22-year-old youngster loses arm in 'fatka' incident at Diva

A 22-year-old man lost his arm in a 'fatka' incident at the Diva railway station earlier this week, according to officials.

Shashikant Kumar, a resident of Navi Mumbai, was attacked just as the train was pulling out of the platform, the officials said, adding that the attacker wanted to steal his mobile phone.

The incident occurred around midnight Monday on Platform 2. Kumar was returning home from Badlapur after visiting a relative and was travelling on the footboard of a slow Mumbai-bound local train. It is suspected that the attacker was

also travelling in the same train and had got down before the local halted.

"Just as the train started to leave the platform, the accused lunged at the victim and hit him on his hand, making him lose his grip on the mobile phone that he was holding. The victim lost his balance and fell off the moving train while trying to reclaim his handset. However, his left hand got trapped in between the train and the platform and was severed elbow down," an official at the Thane GRP was quoted as saying.

A group of passengers at the station managed to nab the accused and handed him over to the police while the duty policeman took the bleeding victim to the hospital, where he was recuperating in the ICU.

The victim had lost consciousness due to the bleeding and his statement was recorded the following day, informed an official.

Geo-polymer tech for SoBo arch drains

The BMC has undertaken major maintenance work of century-old storm water arch drains in south Mumbai at an estimated cost of Rs416 crore. Geo-polymer technology is being used for the first time to avoid digging and trenching of the road surface.

The underground arch-drains were constructed during the British era. Now old and dilapidated, they face risk of collapsing and hence road cave-ins. In 2022, the civic body conducted a survey to assess their structural condition, after which it was decided to use a geo-polymer coating on their walls. The geo-polymer lining (GL) technology applies a chemical-based lining on the corroded walls to prevent water leak and any damage to roads.

"As these drains are either arch-shaped or horse-shoe shaped, the coating will be applied on the inner walls. The polymer coating will also make their surface smooth and ensure uninterrupted flow of water. The work is expected to be completed in the

next three years," said a civic official.

The repair work of drains has been undertaken at 27 locations on a 14km stretch - Churchgate, Colaba, Fort, PD'Mello road, Shimla House, Senapati Bapat Marg, Dadar and Matunga. The contractor will be responsible for five-year maintenance, including desilting during monsoon.

In 2012, a road cave-in at Pedder Road led to massive traffic disruption in south Mumbai. It was replaced by the BMC only after three years.

Kharghar coastal road plan put on ice

Stating that the proposed coastal road between Jalmarg-16, Kharghar and Sector 11 in CBD-Belapur and the balance link from Sector 15, CBD to Water Transport Terminal in Nerul would lead to considerable damage to the mangroves, the Expert Appraisal Committee (EAC) of the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change (MoEF&CC) has deferred the proposal.

The committee also advised the City and Industrial Development Corporation (CIDCO) to consider the three alternate alignments and change in the structural design of the proposed road.

Deliberating the proposal based on the information provided / presented by CIDCO, the committee, at a recent meeting, also asked the CIDCO administration to consider constructing long span bridge / cable-stayed bridges with minimal destruction of mangroves as already approved by the EAC for other projects. The EAC also suggested to submit road design detailed information, traffic plan along with noise barrier plan and proposed parking plan.

In response, CIDCO has agreed to assess the alternate alignments of the proposed coastal road and structural change in proposed design.

₹4,000cr MD seizure: UK link, hunt for Indian-origin suspect

Drugs concealed in food packets and smuggled to London

Investigation into the Pune's biggest-ever seizure of mephedrone has revealed that the banned drug was being smuggled to London through a courier firm in Delhi after being concealed in ready-to-eat food packets, an official said on Wednesday.

The police have so far seized approximately 1,700 kilograms of MD from Pune and a couple of locations in Delhi. Eight people - including Vaibhav Mane, Ajay Karsiya, Haider Shaikh, Bhimaji Sable, Divesh Bhutiyia, Sandeep kumar and Yuvraj Bhujbal - have been arrested and their linkages are being investigated, Pune Police Commissioner Amitesh Kumar said.

They were produced in the sessions court on Wednesday and sent to eight days' police custody, he said. The police is also searching for a man of India origin named 'Sam', who holds a British passport, the official said.

"In the ongoing searches, our team has seized 720 kilograms of mephedrone in Pune, out of which around 600kg was recovered from a manufacturing unit located in Kurkumbh MIDC area on Pune-Solapur Road on the city outskirts. In the ongoing operation in Delhi, so far 970kg mephedrone has been recovered. The approximate value of the total contraband is estimated to be between Rs3,000 crore and Rs3,500 crore," Kumar said.

In the Delhi seizure, a courier firm's name cropped up, he added.

"We have learned that some contraband was sent to London through a Delhi-based courier company after being

concealed in ready-to-eat processed food packets," Kumar said, adding that one person from this courier firm has been detained. The entire quantity of this drug was being manufactured at the unit based in Kurkumbh MIDC, Kumar added.

He also said that besides Delhi and Pune operations, another operation is underway in Sangli where some quantity of drugs has been seized.

"So far, we have arrested eight people. Multiple teams of the Pune police have been positioned in various parts of the country in connection with the case," he said.

Kumar said the police had started the investigation with the seizure of mephedrone worth Rs 2 crore, which has now reached around 1,700kg. "We have unravelled the national and international ramifications in the case. The police teams are working hard to destroy the supply chain in the present case."

Broker under scrutiny in ₹8.6cr diamond fraud

The Bandra-Kurla Complex police are thoroughly investigating diamond broker Mehul Zaveri's role in cheating nine diamond traders of Rs8.68 crore. The traders were allegedly lured by promises of profitable diamond sales at favourable prices. Among the complainants is Anand Shah, 47, a businessman with a diamond buying and selling unit based in

Tardeo. Shah's company operates from the Bharat Diamond Bourse in Bandra-Kurla Complex.

Zaveri, 45, established a business relationship with Shah, gaining his trust before executing the fraud. On January 16, he visited Shah's office, claiming to have a potential diamond buyer requiring a substantial quantity. Shah handed over diamonds totalling 339.83 carats valued at Rs1.73 crore, with Zaveri

committing to payment within 10 days.

However, Zaveri failed to fulfil his promise and, instead, requested more diamonds from Shah, who declined until the initial transaction was settled. Subsequently, Zaveri's mobile

phone became inaccessible from January 30. Upon investigation, it was discovered that he had employed a similar deceitful tactic with other businessmen.

BKC police officials revealed that Zaveri duped a total of nine businessmen, involving diamonds valued at Rs8.68 crore. The affected diamond traders collectively filed a complaint against Zaveri, accusing him of embezzlement in the diamond trade.

CHARUL SHAH JOSHI / MUMBAI

The special Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act (NDPS) court on Wednesday sentenced a Zimbabwe national to 10 years in jail and imposed a fine of Rs2 lakh for carrying 8.5kg of methamphetamine and heroin while traveling from Zimbabwe to Mumbai in 2022.

Rosie Diamon was held on February 12, 2022, by the intelligence unit of the Customs department after a tip-off. The officer kept a watch on all the passengers, checked Diamon's trolley bag and found several file folders

Woman was held on February 12, 2022, after a tip-off

with pages lined with a yellowish powder, granules and white crystals. She was formally arrested the next day.

The court began the trial in June 2023, wherein Diamon pleaded not guilty and said that her cousin, who is a part of a gang in Zimbabwe, lured her with money and asked to carry a bag to India and bring back medical equipment.

Special judge AV Kharkar observed that the accused didn't deny that the contra-

band was recovered from the bag found in her possession. In her written arguments, she submitted who handed the bag to her. "In such a case, the court will have to presume that the contraband's possession was a conscious one," the court said.

The prosecution sought a maximum punishment of 20 years under the law for bringing narcotics to India in commercial quantities. Diamon, however, pleaded for leniency and contended that she had no idea about the bag's contents. She said she is from a poor family and has young children.
