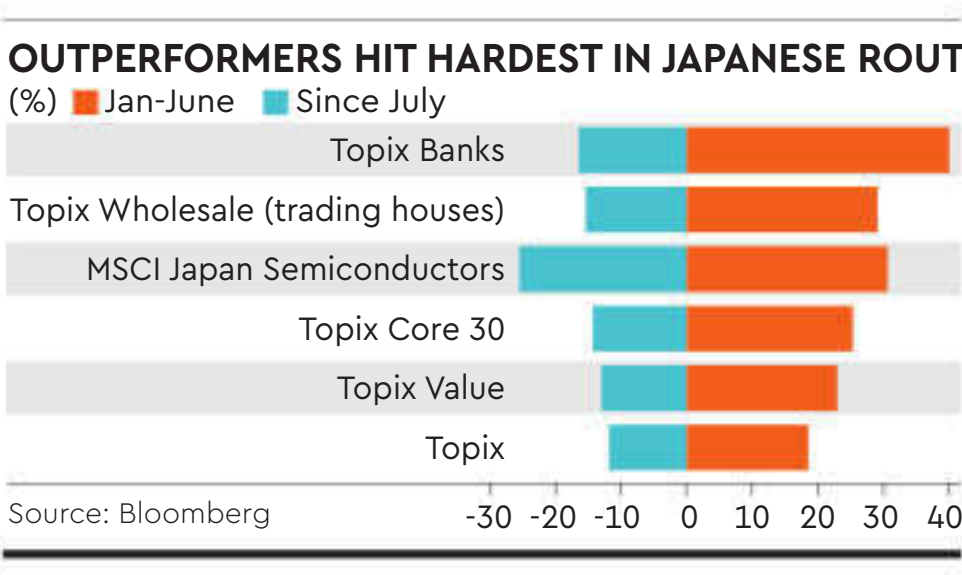

JAPANESE EQUITIES SHED \$1.1 trillion in value as they kicked off August with a record three-day loss. For bullish investors, that's providing a fresh reason to buy what has been one of 2024's hottest trades.

The stocks that were hit the hardest are the ones that had soared the highest, bringing prices down to more attractive levels. The valuation improvement campaign that has boosted the international appeal of Japanese shares continues apace, and some of the froth has been removed from the now \$6.1 trillion market.

While the Bank of Japan's sudden interest rate hike last month caught traders off guard, the central bank followed up with comments that it won't tighten so quickly as to risk further market turmoil. That's helped put a lid on sudden gains in the yen, removing a key threat to the stock rally.

In terms of major global catalysts, the latest US labor-market data helped ease concern about whether the Federal Reserve is easing fast enough to head off a potential recession. And the world's major technology companies are steaming ahead with plans to spend billions on artificial



intelligence infrastructure. "It's not like we had a major economic or financial crisis," said Tetsuro Ii, chief executive of Commons Asset Management, adding that it will probably take just two or three months for the market to fully recover. Investors now recognise that monetary policy in Japan and the US has "entered a new stage," having taken this as a cue to exit crowded positions. The benchmark Topix is down 12% since the end of June. Stocks that had outperformed earlier in the year have suffered more. An MSCI gauge of the nation's semiconductor-related stocks — whose AI-fueled surge was a key driver of this year's rally — has fallen 25% in that span. A measure of banks, which had surged on anticipation of higher rates, is down 16%. "I wouldn't call it a bubble but the market just got carried away," said Toru Yamamoto, chief strategist at Daiwa Asset Management. "When you need to cut risks, the most bloated positions will get slashed." Japan had become one of the favourite markets of global traders this year amid expectations that inflation will return after more than two decades of price stagnation and hopes that Japanese companies will return more cash to shareholders at the urging of the Tokyo Stock Exchange. The recent slide made stocks cheaper, potentially making them even more attractive to overseas investors such as Warren Buffett, who has poured funds into Japanese trading houses. The Topix is now trading at 13 times estimated forward earnings, compared with 20 times for the S&P 500 Index. The Japan chip gauge is down to 21 times from 35 times earlier this year.

Bangladesh warns media shutdown for false news

PRESS TRUST OF INDIA Dhaka, August 11

BANGLADESH'S INTERIM GOVERNMENT on Sunday issued a stern warning to media organisations, stating that they will be shut down if they publish or broadcast false or misleading news, in a move aimed at curbing the spread of misinformation.

"A nation falters when the media does not uphold the truth," the interim government's Home Affairs Adviser, Brigadier General (ret'd) M Sakhawat Hossain, said during his visit to injured policemen at Rajarbagh Central Police Hospital.

He warned that the media outlets would face closure if they provided misleading news, the Dhaka Tribune newspaper reported.

Criticising the media for not presenting the truth, Hossain said, "A country deteriorates when the media fails to report honestly," and argued that had the media accurately reported events, the current situation involving the police might have been avoided.

"The media often ignores the truth... There is a lack of substantive discussion on talk shows, and the media fails to provide accurate information," he said.

Meanwhile, Nahid Islam, adviser for Posts, Telecommunications, and Information Technology, said action will be taken against officials involved in the internet shutdown during the recent student protests.

Talking to journalists on the first day of joining his office at the Secretariat on Sunday, Nahid emphasised that those responsible for the internet shutdown during the protests will face consequences, the Daily Star newspaper reported.

He said access to the internet is a right and disrupting or shutting it down is a violation of human rights. Nahid asserted that the indiscriminate internet shutdowns will no longer be tolerated.

Refaat Ahmed takes oath as chief justice

SYED REFAAT Ahmed was sworn in as Bangladesh's new chief justice on Sunday, a day after Obaidul Hassan stepped down as the top judge following an ultimatum by the protesters demanding a revamp of the judiciary. Hassan and five other judges of the apex Appellate Division on Saturday tendered their resignation. — PTI

Maldives' main Oppn welcomes President Muizzu govt's recalibration of its India policy

PAKISTAN'S INDUSTRIAL AND financial centre Karachi has become the food capital for the foodies of the cosmopolitan city, with the latest trend being an acquired taste for authentic and refined Indian vegetarian dishes such as 'soyabean aloo biryani', 'aloo tikki', 'vada pav', 'masala dosa' and 'dhokla'.

For millions of people in the capital of Sindh province, Karachi's beauty is the food options ranging from the most expensive European and Italian cuisine to affordable Chinese food or a simple bun kabab as the food capital caters to the taste and pockets of everyone.

The foodies in recent months have also developed a taste for "pure vegetarian" dishes. Initially built for the inhabitants of the compound, the Maharaj Karamchand Inn is now a popular joint for the lawyers and visitors who show up every day at the city courts just opposite the compound or for other businesses in this commercially vibrant area of

old Karachi. "Our Soyabean Aloo Biryani, Aloo Tikki, Paneer Karahi, and Mixed Vegetables are famous and we witness a lot of rush during lunchtime with a lot of takeaways and deliveries as well," Kumar said.

पार्क में भरे पानी में डूबने से सात वर्ष के बच्चे की मौत

दिल्ली के रोहिणी के सेक्टर 20 स्थित अमन विहार के एक पार्क में बारिश के भरे पानी में डूब जाने से सात वर्षीय बच्चे की मौत हो गई। यह घटना शनिवार देर शाम को उस समय हुई जब बच्चा पार्क में खेल रहा था। पुलिस अधिकारी ने बताया कि बच्चे के डूब जाने की सूचना पीसीआर को मिली। पुलिस अधिकारी ने बताया कि पुलिस की एक टीम तुरंत घटनास्थल पर पहुंची और उसे बताया गया कि बच्चे को अस्पताल ले जाया गया है, जहां चिकित्सकों ने बच्चे को मृत घोषित कर दिया। पार्क में बने छठ घाट में करीब पांच से छह फुट पानी भरा हुआ है। पुलिस अधिकारी ने बताया कि शव को पोस्टमार्टम के लिए भेज दिया गया है और मामले में आवश्यक कार्रवाई की गई है। पुलिस घटना का वास्तविक कारण पता लगाने के लिए सीसीटीवी कैमरे को फुटेज भी खंगाल रही है।

किशोर की करंट लगने से मौत

शनिवार को ही बाहरी दिल्ली के रणहोला इलाके में क्रिकेट खेलते समय बिजली के खंभे के संपर्क में आने से 13 वर्षीय लड़के की मौत हो गई थी। मामले में परिवार के सदस्य और स्थानीय लोगों ने किशोर के शव को सड़क पर रखकर नांगलोई-नजफगढ़ सड़क को बंद कर दिया और परिवार के लिए मुआवजे और न्याय की मांग की।

प्रदर्शनकारियों ने पुलिस और डिस्कॉम (विद्युत कंपनी) के खिलाफ नारेबाजी की परिजनों ने जाम भी लगा दिया बाद में पुलिस के समझाने मामला शांत हुआ। पुलिस ने बताया कि भारतीय न्याय संहिता (बीएनएस) की धारा 106 (1) (लापरवाही से मौत) के तहत प्रारंभिकी दर्ज कर ली गई है और जांच जारी है। इस बीच, मृतक की मां अनिता देवी ने गौशाला और बिजली विभाग के खिलाफ सख्त कार्रवाई की मांग की है।
