Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 110, and other applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013, as amended (the "Act"), read together with the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, as amended (the "Management Rules"), General Circular Nos. 14/2020 dated April 8, 2020, 17/2020 dated April 13, 2020, 20/2020 dated May 5, 2020, 22/2020 dated June 15, 2020, 33/2020 dated September 28, 2020, 39/2020 dated December 31, 2020, 10/2021 dated June 23, 2021, 20/2021 dated December 8, 2021, 3/2022 dated May 5, 2022 and 11/2022 dated December 28, 2022, issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Government of India (the "MCA Circulars"), Secretarial Standard on General Meetings issued by the Institute of Company Secretaries of India ("SS-2") that the resolution(s) as set out in this notice, are proposed to be transacted by the Members through postal ballot by remote e-Voting only ("remote e-Voting").

1) Appointment of Ms. Ananya Tripathi (DIN: 08102039) as an Independent Director of the Company:

To consider and, if thought fit, to pass with or without modification(s), the following resolution as Special Resolution:

"RESOLVED THAT pursuant to the provisions of Sections 149, 150, 152 and any other applicable provisions if any, of the Companies Act, 2013 and the rules made thereunder (including any statutory modification(s) or re-enactment thereof for the time being in force) read with Schedule IV to the Companies Act, 2013, **Ms. Ananya Tripathi (DIN: 08102039)**, in respect of whom the Company has received a notice in writing from a member proposing her candidature for the office of Director, be and is hereby appointed as an Independent Director of the Company to hold office for five consecutive years for a term up to 12th March 2028 and that her office as an Independent Director shall not be subject to retirement by rotation."

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the Board be and is hereby authorized to delegate all or any of the powers to any committee of directors with power to further delegate to or any other Officer(s) / Authorized Representative(s) of the Company to do all acts, deeds and things and take all such steps as may be necessary, proper or expedient to give effect to this resolution".

2) To consider such number of stock options exercisable into not more than 8,00,000 (Eight Lakhs only) equity shares of the Company of face value of Rs. 4 each, under one or more Employee Stock Option Schemes for the benefit of such person(s) who are in permanent employment of the Holding Company/Subsidiary Companies:

To consider and, if thought fit, to pass with or without modification(s), the following resolution as Special Resolution:

"RESOLVED THAT pursuant to the provisions of Section 42, 62(1)(b) of the Companies Act, 2013 ("the Act") and the Companies (Share Capital and Debentures) Rules, 2014 and other applicable provisions, if any, of the

Act, including any statutory modification(s) or re-enactment of the Act for the time being in force and in accordance with the provisions of the Memorandum and Articles of Association of the Company and the provisions of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Share Based Employee Benefits) Regulations, 2014 including any modifications thereof or supplements thereto ("the SEBI ESOS Regulations") as and when they become applicable to the Company, SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ("the SEBI LODR Regulations") as and when they become applicable to the Company, the Listing Agreement entered into with the Stock Exchange where the securities of the Company are listed and any other applicable laws for the time being in force and subject to such other consents, permissions, sanctions and approvals which may be agreed by the Board of Directors of the Company (which shall be deemed to include the Nomination and Remuneration Committee or any other Committee of the Board of Directors constituted by the Board, to exercise its powers including powers conferred by this Resolution) (hereinafter referred to as "the Board" or as "the Committee"), consent of the Shareholders be and is hereby accorded to create, offer, issue and allot at any time to or for the benefit of such person(s) who are in permanent employment of the holding company and the subsidiaries of the Company (whether now or hereafter existing, whether incorporated in India or overseas as may be from time to time be allowed under the prevailing laws, rules and regulations and / or any amendments thereto from time to time), whether working in India or out of India, including Director of the Company, whether Whole-time director or not, but excluding Promoter, Promoter group and independent Directors and such other persons as may from time to time be allowed to be eligible for the benefit under the provisions of applicable laws and Regulations prevailing from time to time (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Employees") selected on the basis of criteria decided by the Board such number of stock options exercisable into not more than 8,00,000 (Eight Lakhs only) equity shares of the Company of face value of Rs.4 each, under one or more Employee Stock Option Schemes, in one or more tranches, and on such terms and conditions as may be fixed or determined by the Board in accordance with the provisions of the law or guidelines issued by the relevant Authority.

1. The statement pursuant to Section 102 of the Companies Act, 2013 stating all the material facts and the reasons for the proposed resolution is annexed herewith the Notice.
2. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 110 of the Act read with the Rules and MCA Circulars, your Company has an option for the above mentioned resolution, to seek the approval of the members through Postal Ballot (via remote e-Voting), instead of getting the same passed at a General Meeting. Accordingly, if the resolution is approved by the members through Postal Ballot via remote e-Voting, it shall be deemed to have been passed as if the same has been passed at a General Meeting of the members convened in this regard.
3. In compliance with the MCA Circulars, the Notice of the Postal Ballot is being sent by electronic mode only to those members whose names appears in the Register of Members / List of Beneficial Owners maintained by the Company/Depositories respectively as at close of business hours on 31st March 2023, (the “Cut-off date”) and whose e-mail addresses are registered with the Company / Depositories.

4. As per the MCA Circulars on account of the COVID-19 pandemic, physical copies of the Notice, are not being sent to members for this Postal Ballot. Members are requested to provide their assent or dissent through remote e-Voting only.

In compliance with the MCA Circulars, Sections 108 and 110 of the Act and the Rules made thereunder and Regulation 44 of the Listing Regulations, the Company is providing remote e-Voting facility to seek the approval of members of the Company for the resolution(s) contained in this Notice. 6. Voting rights of the members shall be reckoned in proportion to the paid-up equity shares registered in the name of the member / beneficial owner as on the Cut-off date.

2. Select "EVEN" of company for which you wish to cast your vote during the remote e-Voting period.
3. Now you are ready for e-Voting as the Voting page opens.
4. Cast your vote by selecting appropriate options i.e. assent or dissent, verify/modify the number of shares for which you wish to cast your vote and click on "Submit" and also "Confirm" when prompted.
5. Upon confirmation, the message "Vote cast successfully" will be displayed.
6. You can also take the printout of the votes cast by you by clicking on the print option on the confirmation page.
7. Once you confirm your vote on the resolution, you will not be allowed to modify your vote.

General Guidelines for shareholders

Item No.1

The Board of Directors ('Board'), has appointed Ms. Ananya Tripathi (DIN: 08102039) as a Non-Executive Independent Director of the Company with effect from March 14, 2023 for a term of 5 consecutive years up to March 14, 2028, subject to the approval of Members in the ensuing General Meeting. In terms of section 160 of the Companies Act, 2013, ("Act") the Company has received notices in writing from a member proposing the candidature of Ms. Ananya Tripathi, for appointment as an Independent Director as per the provisions of sections 149 and 152 of the Companies Act, 2013.

Ms. Ananya Tripathi, has given declarations to the Board of Directors of the Company that she met the criteria of Independence, as provided in Section 149(6) of the Companies Act, 2013 and Regulation 16(1)(b) of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ("Listing Regulations").

In the opinion of the Board, Ms. Ananya Tripathi fulfils the conditions specified in the Companies Act, 2013 and the Listing Regulations for appointment as Independent Director and she is independent of the management. Given Ms. Ananya Tripathi's expertise, your Board is of the view that Ms. Ananya Tripathi's appointment as an Independent Director would be of immense value to the Company.

As per the provisions of the Section 149 of the Act, an Independent Director shall hold office for a term up to five consecutive years on the Board of the Company and is not liable to retire by rotation. The Board is authorized to re-grant such lapsed / cancelled options as per the provisions of ESOS - 2022.
