Having lung trouble post-Covid?

Go, consult a doctor if you are constantly coughing

Citizens should seek medical help if constant coughing, breathlessness while walking or bleeding during coughing persists in Covid recovered patients

octors in the city are reporting patients who have recovered from Covid complaining of breathless ness, sudden weight loss, perpetual coughing for more than a fortnight and bleeding while coughing. These, doctors say are often symptoms that could turn out to be Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD), lung fibrosis and potentially lung cancer at a later

stage.
Most of the patients showing these symptoms are those who were admitted to hospital during Covid and had to be put on ventilators, BIPAP, ICU or oxygen. Many recovered but complained of breathlessness during jogging, walking or

MD physician Dr Pravin Garg said many patients who have recovered from Covid report breathlessness while run-ning, walking or other such activities. y also cough a lot and bleed while coughing. We refer such cases to pulmo-nologists. Some of these patients were found to be suffering from lung fibrosis or lung cancer," said Dr Garg.

Pulmonologist Dr Shweta Gargiya of Orchids ICU and Hospitals at Satellite said they have treated many post-Covid patients and several of them complained of breathlessness while running or other



arduous tasks. "We found lung cancer in three youths who came to us 10 months after Ćovid recovery," said Dr Gargiya. She said that if a patient continuously suffers from cough for 10 days or more after recovering from Covid, loses weight sud-denly, has blood in cough or has breathlessness while doing routine tasks, it is

important to contact a pulmonologist.

"People often ignore the symptoms and go to a doctor only when the condi-tion deteriorates. By then the problem may get aggravated, particularly in case of lung cancer, and recovery becomes difficult," said Dr Gargiya. that such patients get detected while the cancer is in the first stage," she said.

Former president of Chest Physician Association Dr Narendra Raval said patients who were put on ventilators or oxygen or admitted to a hospital during Covid were found to have pulmonary fibrosis, lung cancer, COPD and other breathing problems post recovery. "It is important that they are diagnosed early," said Dr Raval.

protection to the groom's family and helped him take out the wedding procession. As per initial probe, the procession was not attacked out of any discrimination or grudge against Dalits.

According to District Superintendent of Police Vijay Patel, "To stop unnecessary expenditure on lavish weddings, the village panchayat had passed a resolution six years ago that irrespective of the caste, no family is allowed to take out a procession during weddings. But the groom's family insisted on taking out a procession."

he General Administration Department (GAD) on Thursday gave GH Solanki, Deputy Municipal Commissioner (DyMC) of Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation (AMC) the additional charge as Ahmedabad Urban Development Authority (AUDA)

DP Desai, the AUDA CEO, went on a planned long leave from May 3. The GAD had however not given his charge to anyone as the appointment file for the same was reportedly stuck at the Chief Minister's Office (CMO).

Earlier, Mirror had on May 10 reported about the administrative lacuna resulting in contractual employees not getting their salary for April as well as hundreds of important files remaining stuck due to lack of a signing authority.

After Mirror carried the report, the contractual staff salaries were also immediately released. Salaries worth Rs 14 lakh of around 200 contract employees in AUDA had been pending for April.


Two agencies hire employees on con-



tract for AUDA and money is credited to their account only after it is signed by the concerned AUDA authority. The credited money is then distributed by the

agencies to the staff as salary. But files remained pending as Desai was on leave and no one had the authority to clear the files.

Mirror in its story had also mentioned that a deputy municipal commissioner of AMC will be given the additional charge as AUDA CEO as whoever is appointed to the post needs to be junior to Lochan Sehran, the Auda Chairman and appoint-ing a DyMC will help in easy coordination of day to day operations too

Another reason for the delay in appointment was that AUDA is an important department that handles a

> lot of development-related decisions, and the Chief Minister's Office (CMO) wanted to ensure that the additional charge is given to someone

With the appointment, there is a possibility that the development of phase-2 of the Sabarmati Riverfront near Motera and other related projects like the Sports Complex and bridges will be set in motion.
