**Instructor eligibility**  
Educational Qualification: The desirable qualification required to become an Adventure Sports Instructor is the 12th class with Physical



Education as one of the subjects (it is not compulsory although) followed by certification from any Adventure sports institute.

**Important:** Good swimming skills are mandatory for water-based sports. Also, proficiency in English or some foreign languages can be handy to handle foreign Adventure Sports enthusiasts.

Adventure Sports Instructors Required Skills: Adventure Sports Instructors must have an enthusiasm for sports, excellent communication skills, the ability to inspire confidence and motivate participants. They should have determination and patience, good organizational skills, a

sensitive and supportive approach. They should have physical stamina and a commitment to sports participation for all.

**How to become an Adventure Sports Instructor?** There is no formal qualification required for those aspirants who themselves have been involved with Adventure sports as players. Former and senior adventure sports persons can get the job as Assistant Sports Instructors (after getting necessary certification or licence) owing to their knowledge and experience of the sport as a player.

With some experience in the field as assistants, they can alleviate to the upper position as main instructors or chief instructors in due course

of time. However, those aspirants who have the non-playing background but are energetic and have good knowledge of sport can undergo formal training and get into this field as instructors by following below given steps:

**Step 1** Interested candidate has to join some adventure sports institute or clubs like National Institute of Water Sports and Nehru Institute of Mountaineering to do Short Term adventure sports courses offered by them.

**Step 2** Once they have done with the training successfully they are provided certification or licenses that enable them to be eligible for becoming Adventure

Sports Instructors.

Besides this, he encourages campers and staff to try new sports, participate in other aspects of camp life. An Adventure Sports Instructor has to perform all those duties that may be assigned to him by the Adventure/Sports Director, Village Director, Program Coordinator or Camp Director.

**Career prospects**  
Enormous employment opportunities are available for Adventure Sports Instructors in private as

well as public sector organizations. They can get a job in Excursion agencies, Holiday resorts, leisure camps and commercial recreation centres besides Sports centres and athletic clubs. ## Scars of partition still haunt sub-continent

The partition of India, in 1947 holds significance in the history of South Asia. It was influenced by factors such as escalating tensions between Muslims and Hindus in the adoption of the Pakistan Resolution by the All-India Muslim League in 1940 and the failure of the Cabinet Mission Plan in 1946. This division was accompanied by violence, communal riots, and cruel acts that affected the communities involved. Muhammad Ali Jinnah, a figure in the All-India Muslim League played a role in facilitating India's partition and advocating for the creation of a separate Muslim state.

During a three-day session held in Lahore on March 23 1940 known as the Pakistan Resolution or Lahore Resolution, it was proposed by the All-India Muslim League. The resolution aimed to establish states with sovereign constituent units in regions where Muslims were a majority. This marked the beginning of demanding a state and significantly influenced the decision to divide

British India into two independent nations; India and Pakistan.

Jinnah's insistence on establishing a state played a role, in dividing British India into two independent nations; India and Pakistan. When British India was officially partitioned on August 15 1947 Jinnah assumed leadership as the Governor General of Pakistan.

The ongoing debate surrounding Jinnah's role in the partition is a matter of contention. Some perceive him as a hero fighting for rights while others view him differently, for the violence and atrocities that happened during that time. The division of India in 1947 had a lasting impact on the subcontinent resulting in violent clashes between communities and loss of life. Millions of Hindus, Muslims, and Sikhs were compelled to leave their homes and seek refuge in either India or Pakistan based on their identity. The partition witnessed horrifying acts such as massacres, sexual violence, and extensive destruction of property leaving behind a legacy that continues to affect

generations. Furthermore, this division sparked tensions and conflicts between India and Pakistan leading to wars and territorial disputes. Cultural practices, languages, and traditions faced challenges as people adjusted to their affiliations. The scars from the partition remain deeply embedded in the memory of both nations. Efforts towards reconciliation and cross-border exchanges are ongoing, as part of the healing process.

It is worth noting that the partition resulted

in one of history's forced migrations. Estimates range from 14 million to 20 million people being displaced during this period. This mass migration was accompanied by violence, communal riots, and appalling acts that profoundly impacted all communities involved. The division, between India and Pakistan, created during the partition has led to an atmosphere of hostility and suspicion.

In August 1946 the Muslim League opted for Direct Action as a

means to secure their demand for Pakistan, which ultimately resulted in the partition of India. The absence of law and order from March 1947 onwards played a role in this process. To promote peace within the community Gandhiji made efforts by visiting Noakhali and Calcutta to provide reassurance to the minority population.

Mountbatten's partition plan aimed at preventing a war by anticipating that dividing India would result in bloodshed compared to a united nation.
