Gujarat CM launches portal for e-auction of gifts in toshakhana

GUJARAT CHIEF Minister Bupendra Patel on Tuesday launched an e-auction portal for selling gifts received by him and deposited in 'toshakhana' (government treasury).

Now, people living anywhere in the country can buy these 'toshakhana' gift articles from the online portal, <https://cmgummento.gujarat.gov.in>, said an official release.

Earlier, such gifts were sold through public auctions at state-level gatherings and by district collectors through auctions in areas under their jurisdiction, said the release.

Funds collected by selling these gifts will be utilised by the government towards girl child education, said the release, adding it was Prime Minister Narendra Modi who started this practice when he was the Gujarat CM.

The National Institute of Fashion Technology (NIFT) has been roped in for category-wise classification as well as photography of gifts, whose description will be available in detail in English and Gujarati languages, it said.

To purchase gifts through e-auction, the buyer has to first register themselves on the newly launched portal and then submit a bid for them.

The highest bidder will have to make a payment via digital mode to the Girl Child Education Fund after which the purchased item will be delivered to that person by post, added the release.

Actor Govinda injured after his licensed gun 'misfires', probe on

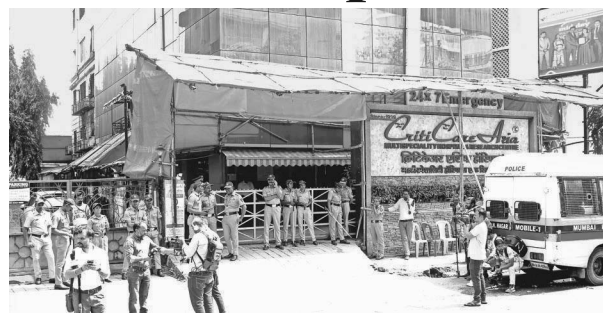

ACTOR AND former MP Govinda was injured after his licensed revolver accidentally went off at his home in Mumbai early on Tuesday. The actor has been hospitalised and is out of danger, said police.

Preliminary inquiry showed that Govinda was in a rush to leave for Kolkata for some work at around 5 am when the trigger of his licensed revolver was accidentally pushed while he was keeping it in the cupboard. The gun misfired and a bullet hit his left leg, the actor told the police in his statement, as per the police sources. He was alone at his Juhu bungalow at the time.

The injured actor was admitted to the nearby Criti Care Hospital by his staff. No one lodged any complaint and currently he is undergoing treatment at the hospital, said a senior police officer.

CM Eknath Shinde said he had reached out to Govinda, and

assured him of all necessary support during his recovery.

"I have personally reached out to Govinda to convey my deep concern about his health condition. On behalf of the government and people of our state, I wish him a speedy and complete recovery," Shinde said.

The Mumbai Police said they have begun an investigation into the incident. The Juhu police said they will record the statement of the actor when he is better. They will also record the statement of

the people who could have been present at his place at the time of the incident. Police have not seized the firearm, an officer said.

In a statement, Govinda said, "Due to your blessings, my parents' blessings, and the grace of my guru... I was shot, but the bullet has been removed. I thank the doctors here, especially Dr Agarwal. Thank you all for your prayers and support." Mumbai Police sources said they may review the firearm licence.

Botad: 2 arrested for 'attempting train derailment to rob passengers'

Botad: Two persons were arrested on Tuesday for allegedly placing an iron rail piece on a railway track in an attempt to derail a train for robbing passengers in Gujarat's Botad district, police said.

The accused, Ramesh Salia and Jayesh Bavalia, allegedly placed a four to five-foot-long iron rail piece vertically on the track near Kundli village on September 25, an official said.

The duo allegedly planned to derail coaches and rob passengers as they were facing financial difficulties, he said.

Botad is around 150 km from Ahmedabad.

As per a release issued by the Botad district police, the accused watched YouTube videos about ways to derail trains before committing the crime.

The engine of the Okha-Bhavnagar passenger train came to a halt after hitting the iron rail piece in the wee hours of September 25. The accused, who are farm labourers, were lying in wait in a cotton field nearby, they said. However, when their plan failed, they fled on their two-

wheeler, police said.

The National Investigation Agency (NIA) and Gujarat Anti-Terrorist Squad (ATS) were called in for the probe with the local police teams, police said.

The police used technical surveillance and human intelligence to zero in on the two men, who went into hiding, they said. The duo was subsequently apprehended and interrogated, police said.

The men were booked under relevant sections of the Bharatiya Nyay Sanhita, Railways Act and Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, the release said.

The incident came a few days after three railway employees were arrested in Surat district for alleged track tampering and alerting authorities about a "sabotage attempt" to take credit for averting a possible tragedy. PTI

Rupani withdraws defamation case against Cong leaders after apology in court

FORMER CHIEF Minister Vijay Rupani has withdrawn a criminal defamation case he had filed against former Leader of Opposition, Sukhran Rathva, his personal assistant and two MLAs, one of whom is now with the BJP, for accusing that his government had changed zoning of plot of land in Rajkot to favour a private firm.

This comes after the four appeared in court on September 26 and tendered a written unconditional apology.

In February 2022, Rathva, Shailesh Parmar and CJ Chavda held a press conference in Gandhinagar, alleging the Gujarat government approved a change in zonation of 111 acres of land belonging to Sahara India Home Corporation on the outskirts of Rajkot on May 28, 2021, when Rupani was the CM and held the portfolio of urban development department. The three leaders alleged that the zoning of the land was changed from residential to industrial, increasing the price of the land. The Congress leaders had alleged that it was a scam worth Rs 500 crore, adding that it was the reason why Rupani was "removed" from the CM's post.

Parmar was then deputy LoP in Gujarat Assembly while Chavda was chief whip of the Congress.

Rupani had denied the allegations. Rupani, who stepped down as CM in September 2021, had stated that the zoning of the area had been changed to promote industrial development of Rajkot.

After the three Congress leaders levelled allegations against Rupani, Ansh Bhadwaj, the former CM's advocate, had served a legal notice to them as well as Rathva's personal assistant Pravin Parmar, seeking public apology. When the Congress leaders didn't respond to the notice, Rupani filed a criminal defamation case in the chief judicial magistrate's

court in Gandhinagar on March 22, 2022.

After they didn't respond to repeated summons, the court issued arrest warrants against the three Congress leaders and rejected their pleas for discharge. Eventually, they appeared in court on September 26. "The four tendered a written unconditional apology, stating that they had no evidence to support allegations they had levelled and that the allegations were politically motivated. The former CM accepted the apology and therefore, we gave a pursis to the court to close the case," Bhardwaj told *The Indian Express* on Tuesday.

While Parmar and Rathva could not be contacted for comment, Chavda said, "We were in the Opposition and made allegations against Rupani based on information provided by others...we could not independently verify facts of the matter. But after we met him, we came to know about the facts and therefore, apologised unconditionally," said Chavda.

Chavda quit Congress earlier this year and joined the BJP. While Parmar managed to retain his Danilimda (SC) Assembly seat in 2022 and continues as deputy leader of the Congress Legislative Party, Rathva lost the elections.

Rupani said that he saw no point in pressing the case after the Congress leaders apologised. "...they apologised in an open court, tending they had no proof to support allegations...The court asked me if the apology was acceptable to me and I said now that they are apologising sincerely, I had no hesitation in accepting it and withdrawing the case," Rupani told *The Indian Express*.
