Amazon seen triumphing over Apple privacy changes in digital ad business

AMAZON IS EXPECTED to emerge as a winner in the digital advertising arena, surviving Apple's privacy changes better than rivals Facebook and Snap.

The ecommerce giant's vast trove of customer shopping data reduces its reliance on tracking info once provided by Apple's iOS mobile operating system.

Others including Alphabet, which also collects a rich set of data from users' search habits, reported a 41% surge in Google advertising revenue for the third quarter, a sign that businesses that rely less on targeted ads are able to overcome Apple's limits on tracking mobile users.

Amazon, which reports earnings on Thursday, does not break out its advertising sales, but nestles it in its "other" business segment.

"Google and Amazon therefore aren't as reliant on cookies," Eduardo Cruz, per-

formance marketing manager at SupplyKick.

"For brands selling a physical product, Amazon Ads are a powerful way to drive purchases, increase product consideration, and reach customers."

Apple's advertising business has surged since it prevented advertisers from tracking iPhone users without their consent in April, eating into market share once occupied by Facebook, Instagram and Snap.

The iPhone maker will report fourth-quarter results on Thursday.

Most Facebook users access the social networking platform through a mobile device, with nearly 15% of adults using iPhones and iPads in July, according to data firm Data Reportal.

Twitter, which relies on targeted ads but not as

much as Facebook, reported advertising revenue in line with estimates.

Wall Street analysts said since the majority of advertising on Twitter comes from Brands, especially services or digital, as opposed to Direct ads, the company was better positioned to overcome the privacy changes than Facebook or Snap.

To be sure, the digital advertising market is still booming exponentially as the pandemic led to more consumers shopping online and spending more time on social media. Like Facebook and Snap, Google's YouTube saw a modest hit, the company said, primarily in direct-response advertising.

"This is the early innings of a shift that will play out over several quarters," Andrew Lipsman, eMarketer principal analyst at Insider Intelligence, said.

"The strength that we've seen in the past few quarters has remained, but it is starting to shift a little bit between the different players."

India successfully test fires Agni-5 missile from Odisha coast



INDIA SUCCESSFULLY TEST fired surface to surface ballistic missile, Agni-5, from APJ Abdul Kalam Island of the Odisha coast here on Wednesday, according to a defence statement.

The missile, which uses a three-stage solid fuelled engine, is capable of striking targets at ranges up to 5,000 kilometres with a very high degree of accuracy, they said.

The successful test of Agni-5 is in line with India's stated policy to have 'credible minimum deterrence' that underpins the commitment to 'No First Use', the statement said.

The missile launching was carried out approximately at 7.50 pm.

Indian-origin Singaporean fined for hosting in-laws' wedding dinner during Covid restrictions

AN INDIAN-ORIGIN Singaporean was fined SGD3,000 for hosting a dinner involving at least 20 people to celebrate his in-laws' wedding anniversary on April 10 despite prevailing Covid-19 laws that barred groups of more than eight people from gathering in public.

Ganesan Angudan, 39, pleaded guilty to one count of breaching the Covid-19 (Temporary Measures) (Control Order) Regulations 2020 on Tuesday, TODAY newspaper reported.

The court heard that on April 3, after deciding to hold the dinner, he booked a multi-purpose event space at Lotus@Norris in

the Little India precinct for use a week later.

He paid the owner SGD7,000 for the booking and invited about 30 people, including friends and relatives.

At the time, restrictions under the third phase of Singapore's gradual reopening after a semi-lockdown were in place. These included a cap of eight people gathering in public.

At about 7pm on April 10, he gathered with at least 20 people who were not from his household for the dinner celebration, which went on for three hours.

The guests were seated at tables of about five to six people, but there was no 1m safe distancing between them and they intermingled freely between different tables.

Some guests were also unmasked even when they were not drinking or eating.

China developers propose debt rejig, maturity extension to regulators

SOME CHINESE PROPERTY developers have proposed extending their offshore bond maturities or undertaking a debt restructuring in a meeting with regulators, sources said, as a wave of defaults shakes investor confidence in the sector.

The meeting underlines the behind-the-scenes efforts by China's debt-laden developers and regulators to contain the fallout centred around embattled China Evergrande Group.

The developers made the proposals at a meeting jointly held by China's National Development and Reform Commission (NDRC) and the State Administration for Foreign Exchange (SAFE) on Tuesday, said two sources with direct knowledge of the matter, who asked not to be named because of its sensitivity. SAFE and NDRC did not respond to Reuters' requests for comment.

It was not immediately clear which developers made the proposals, and what decision the regulators would settle on.

The regulators, however, told developers facing large offshore debt maturities to evaluate their repayment risks and report difficulties,



the sources said.

The regulators also asked the unnamed companies in the meeting to proactively prepare for repayment of both principal and interest on their foreign bonds and to "jointly maintain their own reputations and the overall order of the market," NDRC said in a statement late on Tuesday.

Evergrande, once China's top-selling developer, is reeling under more than \$300 billion in liabilities, fuelling worries about the impact of its fate on the world's second-largest economy and on global markets.

Evergrande narrowly averted a costly default last week by securing \$83.5 million for the last-minute payment of interest on a bond, boosting confidence the company may be able to avoid a messy collapse.

The developer now needs to find \$47.5 million by Friday, and has nearly \$338 million in other offshore coupon payments

coming up in November and December.

Broader concerns about China's real estate sector, which accounts for a quarter of its gross domestic product, still loom large for investors and Chinese policymakers.

The meeting with the regulators took place in Beijing on Tuesday against the backdrop of several bond defaults in the sector. Developers Fantasia Holdings Group, Sinic Holdings and Modern Land all defaulted on their maturing dollar bonds this month.

"Developers were asked to report in great details about all their offshore bond repayment plans; they need to voice out if there are particular payments (for which) they're seeing some difficulties in repayment," one of the sources said.

Rating agency S&P said on Wednesday defaults in the Chinese property sector are rising, with some \$84 billion of onshore and offshore bonds due over the next five quarters and the first peak of debt payments due in January 2022.

Steven Leung, director of brokerage UOB Kay Hian based in Hong Kong, said that by initiating this kind of meeting with developers, regulators were sending a positive signal to the market that they are handling the risks.

Not seeking an arms race with China but won't submit to pressure, says Taiwan

TAIWAN IS NOT seeking to get into an arms race with China but does need to defend itself and will not submit to pressure, its defence ministry said in a report to parliament on Wednesday.

Tensions between Taiwan and China, which claims the democratically-governed island as its own territory, have spiked over the past year as Beijing ups its military and political pressure to force Taipei to accept Chinese sovereignty.

That has included repeated missions by Chinese warplanes in Taiwan's air defence identification zone, or ADIZ, which covers a broader area than Taiwan's territorial air space which Taiwan monitors and patrols to give it more time to respond to any threats.

China is in the midst of a military modernisation



programme, building new aircraft carriers and stealth fighters, while Taiwan is also increasing military spending, especially on developing new missiles and submarines.

In its report to parliament, Taiwan's Defence Ministry described the situation in the Taiwan Strait that separates it from its giant neighbour as "severe and unstable" and labelled the actions of China's military "provocation".

"Taiwan will not engage in an arms race with the Chinese Communists' military and will not seek military confrontation, hoping

for peaceful coexistence across the strait," it said.

"But in the face of the Chinese Communists' threat to our national security, we will do our best to defend our country's sovereignty and will never give in under duress."

What it termed the "confrontation" between Taiwan and China would be "difficult to alleviate in the short term".

The military will strive to hone its abilities to monitor Chinese aircraft and ships so it can react earlier, and will also exchange intelligence with foreign countries so it can be fully informed of the regional security situation, it added.

Speaking earlier on Wednesday in Beijing, a Chinese government spokesman reiterated their determination to prevent Taiwan's formal independence and bring the island under China's rule, preferably peacefully.

Anonymity no more? Age checks come to the web

RICHARD ERRINGTON CLICKED to stream a science-fiction film from his home in Britain last month when YouTube carded him.

The site said Errington, who is over 50, needed to prove he was old enough to watch "Space Is the Place," a 1974 movie starring the jazz musician Sun Ra. He had three options: Enter his credit card information, upload a photo identification like a passport or skip the video.

"I decided that it wasn't worth the stress," he said.

In response to mounting pressure from activists, parents and regulators who believe tech companies haven't done enough to protect children online, businesses and governments around the globe are placing major parts of the internet behind stricter digital age checks.

People in Japan must provide a document proving their age to use the dating app Tinder. The popular game Roblox requires players to upload a form of government identification — and a selfie to prove the ID belongs to them — if they want access to a voice chat feature. Laws in Germany and France require pornography websites to check visitors' ages.

The changes, which have picked up speed over the last two years, could upend one of the internet's central traits: the ability to remain anonymous. Since the days of dial-up modems and AOL chat rooms, people could traverse huge swaths of the web without divulging any personal details. Many people created an online persona entirely separate from their offline one.

But the experience of communicating content and communicating online is increasingly less like an anonymous public square and more like going to the bank, with measures to prove that you are who you say you are. This month, lawmakers in Washington, which has lagged other world capitals in regulating tech companies, called for new rules to protect young people after a former Facebook employee said the company knew its products harmed some teenagers. They repeated those calls on Tuesday in a hearing with executives from YouTube, TikTok and the parent company of Snapchat.

Critics of the age checks say that in the name of keeping people safe, they could endanger user privacy, dampen free expression and hurt communities that benefit from anonymity online. Authoritarian governments have used protecting children as an argument for limiting online speech: China barred websites this summer from ranking celebrities by popularity as part of a larger crackdown on what it says are the pernicious effects of celebrity culture on young people.

"Are we going to start seeing more age verification? Of course," said Hany Farid, a professor of engineering and computer science at the University of California, Berkeley, who has called for more child safety measures. "Because there is more pressure, there's more awareness now, on how these technologies are harming kids."

But, Farid said, regulators and companies need to proceed with caution. "We don't want the solution to be more harmful than the problem," he said. —NYT
