The proposed heritage rules prohibit construction within a radius of 100 metre of any archaeological site, undermining to develop the Lingaraj temple and its surroundings as a heritage site at the cost of Rs 700 crore. THREE DAYS after Prime

Minister Narendra Modi said in Parliament that the Centre's three farm laws merely provide an "option" to farmers, former Congress president Rahul Gandhi on Saturday said that those options are "hunger, unemployment and suicide".

On February 10, PM Modi had said in Lok Sabha: "What deterioration has occurred in any facilities (the) farmers have been enjoying? This is just another option. They are not binding.. Why are you opposing another option? These laws will not ban any existing mandis nor will they discontinue the MSP. We are just modernising the mandis."

Addressing a 'Kisan Tractor Rally' from a flatbed tractor in Ajmer, Gandhi said, "Narendra Modi says 'I am giving you options'. Yes... he has given three options: first is hunger, second is unemployment and the third
