Pune: The Department of Science and Technology (DST) has invited applications from young students keen on entrepreneurship to apply for the National Initiative for Developing and Harnessing

Innovations-Entrepreneur-in-Residence (NIDHI-EIR) scheme 2021. Graduate students will be provided funding to take up entrepreneurship through a fellowship for 12 to 18 months.

AN ACTOR Vikram Gokhale said he agreed with Kangana Ranaut's recent remark that the Independence Day in 1947 was a "bheekh", adding that he also supports Ranaut's statement that we got "real freedom in 2014". Speaking on the sidelines of an event organised by Bramhan Singh in the city to honour him on his 75th birthday, he said, "I agree with what Kangana has said. We got freedom in 1947. The fighters who wanted to get it from the British were the bigwigs at that time and they did not attempt to save it." Gokhale later told the Indian Express: "I also agree with Kangana that we got real freedom in 2014." Gokhale, though, said he was not a blind supporter of Prime

Minister Narendra Modi. "When PM Modi and Home Minister Amit Shah go on election campaign, I don't agree with what they say. But yes, when they work in national interest, like when they put China on the backfoot, I support them."

Senior Congress leader and former chief minister Prithviraj Chavan said, "If Gokhale is supporting her (Ranaut), he should better join a political party like BJP." To this, Gokhale said he was not a supporter of any political party. "My views are my views. They are not dictated by any political parties. All parties are similar," he said.

Actor Sharad Ponkshe, whose play "Mee Nathuram Godse Boltoy" had created a storm a few years back, said, "India gained freedom because of the fight put up by freedom fighters, patriots, satyagrahis, those who believed in non-violence, and even those who stayed home and prayed... Indian gained freedom in 1947 and not in 2014." Stating that he did not want to get into a verbal duel with

Gokhale, he said, "I don't know what he said and what was reported by television channels, which are known for twisting things." Santosh Shinde of the Sambhaji Brigade said, "Gokhale supporting Ranaut should invite seditious charges... We will file a complaint with the police tomorrow (Monday)."

Mukund Kirdat of the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) said, "We are consulting our legal team and might file a police complaint against the actor."

Gokhale, a well known name in theatre and films, also said the Shiv Sena and BJP must join hands, adding he was putting in efforts to bring the parties back together. "My efforts are on. I had personally asked Devendra Fadnis (former CM and senior BJP leader) why he did not give CM's post to Sena for 2.5 years. He (Fadnis) told me that it was a mistake." He said that in the future too, he would personally speak to Fadnis and CM Uddhav Thackeray.

SECTION 144 AFTER VIOLENCE

Pune Rural Police order: Don't post messages that create disharmony, will hold group admins liable

In the backdrop of incidents of alleged violence in parts of

Maharashtra during protest rallies to condemn the reported violence in Tripura, the Pune Rural Police have issued orders under CrPc's section 144, prohibiting locals from sending or posting messages on social media and messaging platforms that can potentially lead to "communal disharmony or law-and-order situation".

The order, issued by Pune District Collector Rajesh Deshmukh, who is also the administrative in-charge of law and

order in areas other than those covered under Pune City and Pimpri-Chinchwad police jurisdictions, stated that sender of messages and social media group administrators would also be held responsible for "inflammatory messages" posted on these platforms. The orders will remain in force from November 14 till the midnight of November 20. Those found in violation of the order will be liable to prosecution under IPC Section 188. ENS
