Sable finishes creditable fifth

Xiamen, India's Avinash Sable finished a creditable fifth in the men's 3000m steeplechase event of the Xiamen leg Diamond League Meeting on Saturday to qualify for the grand finale in Eugene, USA later this month. The 28-year-old Sable, who had failed to qualify for the final round in the World Championships in Hungary last month, clocked 8 minutes 16.27 seconds, well below his season's best of 8:11.63 and national record time of 8:11.20. Olympic and world champion Soufiane El Bakkali of Morocco won the race with a time of 8:10.31, while Samuel Firewu (8:11.29) of Ethiopia and Amos Serem (8:14.41) of Kenya were second and third respectively.

Hyderabad FC signs Lalchhanhima Sailo

Hyderabad: Former Indian Super League champions Hyderabad FC have roped in Mizoram-born midfielder Lalchhanhima Sailo on a three-year-deal. The 20-year-old, who joins from I-League side Aizawl FC, also has the option to extend his contract by another season. Speaking on joining HFC, Sailo told the club, "I am very happy to join Hyderabad FC and be a part of ISL this season." "With the way the club shows trust in youngsters and what they have achieved as a team, it has been my long desire to be here, and I thank the Coach and the Management for showing the trust in me," he added. Having started his professional career with Punjab U15s, Sailo spent three years nurturing his game before joining Indian Arrows, slowly growing into a regular in the first team in the I-League.

B'eswar, Guwahati to host WC Qualifier

New Delhi: All India Football Federation on Saturday announced Bhubaneswar and Guwahati as the venues for the first two home matches of India in FIFA World Cup 2026 and AFC Asian Cup 2027 Preliminary Joint Qualification Round 2. India are in Group A of the Asian qualifiers, alongside Qatar, Kuwait, and the winners of the Preliminary Joint Qualification Round 1 fixture between Afghanistan and Mongolia. The Blue Tigers will open their campaign with an away fixture in Kuwait on November 16, 2023, before hosting reigning AFC Asian Cup champions Qatar at the Kalinga Stadium in Bhubaneswar on November 21.

Liverpool completes signing of G'berch

Liverpool: Liverpool completed the overhaul of its midfield by signing Netherlands international Ryan Gravenberch from Bayern Munich in a deal worth 40 million euros (USD 43.1 million) on the final day of the summer transfer window. Gravenberch joins fellow midfielders Alexis Mac Allister, Dominik Szoboszlai and Wataru Endo in joining Liverpool this summer while Fabinho, Jordan Henderson, James Milner, Naby Keita and Alex Oxlade-Chamberlain have left. The 21-year-old Gravenberch has signed a five-year deal just 12 months after joining Bayern from Ajax.

United signs Amrabat on loan

Manchester: Morocco midfielder Sofyan Amrabat described Manchester United as the "club of my dreams" after completing a season-long loan move to the English team in the final hours of the last day of the transfer window. Amrabat moved on Friday from Italian club Fiorentina, which reportedly received a loan fee of 10 million euros (USD 10.8 million). United has the option to make the signing permanent for 20 million euros (USD 21.5 million).

Celta Vigo beats Almeria in style

Madrid: Williot Swedberg scored in the 87th minute as Celta Vigo defeated Almeria 3-2 for its first Spanish league victory of the season. The 19-year-old Swedish midfielder netted the winner with a late header on Friday after Unai Nunez and Jorgen Strand Larsen gave Celta a 2-0 lead before halftime. Sergio Akieme and Sergio Arribas equalized for the hosts in the second half. Rafa Benitez's Celta entered the fourth round coming off two losses and a draw.

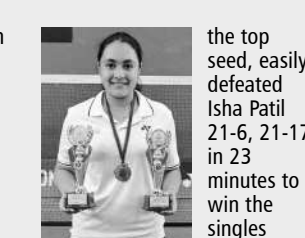
