Harry Kane scored his 200th goal for Tottenham Hotspur to help the London club beat Ludogorets 3-1 while Lille ended AC Milan's 24-game unbeaten streak with a 3-0 win in the Europa League group clash on Thursday.

Arsenal, Leicester City, Roma and Real Sociedad ended up victorious in their respective group matches while Celtic was beaten 4-1 by Sparta Prague in Glasgow and PAOK pulled off a surprise 4-1 win over PSV Eindhoven.

Arsenal came from one goal down to defeat the Norwegian club Molde 4-1 at home for its third straight win. Leicester routed Braga 4-0, Roma thrashed Cluj 5-0, while Real Sociedad handed

Nadal, a 20-time Grand Slam champion who on Wednesday became only the fourth man to reach 1,000 match wins, next faces Spanish countryman Pablo Carrero Busta.

Alexander Zverev needed three hours to beat unseeded Frenchman Adrian Mannarino 7-6 (11), 6-7 (7), 6-4.

The fourth-seeded German saved set points in each of the opening two sets, but then Mannarino saved a match point at 7-6 down in the tiebreaker and clinched the second set with a smart volley at the net.

Zverev broke in the ninth game of the decider, then saved a break point at 30-40

before serving out the match with two aces, bringing his total to 19.

He next faces three-time Grand Slam champion Stan Wawrinka, after the Swiss veteran rallied to beat fifth-seeded Russian Andrey Rublev 1-6, 6-4, 6-3.

Zverev has won all three previous matches against the 12th-seeded Wawrinka, including in an Australian Open quarterfinal this year.

Earlier, No. 3 Daniil Medvedev overcame a first-set blip where he conceded 11 straight points before rallying to beat 16th-seeded Alex de Minaur 5-7, 6-2, 6-2.

The strong-serving Russian concluded with a 13th ace and next plays No. 6 Diego Schwartzman, who routed qualifier Alejandro Davidovich Fokina 6-1, 6-1.

Eugene set for ISL showdown

Although he was not a part of the Blue Tigers' 2019 AFC Asian Cup campaign in UAE, his team-mates and Assistant Coach Shanmugam Venkatesh believe **Eugene Lyngdoh** was instrumental to India's qualification for the Continental championship.

Lyngdoh, who had appeared on AIFF TV for a candid live chat, was flooded with wishes from his former team-mates and current rivals, as he makes a comeback from injury in the upcoming Hero Indian Super League season with SC East Bengal.

"He had a huge contribution towards our qualification to AFC Asian Cup 2019. We missed him in UAE," said former India captain and current assistant coach Shanmugam Venkatesh. "His international career started late but on his

debut, against Nepal in Guwahati, it didn't look like he was playing his first game for India."

Current India captain Sunil Chhetri, who had made a moving speech about the sacrifices of players like Lyngdoh that allowed the Blue Tigers to participate in the AFC Asian Cup on the eve of India's first match against Thailand, stated that the latter was a big reason why the team made it to the continental stage.

"The whole team and I missed him so much at the Asian Cup. He was an important reason why we qualified in the first case," said Chhetri.

'Eugene,' as he is fondly called in the dressing room had become a regular in the Blue Tigers starting XI around four years back, playing a crucial role in the midfield as India topped Group A of the Round 3 of the Qualifiers.



FC Goa skipper optimistic

Football Club, Goa is set for the better showdown this year when the Indian Super League kick off in Goa later this month.

The 2020-21 ISL will be played in three venues in Goa from November 20 till March.

"The one thing I am noticing this year as compared to last season is the intensity of the training sessions. We are working a lot on our tactical elements this year and I believe this will make us stronger than we were last season," **Bedia** said at a virtual press conference.

According to the Spaniard, the rhythm which the foreign players will provide will be crucial at the end of the season.

"The one thing I can say from what I have seen in the training sessions right now, and having played with the team for the last couple of



years, is the fact that I believe the foreigners that we have can give us that extra rhythm that we will need to try and push ourselves all the way to the final.

"We had a great strength in the team last season as well and I believe we have similar quality again this time.

"But it is that actual bit of rhythm I feel that could be crucial, come the later stage of the tournament, towards the end of the season," the 31-year-old central midfielder added.

FC Goa start their ISL campaign on November 22 against Bengaluru FC at the Fatorda Stadium.

He also said that the club would continue to play the same style of football.

"I do believe we will continue to play the same style of football.

"With regards to the tactical elements and the differences you expect us to see, I think this season will be a lot more organised, given the fact that we are working not just on our defences but on our attacking movements as well."

Citing Bengaluru FC's example, Bedia conceded that some teams who were little better than them in terms of tactical elements had an upper hand in the past seasons.

Attacking mid-fielder and India international Brandon Fernandes believed that FC Goa will have a bit of an advantage over other teams as they are used to playing in the coastal state and know the conditions.

Ningombam is HI president

Manipur's Gyanendro Ningombam was on Friday elected unopposed as the Hockey India (HI) president, taking over from Mohd Mush-taque Ahmad.

Ahmad remains in the federal arena after being elected unopposed for the senior vice-president post at HI's Congress and Elections here.

Access to the meeting through video conferencing facility was made available for member units which were unable to travel due to the restrictions imposed by their respective state governments to deal with the COVID-19 pandemic.

On being elected unopposed, Ningombam becomes the first President from the North East region to spearhead HI.

He held the position of "officiating president" after Ahmad tendered his resignation in July citing personal and family commitments.

1979: India clinched their first series victory over Australia with a thumping win in the sixth Test in Bombay. Going into the match 0-1 down, Australia had to win to square the series, but Sunil Gavaskar and (late) Chetan Chauhan closed the door with an opening partnership of 192. Gavaskar and Syed Kirmani made hundreds (Kirmani was only the third nightwatchman to do so in a Test), and the No. 9, Karsan Ghavri, iced the cake with a rumbustious 86 to take the score to 458. With no hope of victory, Australia submitted meekly. In the first innings only Graham Yallop (60) passed 25, in the second only Allan Border (61) and Kim Hughes (80) reached double figures, and India wrapped up victory by an innings and 100 runs, with a day to spare.
