An Explanatory Statement pertaining to the said resolutions setting out the material facts and the reasons / rationale thereof form part of this Postal Ballot Notice ("the Notice" or "the Postal Ballot Notice").

In compliance with Regulation 44 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("the LODR Regulations") and pursuant to the provisions of Sections 108 and 110 of the Act read with the rules framed thereunder and the MCA Circulars, the manner of voting on the proposed resolution is restricted only to e-voting i.e., by casting votes electronically instead of submitting postal ballot form. Accordingly, the Postal Ballot Notice and instructions for e-voting are being sent only through electronic mode to those members whose email address is registered with the Company / Depository Participant ("DP").

The Board has appointed Ms. Nikita Kothari, Practicing Company Secretary (Membership Number: F10365, CP No. 13507), as the scrutinizer ("Scrutinizer") for conducting the Postal Ballot / e-voting process in a fair and transparent manner. In compliance with the provisions of Sections 108 and 110 of the Act read with Rule 20 and 22 of the Management Rules, Regulation 44 of the LODR Regulations, and SS-2, the Company has provided e-voting facility to its members to cast their votes electronically. The detailed procedure with respect to e-voting is mentioned in this Notice. The Company has engaged the National Securities Depository Limited ("NSDL") for facilitating e-voting. Members desiring to exercise their votes are requested to carefully read the instructions indicated in this Notice and record their assent (FOR) or dissent (AGAINST) by following the procedure as stated in the Notes forming part of the Notice.

In terms of Section 180(1)(a) and 180 (1) (c) of the Companies Act, 2013, the Board of Directors of a Company, shall exercise the power to borrow money, where money to be borrowed, together with the money already borrowed by the Company and to create charge / provide security for the sum borrowed on such terms and conditions and in such form and manner and with such ranking as to priority, as the Board in its absolute discretion thinks fit, on the assets of the Company, as may be agreed to between the Company and the Lenders so as to secure the borrowings by the Company, together with interest costs, charges, expenses and all other monies payable by the Company to the concerned Lenders / Institutions, under the respective arrangements entered into / to be entered by the Company and/or Board exceeding aggregate of its paid-up share capital and free reserves, apart from temporary loans obtained from the Company's bankers in the ordinary course of business only the consent of the Company by passing a Special Resolution.

The Shareholders of the Company in the Extra ordinary General Meeting held on April 29, 2021, had inter-alia passed a Special Resolution to borrow monies for and on behalf of the Company from time to time as deemed by it to be requisite and proper for the business of the Company (apart from temporary loans obtained from the Company's bankers in the ordinary course of business) and remaining outstanding shall not exceed INR 2500 Crores (Rupees Twenty-Five Hundred Thousand Crores Only).

Shareholders may kindly note that there is no change proposed in the Borrowing limits and the current proposal is only reaffirmation and to comply with the requirement of passing of Special Resolution under Section 180 of the Companies Act, 2013.
