ADB President proposes \$25-b support to India



New Delhi: Asian Development Bank President Masatsugu Asakawa on Tuesday called on Prime Minister Narendra Modi and conveyed ADB's intention to provide \$20-25 billion resources over five years to advance India's aspirations for inclusive, and green growth. In a release, the Manila-based multilateral lending agency said its President in his meeting with Modi discussed a range of issues, including ADB support to India's infrastructure and social development and climate actions.

SBI pegs Q3 GDP growth at 4.6%

India's economy was estimated to have grown 4.6 per cent during the October-December quarter of the current financial year, said a research report by SBI.

This is higher than the 4.4 per cent growth projected by the Reserve Bank of India and the National Statistical Office (NSO), but lower than India Ratings & Research's (Ind-Ra) estimate of around 5 per cent. NSO will release the actual number on February 28.

The country's Gross Domestic Product (GDP) grew 0.7 per cent and 5.4 per cent in Q3 FY21 and Q3 FY22, respectively, while growth during the first two quarters of the current fiscal has been pegged at 13.5 per cent (Q1) and 6.3 per cent (Q2). For the whole of current fiscal, GDP is estimated to grow between 6.8 and 7 per cent.

"We estimate India's GDP growth for Q3 FY23 at 4.6 per cent. This is based on an in-house SBI Artificial Neural Network (ANN) model," SBI research report titled Ecowrap said.

INDIA INC'S GROWTH
The report added that corporate results, excluding BFSI (banking, financial services and insurance), for Q3 FY23 show de-growth in EBIDTA (earnings before

interest, depreciation, tax and amortisation) by 9 per cent year-on-year against 18 per cent EBIDTA growth in Q3 FY22, though the top line continued to grow at a healthier pace. Net sales grew 15 per cent in Q3 FY23, while bottom line was down around 16 per cent. Further, corporate margin seems to be under pressure as reflected in results of around 3,000 listed entities (exclud-

ing BFSI), on account of higher input costs with decreasing EBIDTA margin, on aggregate basis, from 15.3 per cent in Q3 FY22 to 11.9 per cent in Q3 FY23.

"These could pull down the manufacturing growth in Q3 FY23," the report said. It also mentioned that the

geopolitical uncertainty continues to rattle the global economic landscape. With the Russian aggression into Ukraine completing a year this week, "we witness a domino effect coming in full force as tensions of formidable momentum, with meaty consequences for growth and prosperity for majority of world, take centre stage."

Other than the lingering long war in Europe that dealt a heavy blow to food/energy/commodity security, there are fresh points of conflict erupting primarily in Korean Peninsula and West Asia.

Steel imports from Russia rise 5x in April-January

Russia has emerged the fourth largest supplier of steel to India for the April-January period with a five-fold rise in shipments. It has also displaced Japan as the largest supplier of hot rolled coils (HRCs), for the first time in eight years.

Of the 0.28 million tonne (mt) of finished steel shipped to India from Russia in the April-January period, around 0.21 mt - a lion's share of 72 per cent - was HRCs and strips.

In the year-ago-period (10MFY22), shipments from Russia were 0.048 mt. HRC coil and strip shipments from Japan during the year were 0.14 mt. This is the first time that Russia has emerged as one of the key steel exporting nations, and among the top five exporting nations, replacing countries such as Vietnam and Indonesia, data from the Ministry of Steel, accessed by *businessline*, show.

"If you see, Russian offerings came at a discount. There was distress sales, and in some cases, offerings from Russia - mostly hot rolled coils - were 20-30 per cent lower than the market prices," an exporter said.

Ministry data showed that total steel imports (semis and finished put together) from Russia were valued at \$360 million for the April-January period; of which 86 per cent or \$308 million was finished steel imports. Calculations suggest that the average per tonne

price of Russian HRC was around ₹45,000 per tonne (around \$550 per tonne).

"Volume-wise HRC coils / strip (1.69 mt) was the item most imported, with 34 per cent share in total finished steel," the Ministry report mentioned, adding that import of flat products accounted for 93 per cent share (up by 29.2 per cent), the rest 7 per cent include long and non-flat offerings (up by 13.8 per cent).

According to the data, overall imports of total finished steel stood at 5 mt up by 28 per cent, YoY. Korea, with shipments amounting to 1.841 mt, was the largest supplier to India (37 per cent market share); followed by China (1.2 mt) and Japan (0.7 mt). Shipments from Vietnam rose 195 per cent, YoY, to 0.19 mt.

The report says import of total finished steel was valued at ₹54,534 crore whereas export of total finished steel was valued at ₹44,463 crore. Thus, overall trade deficit (total finished steel) stood at ₹10,071 crore during 10MFY23.

Need to grow 7.6% annually till FY37 to achieve pre-pandemic trend: Ind-Ra

Annual GDP (Gross Domestic Product) growth of 7.6 per cent is required till 2036-37 to catch up with the pre-pandemic GDP trend, India Ratings & Research (Ind-Ra) said on Tuesday.

The rating agency expects Indian economy to grow at 5.9 per cent in 2023-24. It is lower than the RBI's projection of 6.4 per cent and IMF's projection of 6.1 per cent. The Economic Survey had given a projection of

6-6.8 per cent with 6.5 per cent in baseline scenario.

Pre-pandemic trend shows average GDP growth was 6.6 per cent between 2011-12 and 2019-20. However the first year of pandemic recorded a de-growth of 6.6 per cent. FY22 saw growth of 8.7 per cent which was mainly due to base impact. For the current year, the expectation is 7 per cent. The agency says India needs to grow at 7.6 per cent annually for next 13 fiscal years starting 2024-25 to 2036-37 to catch up with the pre-pandemic GDP trend. Ind-Ra

says it does not expect the growth momentum witnessed in the first half of FY23 (April-September) to sustain in the second half (October-March). NSO estimates GDP growth to drop to 4.5 per cent in the second half from 9.7 per cent in the first.

PENT-UP DEMAND

The pent-up demand, which had provided thrust to growth, is normalising, exports, which had been buoyant, are facing headwinds from the global slowdown and credit growth is facing tighter financial conditions.

The International Monetary Fund expects the global GDP growth to fall to 2.9 per cent in 2023 from an estimated 3.4 per cent in 2022.

"Although there are a few positives for India such as sustained government capex, deleveraged corporates, low NPA in the banking sector, production-linked Incentive scheme and likelihood of global commodity prices remaining subdued, Ind-Ra believes they are still not sufficient to take the FY24 GDP growth beyond 6 per cent," says Sunil Kumar Sinha, Principal Economist, Ind-Ra.

Crypto regulation, inflationary challenges to be in focus during G20 FMCBG meeting

The first G20 Finance Ministers and Central Bank Governors (FMCBG) meeting will discuss challenges including regulations relating to cryptocurrencies, global inflationary challenges, climate finance and debt issues, Economic Affairs Secretary Ajay Seth said here on Tuesday.

"Crypto assets, by nature, don't recognise the boundaries of any country, and hence, require a broad level of consent to form any level of regulation," said Seth during the curtain raiser event held here.

ON THE AGENDA

The government has repeatedly said that crypto assets require international collaboration to prevent regulatory arbitrage. Therefore, any legislation on the subject can be effective only with significant international collaboration on evaluation of the risks and benefits and evolution of common taxonomy and standards.

As on date, the policy re-

lated to crypto assets and related ecosystem in India is with the Finance Ministry.

The meeting will see ministers, central bank governors and deputy governors besides others from G20 member countries discussing policy perspectives on crypto assets and the role of national payment systems in cross-border payments.

The meeting, which is under Indian Presidency, will be spread over three sessions between February 24 and 25, covering issues such

as strengthening multilateral development banks to address shared global challenges; financing resilient, inclusive, and sustainable cities for tomorrow; and leveraging digital public infrastructure for advancing financial inclusion and productivity gains. The meeting will be jointly chaired by Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman and RBI Governor Shaktikanta Das.

The discussions in the G20 FMCBG meeting are intended to provide a clear mandate for the various workstreams of the G20

Finance Track in 2023. On the sidelines of these meetings, a number of side events have been planned for the visiting Ministers, Governors, Deputies and other delegates, on subjects such as digital public infrastructure, policy perspectives on crypto assets and the role of national payment systems in cross-border payments.

UNCERTAINTIES

V Anantha Nageswaran, Chief Economic Advisor, who was also present during the event, said that nations must communicate with one another and have transparency in monetary policy because uncertainties can lead to spillovers.

"While it is not possible to have clear answers to uncertainties, they can be mitigated with constant communication, which will be facilitated through these meetings," he added. With regard to international taxation, Seth said it is part of the agenda of the meeting.

"The inclusive framework, which is led by the OECD, has surely made progress and will also be on the list of topics for discussion."

'Quality Control Orders in electrical industry will curb unfair competition'

Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal has said that issuance of Quality Control Orders (QCOs) across sectors in the electrical industry will save the industry from unfair competition from non-transparent economies which are pumping low quality goods into the country.

The Minister sought the industry's support in implementing QCOs in his address at the 15th edition of ELECRAMA, an exhibition organised by the Indian Electrical and Electronics Manufacturers' Association (IEEMA) in Greater Noida on Tuesday.

"He urged larger companies to support and handhold smaller companies to develop quality consciousness by making them realise that quality would help them grow, get better markets and better prices," according to a press statement released by the Commerce & Industry Ministry.

'Aim is to increase share of RE in ports to 60%

The Centre is aiming to increase the share of renewable energy to 60 per cent in the total power consumption of its major ports from a present share of less than 10 per cent, Union Minister Sarbananda Sonowal said on Tuesday.

The ports have also aimed to reduce carbon emissions per tonne of cargo handled by 30 per cent by the year 2030.

"The Maritime Vision Document-2030, released by the Prime Minister, is a 10-Year blueprint on India's vision of a sustainable Maritime sector and vibrant blue economy," the Ports, Shipping and Waterways Minister said.

Power producers owe ₹20,491 crore to coal mining PSUs as of January

The outstanding dues of the power sector for the coal supplied by the mining PSUs rose by 7 per cent on an MoM basis to ₹20,491 crore at the end of January 2023, of which the majority is owed to Coal India (CIL).

According to the latest data by the Coal Ministry, power generating companies owed ₹16,857 crore to the mining behemoth, while ₹3,634 crore were the outstanding dues of Singareni Collieries Company (SCCL).

CIL'S DUES

With respect to the country's largest coal miner, the outstanding dues on a month-on-month basis were higher by 10 per cent from ₹15,387 crore in December 2022. However, the dues of SCCL were lower by 4 per

cent from ₹3,793 crore during the period. CIL's outstanding dues during January have been the highest so far in the current financial year ending March 2023. The dues have been inching up since November.

October was the third consecutive month of decline in the outstanding dues. CIL's average cost of production is around ₹1,310.88 per tonne.

At the end of January 2022, the dues stood at 15,097.01 crore, which fell consecutively during February to ₹15,037.32 crore and then to ₹12,272.41 crore in

March 2022. With peak electricity demand season beginning in April 2022, which was also marked by an unusually high uptick in temperatures, the power sector dues started inching up at ₹12,819.09 crore during the month.

The dues kept growing during May (₹13,825.20 crore), June (₹15,252.20 crore) and hit the highest so far in 2022 during July at ₹15,824.14 crore. The outstanding to CIL started to decline from August 2022 onwards (₹15,143.31 crore) and continued their northward journey during the next two consecutive months.

PRODUCTION UP

According to the provisional data for January by the Coal Ministry, CIL registered a growth of 11.44 per cent, whereas SCCL and captive mines/others registered a growth of 13.93 per cent and 22.89 per cent, respectively.

Coal despatch increased by 8.54 per cent Y-o-Y to 81.91 mt last month from 75.47 mt January 2022. During January 2023, CIL, SCCL and captive/others registered a growth of 6.07 per cent, 14 per cent and 21.9 per cent by despatching 64.45 mt, 6.84 mt and 10.61 mt, respectively. The power utilities despatch rose 8.01 per cent to 67.72 mt during January 2023 compared to 62.70 mt in January 2022.

New Turkey-Syria earthquake death toll rises to eight

The epicentre was in the town of Defne in Hatay province

The death toll in Turkey and Syria rose to eight in a new and powerful earthquake that struck two weeks after a devastating temblor killed nearly 45,000 people, authorities and media said Tuesday. Turkey disaster management authority said six people were killed and 294 others were injured with 18 in critical condition after Monday's 6.4-magnitude quake.

In Syria, a woman and a girl died as a result of panic during the earthquake in the provinces of Hama and Tartus, pro-government media outlets said.

The earthquake's epicentre was in the town of Defne, in Turkey's Hatay province, which borders Syria. It was also felt in Jordan, Cyprus, Israel, Lebanon and as far

away as Egypt, and followed by a second, magnitude 5.8 temblor, and dozens of aftershocks.

Hatay was one of the worst-hit provinces in Turkey

in the magnitude 7.8 quake that struck on Feb. 6.

Thousands of buildings were destroyed in the province and Monday's quake further damaged buildings.

The governor's office in Antakya, Hatay's historic heart, was also damaged.

Officials have warned quake victims to not go into the remains of their homes, but people have done so to retrieve what they can.

They were caught up in the new quake.

The majority of deaths in the massive Feb. 6 quake, which was followed by a 7.5 temblor nine hours later, were in Turkey with at least 41,156 people killed.

EU urges members to offer stockpiles, contracts to Ukraine

The European Union on Tuesday urged its member countries to provide more ammunition to Ukraine from their stockpiles and from any orders that they might have already placed with the defense industry to help defeat invading Rus-

sian forces.

According to some estimates, Ukraine is firing up to 6,000-7,000 artillery shells daily - about the same amount that a small European country orders in a peace-time year - but this is only around a third of the number of rounds that Russia is using, one year into the war.

"We have to act with a sense of urgency," EU foreign policy chief Josep Borrell told reporters at NATO headquarters in Brussels. Borrell said that he had written to the bloc's 27 defense ministers urging them to "give Ukraine priority" when it comes to weapons and ammunition.

"What we have to do is measured in weeks, not in months," he added.

Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy has appealed to his Western allies to quicken their military support, warning that delays would play into Russia's hand as the invasion approaches its anniversary on Feb. 24.

Joe Biden meets Polish leader Andrzej Duda

President Joe Biden reaffirmed the United States' dedication to European security as he met with Polish President Andrzej Duda on Tuesday, part of a series of consultations with allies to prepare for an even more complicated stage of Russia's invasion of Ukraine.

"We have to have security in Europe," he said at the presidential palace in Warsaw. "It's that basic, that simple, that consequential."

Biden described NATO as "maybe the most consequential alliance in history," and he said it's "stronger than it's ever been" despite Russian President Vladimir Putin's hopes that it would fracture over the war in Ukraine.

Biden arrived in Warsaw on Monday after paying an unannounced visit to Kyiv. Duda praised Biden's trip as "spectacular," saying it "boosted morale of Ukraine's defenders."

He said the visit was "a sign that the free world, and its biggest leader, the president of the United States, stands by them."

Biden is slated to deliver a speech on the war later Tuesday, and on Wednesday he plans to meet again with Duda along with other leaders of the Bucharest Nine, a group of the easternmost members of NATO military alliance.

The conflict in Ukraine - the most significant war in Europe since World War II - has already left tens of thousands of people dead, devastated Ukraine's infrastructure system and damaged the global economy.

Khareband to Assolna stretch and at Pazorkhoni (near a culvert along the Margao-Canacona highway) and Zuari river, from Panchawadi to Borim bridge stretch as well as the stretch between Panchawadi and the Marcaim jetty.

BOD level of Zuari's stretch between Panchawadi and Marcaim was 6.4 mg/l, which is considered to be in the Priority IV category.

The Khareband to Assolna stretch of the Sal had BOD level of 6 mg/l, Chandel stretch of the Kalna had BOD level of 4 mg/l, Khandepar village stretch of the Khandepar river had 4.2 mg/l, the Amona stretch of the Mandovi had the least level of BOD 3.7mg/l, and the Mapusa river at Karaswada had BOD level of 5 mg/l.

All of these stretches fall under the category of Priority V.

BOD concentrations over 30 mg/l are categorised as Priority 1 (P1) stretches, meaning they are the most polluted and require the most urgent remediation.

There are five of these classifications, with Priority 2 (P2) denoting a BOD of 20-30 mg/l and Priority 3 denoting a BOD of 10-20 mg/l.

Priority 4 (P4) displays a BOD between 6 and 10 mg/l, while Priority 5 (P5) shows a BOD of 3-6 mg/l.

The CPCB report said that two rivers - the Sal and the Mandovi - were downgraded to a 'less polluted stretch' requiring the least amount of river cleaning effort. This was found after comparing the study's identified polluted river stretch with the assessments of 2018.

Sal's stretch from Khareband to Mobor and Mandovi's stretch from Marcela to Volvoi were under Priority III and IV respectively showing BOD between 6-10 mg/l as observed in 2018.

Now the stretch from Khareband to Assolna of the Sal and Mandovi's stretch at 74 polluted river stretches of the country and moved to lower Priority V, indicating BOD level between 3-6 mg/l.

In 2018, when the CPCB published its report (after analysing stretches in 2016

and 2017), there were eight stretches of Goa categorised in P5, two in P4, one in P3. There were no stretches in most polluted categories of P1 and P2.

The latest report's count has brought down the stretches to five in P5, nil in P3, one in P4.

According to the CPCB, after more than two years of research and significant pollution abatement measures, Goa has delisted seven river-stretches - Chapora river (Pernem to Morjim), Assonora river (Assonora village to Sirsaim), Bicholim river (Bicholim to Curchirem), Valvonti river (Sankhali-Bicholim to Poriem), Tiracol river in Tiracol village, Talpona river in Canacona and Sinquerim river at Candolim - from its polluted river stretches.

The CPCB report has further stated that the efforts made to create infrastructure to manage sewage and industrial effluent as also to enforce laws to prevent and control pollution in rivers have helped in decreasing the identified polluted river stretches that have shown improvement in the water quality.
