Minister of Railways, Ashwini Vaishnaw visited Modern Coach Factory, Raebareli

Hon'ble Minister of Railways, Government of India, Ashwini Vaishnaw arrives in Varanasi

Varanasi is a very important city for Indian Railways. Apart from the city's mythological and spiritual significance, Varanasi is a key railway hub that connects remote provinces making it a vital transit point for hundreds of passenger and freight trains from different parts of the country. Keeping this significance in view, various projects are being executed by Northern Railway, Lucknow Division for improving passenger facilities, safety, security and modernization of railways.

Hon'ble Minister of Railways, Government of India, Shri Ashwini Vaishnaw, Union Minister for Railways, Communications & Electronics and Information Technology arrived in Varanasi today to review progress of on-going development projects. The Hon'ble Minister of Railways first went to Kashi Station and examined up-gradation work for making Kashi an intermodal station. The Hon'ble Minister of Railways acquainted himself with self and interacted with

Thereafter, the Hon'ble Minister of Railways reached the Malviya Bridge for inspection whereupon he gave necessary suggestions and instructions. He familiarized himself about a new 04-lane railway and 06-lane road bridge to be constructed parallel to

Malviya Bridge. Also present on the occasion was Shri Ravindra Jaiswal, Hon'ble Minister of State (Independent Charge), Horticulture, Agricultural Marketing, Agricultural Foreign Trade and Agricultural Exports, Govt. of Uttar Pradesh at Raebareli Railway station and discussed the issues of development in this area and held a press conference with media persons present at the station before leaving for Modern Coach Factory, Raebareli. Hon'ble Minister of Railways visited the factory premises of Modern Rail Coach Factory, Raebareli. During this visit the General Manager of Modern Coach Factory, Raebareli Shri S.S. Kalsi

appreciated the Minister about the manufacturing and technology of different types of coaches in Modern Coach Factory. He expressed his happiness to see the technical design and quality of coaches made in Modern Coach Factory. During the inspection of the factory, he inspected the manufacturing infrastructure of Vande Bharat trains and motor coaches of Vande Bharat trains being made in Modern Coach Factory, Raebareli, so that regular production of Vande Bharat trains could be started. Amid row over Delhi minister's special treatment, top prison official shifted

Amid a row over jailed Aam Aadmi Party leader Satyendar Jain getting 'special treatment' while in Delhi's Tihar Jail, Director-General of Prisons Sandeep Goel has been replaced by Sanjay Beniwak an IPS officer of the 1989 batch. A notification issued by Lieutenant Governor VK Saxena has instructed Goel to 'report to PHQ (Police Headquarters) for further orders'. On Thursday the union home ministry sought a report from the Delhi chief secretary on allegations by the Enforcement Directorate that jail officials are colluding with Jain, who was arrested over a money laundering case. The agency submitted CCTV footage of Jain purportedly receiving a body massage from an unidentified person inside his cell. The ED further said the AAP leader is being provided with fruits and salads in his cell and that it was being cleaned by untrained persons under the supervision of co-accused Anshu Jain.

Tihar Jail is run by the Department of Delhi Prisons, Government of Delhi. Meanwhile, conman Sukesh Chandrashekhar who is in jail in connection with a money laundering case of over 7200 crore in which Bollywood actress Jacqueline Fernandez has also been linked wrote to Delhi LG Governor alleging that in 2019 he had paid 710 crore to Satyendar Jain to ensure safety in prison. The letter alleged that more than 750 crore was given to the AAP on a promise of giving Chandrashekhar an important post in the party in South Zone, and also help him in getting nominated to the Rajya Sabha. Ghaziabad civic polls: 57 of 100 wards declared as reserved seats

GHAZIABAD: (AGENCY)

Ahead of the municipal elections that are likely to take place in Ghaziabad by the end of the year, the Ghaziabad municipal corporation has 57 of its 100 wards as reserved seats for various categories, officials said Thursday. While 14 wards were reserved for the candidates from the Scheduled Caste (SC), 21 have been reserved for candidates from other backward classes (OBC), officials said.

The final list has been sent to the office of the district magistrate from where it will be sent to the state administration for approval. "The list of reserved wards has been finalised and 14 wards have been reserved for SC category, 21 for OBC category and 22 for women candidates. Out of the list reserved for women, 50 and OBC category women can contest. So, the overall reserved wards stand at 57 while the rest are for general category candidates," said Nitin Gaur, Ghaziabad municipal commissioner.

He said the reservation has been decided on the basis of demography. "The list has been finalised on the basis of 2011 Census," Gaur added.

A government order seeking the proposals for reservation of wards in local bodies was issued to different local bodies across the state on October 21 this year. The order said (while mentioning a previous order of November 24, 2011) that seats which are reserved for SCs, OBCs and women in the previous elections will not be respectively allotted to the same categories the coming elections as well, officials said. The Ghaziabad district has nine local bodies - Ghaziabad Municipal Corporation, Nagar Palika of Modinagar, Muradnagar, Loni and Khoda-Makanpur, and nagar panchayats of Dasna, Fared Nagar, Palta and Nivern.

According to the wards' list as of now, the nine local bodies have 2,346,365 voters and 1,67,610 voters come under the jurisdiction of the Ghaziabad municipal corporation.

Delhi municipal elections on December 4, counting on December 7: Poll panel

The Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD) elections will be held December 4, while the counting of votes will be done on December 7, announced state election commissioner for Delhi Vijay Dev on Friday. The Model Code of Conduct comes into force in the national capital from Friday



itself. He said "Voting for the municipal polls in Delhi will be held on December 4 while the results will be announced on December 7. The filing of nomination will begin from November 7 and the last date for the same is November 14." Dev said at a press conference. The focus shifted to the commission and the prepa-

ration for holding municipal elections after the completion of the delimitation. The polls were abruptly postponed in March this year when the Centre announced the civic bodies will be merged. A unified MCD came into being in May. The elections were originally scheduled to be held in April 2022. On March 9, the commission called a press conference to announce the schedule before announcing the Centre has sent a note on unifying the three civic bodies. Parliament passed a law to unify the three municipal corporations, which also mandated a reduction in the number of wards from 272 wards to 250 wards, prompting the delimitation exercise. The exercise was completed on October 17. The commission has appointed election officers and fixed the expenditure limit over the last week as part of preparations for the elections.

Ban on entry of trucks other than essential services in Delhi

Exemption for CNG-electric trucks- Gopal Rai

Delhi Government constitutes a 6-member monitoring committee to oversee movement of trucks- Gopal Rai

The Delhi Government has banned the entry of trucks other than essential services in the national capital under the GRAP. The Deputy Chief Minister Shri Gopal Rai informed, "Only CNG and electric trucks will be allowed to enter Delhi other than those serving essential services. The Delhi Government has constituted a 6-member monitoring committee to oversee the same. Delhi government's offices will employ 50 per cent capacity while 50 per cent employees will work from home and 500 new e-buses will be run in the state. A special task force will be formed for the hotspots. 33 teams have also been formed to monitor industrial pollution." Environment Minister Shri Gopal Rai addressed an important press conference at Delhi Secretariat today. He said, "In view of the

severe situation of pollution in Delhi, CAQM had directed us to implement the fourth phase of GRAP. In view of this, the restrictions imposed in Delhi from today are being tightened even more.

There is already a ban on construction and demolition work, but till now some categories of construction and demolition activities were exempted. Among them, the work of high-ways, flyovers and roads, pipelines and power transmission is also being exempted. The decision was taken after a meeting with the officials of Transport Department, MCD, Construction Agencies, GAD, Revenue, DPCC and Environment Department and other concerned departments. With the implementation of the new restrictions of GRAP in Delhi, vehicles other than those used for essential services will be banned in Delhi. Only CNG, Petrol and Electric vehicles will be allowed to enter Delhi. There will also be a ban on medium and heavy vehicles of diesel registered in Delhi. The decision is connected to essential services.
