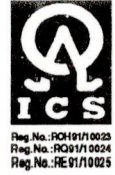

# 900 days and not over yet: Why India is best positioned to play peacemaker in Ukraine war



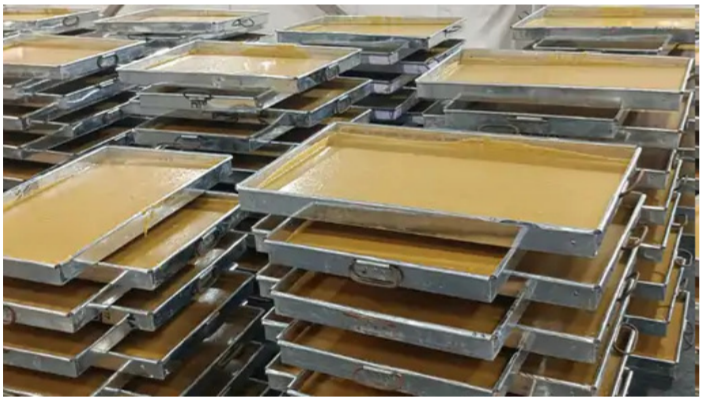
The Ukraine conflict began on August 24, 2024. After over 900 days, nearly a dozen threats of use of tactical nuclear weapons, 500,000 casualties, and expenditure of many 100 billion dollars, there is no end in sight. There are some leaders in the West who are aggressively fuelling the war through rhetorical statements. The US-led West continues to support Ukraine with modern weapons and ammunition. As

Western nations consider permitting Ukraine to strike deeper inside Russian territories, Russia has warned the United States that such thoughts were like playing with fire, and invoked the possibility of World War III and clarified, it would not be just limited to Europe. One of the biggest issues for Russia to go into the war was the prospect of Ukraine joining NATO, which was like the Cuba moment for Moscow. NATO,

which had expanded considerably east since the Warsaw Pact was dismantled in 1991, would have come on Russia's border in case Ukraine were to join. This was a red-line for Russia. Russia managed to successfully circumvent Western sanctions through increased oil and gas sales using alternative currencies. Russia has increased its war stores production, and has been importing arms from China,

Iran, North Korea, among others. While Global South has been recommending caution, India has repeatedly made it clear that "this is not an era of war, but it is one of dialogue and diplomacy". Prime Minister Narendra Modi has recently made back-to-back visits to Russia and Ukraine acting as a peacemaker. What are the ground realities and how can India mediate? The Budapest Memorandum.

This year, the trust is planning to make 1000 ghanas i.e. 3 lakh 25 thousand kg of estuary.

Mohanthal is being made with gram flour, milk, banas ghee, sugar, cardamom. The work of making Mohanthal Prasad has started

in Prasadghar at Ambaji's new college. This Mohanthal is made with gram flour, milk, banana ghee, sugar, cardamom. The work of making Prasad has been started by the artisans working here. After the Prasad is made, it is spread in the chowk. It is then packed in boxes and then placed for sale in the temple and at different Prasad points.

1000 ghan of mohanthal Prasad will be made, it was informed by the administrator of Ambaji temple that abundant mohanthal Prasad will be made for the devotees on the occasion of the Bhadravi Poonam fair at Ambaji this year. Currently 1000 ghanas are being prepared on behalf of Ambaji Trust. In which 1

ghan is equal to 325 kg, thus 3 lakh 25 thousand kg of mohanthal Prasad will be made during the entire fair. Prasad stocking operations have already started and adequate preparations are in place to make more Prasad when more is required. As many as 14 Prasad distribution centers will be set up on Gabbar including Ambaji Mandir. Devotees take home the Prasad of Mohanthal without fail.

Now only a few days are left for the Bhadravi Maha Mela, the district administration under the leadership and guidance of Sri Arasuri Ambaji Mata Devasthan Trust Chairman cum Banaskantha District

Collector is all set to hold the Mela. On the auspicious day of Ganesh Chaturthi, Sri Arasuri Ambaji Mata Devasthan Trust has started making Mohanthal Prasad in a waterproof dome at Ambaji Navi College. Devotees who come to Ambaji for darshan, after having darshan of Mataji, always take Prasad of Mohanthal to their home. Prasad of Mohanthal is a prominent feature of Ambaji temple.

Prasad will be made keeping in mind the number of pilgrims, keeping in mind the number of pilgrims coming to the fair, it is planned to make 1000 ghanas i.e. 3 lakh 25 thousand kilos of Mohanthal during the entire fair.
