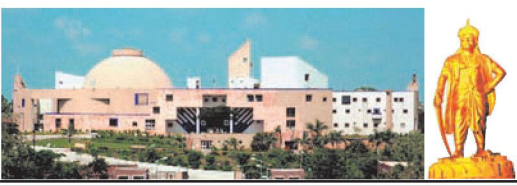

SANT RAVIDAS WILL BLESS ME TO INAUGURATE HIS TEMPLE, SAYS PRIME MINISTER MODI

Modi performs ground-breaking ceremony for the Sant Ravidas Memorial and Art Gallery in Sagar. Sant Shiromani Shri Ravidas was a symbol of social harmony. Kota-Bina double rail line dedicated to people

The Prime Minister Narendra Modi said that Saint Shri Ravidas was a symbol of social harmony. He eradicated social evils and awakened society. India is progressing on the path of liberation from the mental slavery, following the path shown by him. Sagar is experiencing social harmony today. The foundation stone for the Sant Ravidas Memorial and Art Gallery has been laid, which will be grand and divine. A new era of social harmony is beginning in Madhya Pradesh for which he congratulated the Chief Minister Chouhan and the people of the state. Modi said that when it is completed in a year and a half, I will surely come for its inauguration. He was addressing a public gathering after the ground-breaking ceremony of the Sant Shri Ravidas memorial and Art Gallery at Sagar district's Badduma at Dhaana. The Prime Minister dedicated to people the Kota-Bina double rail line. He also laid the foundation stone for two road projects costing over Rs. 1580 crores. The Prime Minister emphasized that the teachings of Sant Shri

Ravidas Ji will inspire the new generation through this memorial site. The spirit of harmony will prevail here. He praised the efforts of collecting soil from around 20 thousand villages and nearly 300 rivers bringing it to Sagar for this project, saying that this initiative represents social harmony and unity. The Samrasata Yatras concluding today in fact marks the beginning of a new era. Modi further explained that inspiration and progress go hand in hand, leading to beginning of a new era. Madhya Pradesh deserves praise for this. Madhya Pradesh is progressing fast. He said that Sant Shri Ravidas Ji was visionary. He was born in an era when the Mughal rule prevailed, and society was facing injustices. He worked for awakening of the society, fighting against evils, and guiding those entangled in caste distinctions. There were numerous constraints in society. He gave society a courage to fight. Prime Minister said that Sant Ravidas Ji's thoughts are inspiring to eradicate poverty and hunger in contemporary times. During the pandemic, the government launched the Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna



Yojana (PMGKAY) to provide free food to over 80 crore Indians who were vulnerable due to the pandemic. He highlighted that the maximum beneficiaries of the schemes for the welfare of the poor in the country are the socially and economically marginalized, the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, and the downtrodden. He affirmed that the nation stands by them at every step of life, supporting their aspirations. He cited the example of the Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana, which provides financial assistance of Rs. 6,000 to newborns and their mothers. The Ayushman Bharat Scheme ensures free healthcare for newborns and their vaccination. Efforts to control diseases, including sickle cell anemia have been launched. The government aims for a tuberculosis-free India by 2025. Similar work is being carried out to control other diseases that plague the marginalized and impoverished. The Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana ensures housing for every poor person. The Prime Minister said that the education facilities have been augmented by the establishment of 701 Eklavya Model Schools, provision of

textbooks, mid-day meals for students, and the Sukanya Samridhi Yojana for the empowerment of the girl child. Scholarships are provided to economically weaker sections for higher education, and the Mudra Yojana fosters self-reliance among the youth. The Stand-Up India scheme has already provided financial assistance to over 8 crore beneficiaries. The Jan Dhan Yojana is benefiting millions of people. Modi reiterated that every poor person should have a house. For this, housing schemes and free electricity and water connections have been provided. The less fortunate sections of society are now standing on their own feet thanks to these initiatives. The temple of Sant Ravidas will be constructed in Sagar at a cost of Rs 100 crore to be provided by the state government. A Sangrahalay (museum) will also be constructed at the temple premises. Meanwhile, Modi also launched some other development projects in poll-bound Madhya Pradesh, including the re-development of the Kota (Rajasthan)-Beena (Madhya Pradesh) railway line.

'Commission controversy': Congress, BJP trade barbs at each other

Bhopal: The alleged 'commission' controversy has also hit poll-bound Madhya Pradesh where both the Congress and BJP have accused each other of taking 'commissions' from the contractors. Congress leader Arun Yadav posted a letter on his social media account claiming that a Gwalior-based contractor has written to Madhya Pradesh High Court and has alleged that after completing the government project, he has been forced to pay 50 per cent commission to reclaim his payment. Congress General Secretary Priyanka Gandhi, who is leading the party's poll campaign in Madhya Pradesh, also wrote a long note on her social media account. "The Union of Contractors in Madhya Pradesh has written a letter to the Chief Justice of the High Court complaining that payment is received only after paying 50 per cent commission in the state," read Priyanka's message. She further pointed out that the BJP government in Karnataka used to collect 40 per cent commission and that "In Madhya Pradesh, BJP has gone ahead by breaking its own record of corruption. The people of Karnataka ousted the government with 40 per cent



commission, now the people of Madhya Pradesh will remove the BJP government with 50 per cent commission from power." MP BJP unit Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan, State Home Minister Narottam Mishra and the party's head for MP unit V. D. Sharma attacked Congress saying that the controversial letter is 'fake'. V.D. Sharma warned of action against Congress General Secretary Priyanka Gandhi over her allegations. MP Home Minister Narottam Mishra also

responded to the allegations and accused Congress of playing politics "with a disgusting mentality" without any issue. "This is a conspiracy and BJP will take action for this tweet under cybercrime... She will have to tell from where did she get this letter. You (Priyanka Gandhi) misled not only Madhya Pradesh, but the country on the basis of a fake letter," V. D. Sharma said. "Congress leadership will have to give an answer on this. We will take legal action in this regard."

Kamal Nath hits back at BJP for questioning his religious belief

Bhopal: Madhya Pradesh Congress president Kamal Nath on Saturday hit back at the ruling BJP, saying worried of losing the assembly polls, the saffron party has started questioning his "religious belief". In a series of tweets, Kamal Nath, the former chief minister, posted in Hindi: "Nowadays BJP people are more concerned about my faith and belief. The BJP leaders are coining new words like election worship and political hypocrisy and boast of breaking the spell of my magic, It suggest that nothing comes in the mind and heart of BJP people except me." "Instead of chanting my name, the government, its representatives and the BJP should chant the name of the people, worship people as in the country, public is 'Janardan'."



"In the interest of the public, the BJP government is requested to break the

spell of inflation, unemployment, corruption, 50 per cent commission and crime against women." Kamal Nath's remarks came days after the state BJP leaders, especially state Home Minister Narottam Mishra and state unit chief V. D. Sharma, launched scathing attack on him, saying that he organised four-day 'Ram Katha' by Bageshwar Dham chief Dharendra Shastri in Chhindwara last week, due to the upcoming elections. The saffron party charged that Kamal Nath becomes Hindu before elections. The BJP leaders alleged that the Congress wanted to cash in on the popularity of the controversial self-styled godman. Kamal Nath always say he had constructed a huge size temple of Lord Hanuman in his home district Chhindwara.

I may not have contested LS polls had Arjun Singh not insisted: Kamal Nath

Madhya Pradesh Congress president Kamal Nath on Saturday said he had not contested the Lok Sabha election had the former chief minister (late) Arjun Singh not insisted him to contest the election. Kamal Nath said that Arjun Singh told him that he has already spoken to Indra Gandhi and Sanjay Gandhi. "He told me I am not seeking your permission just instructing you to get ready to contest Lok Sabha election," Kamal Nath said while launching a book titled 'Vindhya Ki Beti: Muhawaro Se Jhalaki Mamta'. The book is dedicated to Arjun Singh's wife Saroj Singh. The programme was organised by Arjun Singh Arjun Singh Sadbhavna Foundation at Bhopal's

Ravindra Bhavan. Kamal Nath recalled the political developments occurred during Arjun Singh's era, including the incident when he was appointed the Punjab governor and Motilal Vohra was appointed Madhya Pradesh chief minister. Kamal Nath also recalled how Arjun Singh's wife Saroj Singh stayed in Chhindwara for three weeks and worked hard to ensure his first Lok Sabha election in 1980. Kamal Nath has been elected nine times as MP from his home district Chhindwara. His son Nakul Nath is the only MP from Madhya Pradesh. The book 'Vindhya Ki Beti: Muhawaro Se Jhalaki Mamta' is collection of more than 150 proverbs in Bagheli dialect (Bagheli is local dialect in part of Vindhya region also called Baghelkhand-

Rewa, Sidhi, Satna, Shahdol, Singrauli etc.) Saroj Singh was born in Rewa and lived with her maternal grandmother in Burma. According to her daughter Veena Singh, who is now the head of Arjun Singh Arjun Singh Sadbhavna Foundation, Saroj Singh often used to utter 'Bagheli Muhavras' while speaking to the people at home. "All the proverbs my mother used to say have been mentioned in the book with detailed meaning and explanation. People talk a lot about my father but my mother has played a prominent role. After coming back from Bruma at the age of six or seven, she lived in Amethi (Uttar Pradesh) to live with her Masi (sister of her mother). I therefore, decided to convert the collection of her proverbs into a book," Veena Singh said.
