# Dealing premium does not affect insurance cover: HC

Says if insurer finds agent delayed payment, it should initiate action

The Madras Bench of the Madras High Court, in a case pertaining to an insurance claim, has said a delay in receiving the insurance amount by the firm does not affect the insurance coverage of an insurer. The court added that the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal in Thanjavur had erred in asking the agent to pay the amount by endorsing the insurance company. Justice R Vijayakumar said the insurance policy had accepted the renewal premium, received and credited by their agent. The contention of the company that their agent was not authorised to receive renewal premium is not legally sustainable. Certainly, there is a fault on the part of the agent in re-

mitting the insurance amount to the company. The insurance company cannot get exonerated for the fault committed by its own agent, it said, adding that if the company finds their agent was negligent in belatedly remitting the amount, it is for the insurance company to initiate independent proceedings. The court said the insurance company does not have any power whatsoever to postpone the date of commencement of the policy after receipt of the premium either directly or through their agent. "The only fault on the part of the agent is that having received the premium, he has not remitted it to the company in time. The insurance agent does not fall under any one of the categories of section 168 of the Motor Vehicles Act, which says either the driver, owner or the insurance company can be charged with liability to pay compensation. The insurance agent cannot be treated insurer for passing an award," the court said.

# TUSKER IN KOVAI Plans to tranquilise 'Baahubali' called off by forest dept officials

THE plan to tranquilise elephant 'Baahubali' (MP2071) to provide treatment for its own injury, has been called off by the animal health department officials and its health condition is improving. The forest department has taken this decision based on the recommendation by a team of five veterinarians, led by A Sukumar, Coimbatore forest veterinary officer. The team observed the animal's mouth from 20m distance and ruled out that the injury was due to biting Avuttukali (country-made bomb). Joseph Stalin, Forest Range Officer of Mettupalayam, said, "The animal could have been injured following a fight with another tusker or while eating some sharp barks. Initially, the animal had blood loss from its mouth due to which it could not eat properly. But in the past one week, the animal is drinking water and consuming grass without any issues and its eating habit is improving as it is consuming bamboo, Koonthapanal, banana, arca nut, mango and jackfruit, without any issues. All other health parameters are also in good condition." Sources said though the tranquillising has been called off, the veterinarian team has recommended the field staff to provide fruits laced with medicines to cure the injury.

# Linking BPL cards to acc numbers is a huge task: K'taka food officials

WITH the state government deciding to give money per tonne of additional 5kg of rice per beneficiary under the Anna Bhaagya scheme from July 1, officials at the Department of Food and Civil Supplies seemed clueless as to how to provide the money into the accounts of beneficiaries as their Below Poverty Line (BPL) cards do not have bank and PAN card details. The Congress government, unable to procure required rice for the guarantee scheme promised before the Assembly meeting, decided at its cabinet meeting on Wednesday that 834 will be given instead of 1 kg of rice till the rice procurement issue is resolved. Under Anna Bhaagya, each person is eligible for 5kg of rice which costs ₹170 per month. After the cabinet meeting, Chief Minister Siddaramaiah said, "We had promised to give rice from July 1. We need 2.29 lakh metric tonnes of rice every month. But till we get the required quantity, we will pay ₹170 per beneficiary per month." The government needs ₹750-800 crore per month to implement the scheme, covering over 85 lakh BPL card holders. A senior department official told TNIE that a BPL card has the name of the cardholder, names of the beneficiaries in the family, Aadhaar card number, address and other details. But it does not have the bank or PAN card details. "Neither do we have the data at the backend. We don't know how to release the money to beneficiaries. We are waiting for the government's order," he said. Unlike the Gruha Jyothi or Gruha Lakshmi guarantee scheme, the state government has not initiated any application procedure for Anna Bhaagya, nor is it developing any app, he said. "It may not be possible to send money immediately as linking BPL cards and account numbers is a huge task" he added.

# Power to drop a minister lies only with CM

THE communiqué also said there are reasonable apprehensions that the continuation of Balaji in the council of ministers would adversely impact the process of law including a fair investigation, which might eventually lead to a breakdown of the constitutional machinery in the state. "Under these circumstances, the governor has dismissed Balaji from the council of ministers with immediate effect," the statement said. Significantly, the governor dismissed Balaji three days after the Madras High Court refused to pass any orders on PIL petitions which sought the removal of Balaji from the cabinet. The HC refused to pass any order without strong evi-

dence to show that the government had directed the minister to quit. On May 31, the governor wrote a letter to the chief minister advising him to drop Balaji from the cabinet citing the SC's directive to continue the investigation into the charges against him. However, Stalin refused to accept this and recommended that portfolios of Balaji be reallocated to Thangam Thirumani and S Mathiasamy and that Balaji would continue as a minister without a portfolio until he recovers from his illness. On June 16, the governor approved the reallocation of portfolios held by Balaji, but said he has not agreed to Balaji con-

tinuing as a minister since he is facing interrogation by the Enforcement Directorate. However, within a few hours, the state government passed a G.O. reallocation of the portfolios of Balaji and that he would continue as a minister without portfolio. When contacted, senior advocate KM Vijayan told TNIE, "According to the Constitution, the power to appoint or drop minister vests with the chief minister and the governor can only act as his advice. So, as far as the appointment or dropping of a minister, the governor is subservient to the directive of the chief minister. In a parliamentary democracy, the prerogative to

appoint or drop a minister lies with the chief minister and not the governor. So, what the governor did in dismissing Balaji is outside the scope of the Constitution." Vijayan also said the reasons given by the governor for dismissing Balaji is irrelevant since he has no powers to do that. Further, the chief minister need not give any reasoning for keeping or dropping a minister in the cabinet. Referring to the governor's statement that Balaji, abusing his position as a minister, has been influencing the investigation and obstructing the due process of law and justice, Vijayan said, "As per the business rules, a minister without a portfolio cannot give directions to any official."

# Tamil Nadu parties condemn governor's 'undemocratic act'

POLITICAL parties on Thursday condemned the dismissal of Minister V Senthil Balaji from the council of ministers without any recommendation to this effect from Chief Minister MK Stalin. They called for intensifying the demand for the removal of Governor NR Ravji from Tamil Nadu. Assembly Speaker M Appavu said, "If the CM asks or we

Democratic forces should come together and intensify their demand for Ravi's removal from the post, he added. NTK leader Seeman said the governor's action is the height of autocratic functioning. "We agree that investigation should be conducted against Balaji in a fair manner. But the governor's assault on the state's sovereignty cannot be accepted" Seeman, NTK leader

MPMH president MH Jawaharullah said PNT Achary former secretary general of the Lok Sabha, had already said that a governor dismisses a minister on his own, it would be tantamount to running a parallel government which is against the Constitution. Strongly condemning the governor's decision, VCK leader Thirumavalavan said Balaji's dismissal was a mischievous act of Ravi to provoke the CM.
