ED arrests AAP MP Sanjay Singh in Delhi excise case

AAP leadership says agency hadn't summoned Singh even once before arrest

New Delhi, 4 October

The Enforcement Directorate on Wednesday arrested Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) Rajya Sabha MP Sanjay Singh under the provisions of the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA) for his alleged role in the now-scrapped 2021-22 Delhi excise policy.

Singh is the second prominent AAP leader, after former Delhi deputy chief minister Manish Sisodia, whom central agencies have arrested in the case, while raids have been conducted related to the case in the past on the premises of Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal and Bharat Rashtia Samithi's K Kavitha, among others. Another AAP leader, former Delhi minister Satyendar Jain, is in jail in a separate money laundering case.

In a video recorded before his arrest, Singh accused the ED of "forcibly arresting him without any evidence". "I exposed Adani's scams and filed multiple complaints with ED, but no action was taken against Adani. Modi ji is losing the 2024 elections badly," he said.

Kejriwal termed the arrest "totally illegal", a sign that the PM was "rattled" and alleged the government would arrest several Opposition leaders in the run-up to the Lok Sabha polls. AAP spokesperson Reena Gupta said Singh's arrest was because he consistently raised the Adani issue. The Delhi BJP said the heat of the liquor 'scam' probe will ultimately reach Kejriwal. The Rajya Sabha chairman had suspended Singh from the House during the monsoon session for violating the directives of the chair. The AAP leadership said that the ED had not summoned Singh in the case to record his statement before Wednesday's arrest. In April, the ED filed an application in a court to correct a "typographical/clerical error related to Singh's name in a charge sheet."

According to sources, Wednesday's searches at Singh's residence and his arrest came after a businessman, an accused in the case, who later became an 'approver', named him for arranging his meeting with Sisodia.



Ranbir Kapoor gets ED summons

The Enforcement Directorate (ED) has summoned actor Ranbir Kapoor for questioning on Friday in connection with the Mahadev betting application money-laundering case in Chhattisgarh, officials said. They said the agency has accused Kapoor of receiving money from the promoters of the app for promoting their product in the virtual (online) space. The ED has asked Kapoor to appear at the agency's Raipur office on October 6, they said. Despite several attempts to contact the actor, there was no response from him.

Around 14-15 other celebrities and actors are under the ED's scanner in the case and they will also be summoned soon, sources said.



NewsClick founder, HR head in 7-day police custody

'Delhi Police gave no FIR copy'

NewsClick founder Prabir Purkayastha and human resources head Amit Chakravarty, arrested in a case filed under the anti-terrorism law UAPA following allegations the portal received money for pro-China propaganda, were sent to seven days of police remand, officials said on Wednesday.

NewsClick on Wednesday issued a statement on the raids claiming it has not been provided a copy of the first information report (FIR), or informed about the offences people associated with it have been charged with. Meanwhile, US State Department Spokesperson Vedant Patel on Tuesday said the US has seen reports about the alleged ties of an Indian media outlet with China but cannot comment on the veracity of the claims.

The move by ED received widespread protest in Delhi's Jantar Mantar led by the All India Students' Association.

SIKKIM FLASH FLOODS KILL 8; 22 SOLDIERS AMONG 69 MISSING



At least eight people died and 69 others, including 22 army personnel, went missing on Wednesday after a cloudburst over Lhonak Lake in north Sikkim triggered a flash flood in the Teesta River basin (pictured), officials said. Three of the dead were washed up in north Bengal, they said. The flash floods in the region led to disruption in operations at Alembic Pharmaceuticals' Sikkim-based manufacturing plant. The National Disaster Response Force has pressed in three teams for rescue-and-relief operations. The force has so far rescued seven people.

Cabinet hikes Ujjwala subsidy by ₹100

The Union Cabinet on Wednesday approved a hike of ₹100 in cooking gas subsidy under the Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY). The scheme currently provides poor households a targeted subsidy of ₹200 per cylinder of liquefied petroleum gas (LPG).

The PMUY beneficiaries will now get a subsidy of ₹300 per LPG cylinder on market price. As a result, PMUY beneficiaries in Delhi will now pay ₹603 for every 14.2-kg LPG cylinder against the market price of ₹903. The latest decision comes on the back of a series of steps taken by the Centre over the past one month to reduce the cost of LPG cylinder ahead of crucial state and general elections. On

September 13, the Centre had announced the extension of the PMUY scheme by three years till

2025-26 to disburse 7.5 million new LPG connections at a cost of ₹1,650 crore. Under the PMUY, a deposit free LPG connection is provided to adult women from poor households. The beneficiaries are identified either from the Socio Economic Caste Census (SECC) list or from seven other identified categories such as households from Scheduled Caste (SCs), Scheduled Tribe (STs), Most Backward Classes (MBC), beneficiaries of PM

Awas Yojana (Gramin), beneficiaries of Antyodaya Anna Yojana (AAY), etc. With 103 million connections under the PMUY, the beneficiaries make up almost a third of the 314 million households in India with a LPG connection. On August 29, the Centre had cut the price of a 14.2 kg domestic LPG cylinder by ₹200 across all markets. In Delhi, for instance, the decision brought down the cost of a 14.2 kg cylinder to ₹903 per cylinder. The LPG price was last raised in March by ₹50.
