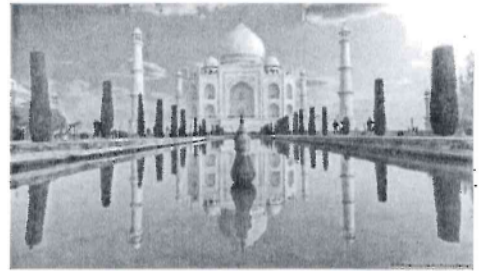

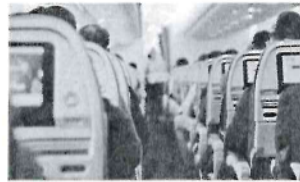


and certainly don't expect to be loved by every single person out there. That doesn't mean because you don't approve of me you can spew negativity instead'.
