Ex-CM's image...

By mere expressing regret for it, Nath would have rung down the curtain over the issue. He would have saved himself from the humiliation he is facing across the country by simply tendering an apology to Imarti Devi. Yet he did nothing. However Nath has apologised, his admission of guilt is full of arrogance. As a result of his failure to regret, the National Commission for Women has also taken exception to the incident and issued a notice. Now, Nath is trying to tell everyone the meaning of the word 'item'; whereas he could have said his remark was not meant to offend any woman. It indicates Nath's advisers have failed to think that the statement is not confined to the by-elections, and that it has dented the image of a respectable national leader. There are some leaders known for courting controversies. Mani Shankar Aiyar, Anant Hegde and Grijal Kishore are some of them. Nath kept Digvijaya Singh away from campaigning, so that there may not be any controversy. But Nath has courted trouble for himself. Nath has had enough time to bury the hatchet, but instead of doing that, he has continued to justify his statement. His aides have failed to convince him that this is the time to abandon stubbornness and to show humility. The politics in Gwalior and Chambal region is so sensitive that a non-issue can turn into a major controversy and change the political scene. What kind of impact Nath's obstinacy will have on the Congress in the by-elections will be known only after the results are out.

Lockdown has ended...

He underlined that India has been successful in saving the maximum number of lives with over 90 lakh hospital beds, 12,000 quarantine centres and 2000 labs at its disposal. The tests, too, will shortly cross the 10 crore population threshold. Looking at the future, he said the government is doing the ground work, so that every Indian can access the vaccine as soon as it arrives in the market. The PM delved into the past and cited the mystic 15th century poet Kabir and quoted from the 16th century epic Ramcharitmahas of Tulsidas to bring home the message that the nation should not relax until the vaccine is available.

Silawat & Rajput...

Whereas the notification about their minister berth is the jurisdiction of the Governor and of the government, the state assembly is the only receiver of the acknowledgment. The delay in announcing the bypoll dates - due to pandemic - has put the future of two ministers in uncertainty. Election Commission of India announced by-elections to the 28 assembly seats in the state on September 29. The polling is to be held on November 3 and the counting will take place on November 10.

BSY will not...

There have been speculations in some quarters in recent times about the possible change in leadership, considering Yediyurappa's age. However, the state BJP had recently issued a statement strongly refuting reports about replacing the 77-year old Lingayat strongman. Stating that the BJP got the Chief Minister because of support from people of north Karnataka, Yatal said, "will anyone vote for them in southern districts like Mandya, Chamarajanagar or Kolar, it is us people of north Karnataka who send good number of MLAs and about 10-15 may come from other parts." "Ninety-five per cent MLAs (in BJP) will be us (from north Karnataka). So people at the top (BJP High command) have also understood. It has come in the mind of our Prime Minister that the successor (to Yediyurappa) should be from north Karnataka, he has said after Yediyurappa it will be from north Karnataka, it is almost final..." he said. Yatal also said, people from the Bengaluru side (southern region) will have to come and stand in front of our house in Vijayapura, like we go and stand in front of their houses now.

US Justice Dept...

It could be an opening salvo ahead of other major government antitrust actions, given ongoing investigations of major tech companies including Apple, Amazon and Facebook at both the Justice Department and the Federal Trade Commission. "Google is the gateway to the internet and a search advertising behemoth," U.S. Deputy Attorney General Jeff Rosen told reporters. "It has maintained its monopoly power through exclusionary practices that are harmful to competition." Antitrust cases in the technology industry have to move quickly, he said. Otherwise "we could lose the next wave of innovation." The Justice Department isn't seeking specific changes in Google's structure or other remedies at this point, but isn't ruling out seeking additional relief, officials said. Lawmakers and consumer advocates have long accused Google, whose corporate parent Alphabet Inc. has a market value just over \$1 trillion, of abusing its dominance in online search and advertising to stifle competition and boost its profits. Critics contend that multibillion-dollar fines and mandated changes in Google's practices imposed by European regulators in recent years weren't severe enough and that structural changes are needed for Google to change its conduct. Google responded immediately via tweet: "Today's lawsuit by the Department of Justice is deeply flawed. People use Google because they choose to - not because they're forced to or because they can't find alternatives." The case was filed in federal court in Washington, D.C. It alleges that Google uses billions of dollars collected from advertisers to pay phone manufacturers to ensure Google is the default search engine on browsers. Eleven states, all with Republican attorneys general, joined the federal government in the lawsuit. But several other states demurred. The attorneys general of New York, Colorado, Iowa, Nebraska, North Carolina, Tennessee and Utah released a statement Monday saying they have not concluded their investigation into Google and would want to consolidate their case with the DOJ's if they decided to file. "It's a bipartisan statement," said spokesman Fabien Levy of the New York State attorney general's office. "There's things that still need to be fleshed out, but..." President Donald Trump's administration has long had Google in its sights. One of Trump's top economic advisers said two years ago that the White House was considering whether Google searches should be subject to government regulation. Trump has often criticized Google, recycling unfounded claims by conservatives that the search giant is biased against conservatives and suppresses their viewpoints, interferes with U.S. elections and prefers working with the Chinese military over the Pentagon.

Further, he discussed different aspects of marketing after Covid-19 outbreak in one-on-one interview: 66 lakh jobs lost in 2 months. Need to expand reach According to its latest data shared by Centre for Monitoring Indian Economy (CMIE), an estimated 66 lakh white-collar professional jobs including those of engineers, teachers and physicians were lost between May and August dragging employment down to the lowest it has been since 2016. In such times, Upadhyaya suggested, "To survive in white-collar positions, every professional needs to influence the market not just physically but also digitally." He added that maintaining and forming relations in the virtual world can expand reach and act as a strength for a manager. Startups: innovate, adopt & capture market With Covid-19 outbreak and financial constraints, markets have suffered losses. In such a situation, as a mentor to start-ups, Upadhyaya suggested, "It is essential to study the market and provide innovative solutions." He gave an example of how android technology changed the scenario of smartphone market. "By adopting what is needed like home deliveries, quick services, etc. in corona times, you can capture the market and win over traditional markets," Upadhyaya said.

ICMR rethink on...

RE-INFECTION: Another grey area is that of re-infection. The ICMR has said patients who have recovered from Covid-19 can again get infected once the antibodies of the viral disease start depleting. As per the guidelines of the US Centre for Disease Control, it can be called a reinfection (of Covid-19) if the person is re-infected after 90 days from turning negative.

Survey in Nov to count migrant labourers, domestic workers

The Centre plans to conduct surveys in November to assess data relating to the wages and social security of the migrant and domestic workers under a proforma designed by a committee headed by Calcutta University's professor emeritus Dr SP Mukherjee.

The decision was taken after the government faced an embarrassment in Parliament in admitting to the MPs' questions that it had no data on the migrant workers who may have died during the Coronavirus-induced lockdown. In fact, it has no data at all on the migrant workers hopping from one state to another in search of employment. The survey is expected to be completed in 6-7 months.

A 40-year-old law says that the migrant workers must be registered both in their home state and workplace state. But several committees, including a parliamentary standing committee, have found that most of the states



never implemented this law. So, the government had no data on them during the lockdown, which left millions of migrant workers jobless and stranded. Many perished while attempting to walk hundreds of miles home virtually on empty stomachs. Enumerators of the labour bureau, a government body, will conduct the surveys. The surveys will tap household, employers and government agencies that register commercial establishments

or keep records about them. There isn't much data on domestic workers or the people engaged (as helpers) by (unregistered) professional firms or individual professionals such as lawyers, architects or doctors who are to be also covered, the Labour Ministry sources said. The purpose is to know about the remunerations and social security of these categories of workers to help the government devise policies to implement the labour laws

passed recently. Parliament last month passed three labour laws - on the workers' occupational safety and health, right to strike and farm trade unions, and social security, respectively - after having passed a wage code last year. The law on occupational safety and health mandates the creation of a database of migrant workers, and the wage code allows domestic workers to seek the minimum wage.

PORN MESSAGE ROW

BJP defends Goa Dy CM, Oppn seeks his removal

PANAJI: The Congress on Tuesday sought the resignation of Goa Deputy CM Chandrakant Kavlekar over the ongoing porn Whatsapp message controversy, even as the ruling BJP defended him, saying the party respects women and efforts were on to defame Kavlekar.

The porn content laden Whatsapp message, purportedly sent from Kavlekar's phone, has kicked up a storm in Goa with Opposition parties seeking the Deputy CM's resignation.

"If BJP believes in the 'Beti Bachao Beti Padhao' principle, then CM Pramod Sawant should sack Kavlekar immediately and an impartial police probe should be initiated," head of the party's Goa social media cell Pratibha Borkar said on Tuesday.



On Monday, Kavlekar had filed a criminal complaint with the Cyber Cell of the Goa Police, saying unknown persons hacked his smartphone late on Sunday night and sent a porn message to a Whatsapp

'Vietnam important for India's Indo-Pacific Ocean's Initiative'

Vietnam is an important partner in India's 'Indo-Pacific Ocean's Initiative' which is based on shared values and interests in promoting peace, stability and prosperity in the region, a senior official of the Ministry of External Affairs

(MEA) said on Tuesday.

The comments by Secretary (East) in the MEA Riva Ganguly Das came at a time India is attempting to further strengthen maritime security ties with key member countries of the 10-nation ASEAN in the wake of China's growing assertiveness in the Indo-Pacific region.

"Today, our comprehensive strategic partnership spans a wide-range of collaboration - from political engagement to economic and development partnership, defence and security cooperation, energy cooperation, cultural exchanges and people-to-people contacts," Das said at a virtual meeting of India-Vietnam Business Forum.

MUTTIAH MURALITHARAN BIOPIC ROW

Actor Sethupathi's daughter gets rape threat

Tamil actor Vijay Sethupathi's daughter received a rape threat on social media today, as controversy over her father's initial acceptance of a starring role in '800' - a biopic on Sri Lankan cricketer Muttiah Muralitharan - refuses to die down.

Sethupathi, who has already quit the film, was told his daughter would be raped if he acted in the movie. 'Twitter user @ItsRithikRajh reportedly said "only sexual assault would make him (Sethupathi) learn the hardship

faced by Lankan Tamils". The account has been deleted; it is unclear if it was removed by Twitter or the user. Chennai Police have registered a case and an investigation is underway. Sethupathi yesterday withdrew from the film after fierce criticism from political leaders and others in the southern state over his portraying of a man who "played fiddle when Lankan Tamils were dying". The actor's decision came after an appeal by Muralitharan; the cricketer said he did not wish for a top artist to be affected because of him.

Uttarakhand HC notice to Maha Governor Koshyari

The Uttarakhand High Court on Tuesday sought Maharashtra Governor Bhagat Singh Koshyari's stand on a plea seeking to initiate a contempt proceeding against him for his failure to follow a court order to pay market rent for a government bungalow allocated to him as a former chief minister.

Justice Sharad Kumar issued notice to Koshyari through his counsel after hearing arguments of the petitioner's counsel on maintainability of the contempt plea. The plea filed by a Dehradun-based NGO, Rural Litigation and Entitlement Kendra, accuses the former chief minister of committing "wilful non-compliance"

of the court's May 3, 2019 order which had asked him to pay market rent of the bungalow occupied by him as ex-CM within six months of the direction. Koshyari has till date not paid the market rent to the government as calculated against him, the petitioner said. The respondent has also not paid the amount due from him towards amenities such as electricity, water, petrol, oil etc. "We have fulfilled the requirement provided under Article 361(4) of the Constitution of In-



dia and given 60 days' notice to Koshyari before filing the contempt petition, petitioner's counsel Kartikeya Hari Gupta said. The petition also accuses the state government of favouring the respondent unlawfully and arbitrarily by passing the Uttarakhand Former Chief Minister Facilities (Residential and other Facilities) Ordinance 2019" and later enacting a law with the same name to ease him out of his payment obligations.

Ex-ACP slaps Arnab with defamation suit

A former assistant commissioner of police (ACP) has filed a defamation suit against Arnab Goswami and ARG Outlier Media Network Private Limited - the company that owns Republic India and Republic Bharat - for running a sustained defamation campaign against Mumbai Police for the latter's probe in the TRP scam case. The former officer has sought that an injunction be issued, restraining the channels from discussing the case either directly or indirectly. He has also claimed damages of Rs 5 lakh for causing mental agony and loss of reputation, having been a decorated officer of the institution. Iqbal Shaikh, who is also a

recipient of the President's Police Medal for Gallantry said the "smear campaign" has aggrieved him, as he takes pride in his legacy in the illustrious force. It has consequently caused harm to his reputation, as he is a former police officer. The suit, filed through advocate Abha Singh before the City Civil Court said that in open contempt of the Press Council of India guidelines, which requires the owner/management to be distinct from the editor, Goswami tripled as owner and director, editor-in-chief and third, as the main anchor of debates. He was mis-using his position, it stated, annoyed that he had to face investigation and added that he was "serving his private interest as owner of the TV channel, to wriggle out of

Biomedical waste management urgent to halt Covid-19: UNIDO

NEW DELHI

The United Nations Industrial Development Organisation (UNIDO) on Tuesday stressed the need to halt the spread of Covid-19 through all possible infection channels, including from contact with or mismanagement of infectious waste. UNIDO Representative in India Rene Van Berkel also said that this is possible with proven biomedical waste management practices and techniques, and never before has it been so urgent to adopt these. He was speaking at a webinar on "Managing bio-medical waste to ensure near-zero infections spread among waste man-

agement workers" organised by Communeeti, a non-profit organisation working on community-centric policy making, in partnership with the Ramaiah Medical College and supported by UNIDO-India. UNIDO has been working to develop and implement environmentally sound practices and techniques for medical waste with 160 plus hospitals across the states of Karnataka, Punjab, Odisha, Maharashtra and Gujarat. Since the onset of Covid-19, it has been reported that project interventions have resulted in achieving near-zero Covid-19 infections among waste management

workers in project hospitals. This was done through a multi-faceted approach which included strict segregation and containment of waste supported by instructional videos, professional training, development and roll-out of Covid-19 specific biomedical waste rules, identification and promotion of suppliers of waste management related goods and services. At the webinar, Temsutula Im-song, the cleanliness warrior of Varanasi, talked about her experience of cleaning the ghats of Varanasi through community participation and how hospitals have to play an important role in efficient handling of biomedical waste.

The webinar witnessed a panel discussion with experts from the sector, including representatives of the hospitals working under this project and from State Pollution Control Boards. Biomedical waste is a threat to global public and environmental health. Worldwide, it is estimated that at least 5.2 million people, including 4 million children, die each year because of diseases related to unmanaged medical waste. Considering the Covid-19 pandemic, the surge in infectious waste from healthcare facilities as well as residential and other sectors has become a new major threat to public health and the environment.

Criminal defamation case

Rahul's plea for exemption from appearance in case heard

AHMEDABAD: A court in Ahmedabad in Gujarat on Tuesday heard Congress leader Rahul Gandhi's plea seeking permanent exemption from appearance in a criminal defamation case. Gandhi's lawyer PS Champaneri concluded his submission in the court of Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate RB Etaliya on Tuesday. The criminal defamation suit was filed against Gandhi for calling Union Home Minister Amit Shah a "murder accused" at an election rally in Jaipur. Gandhi's jibe was slanderous as Shah was acquitted in the Sohrabuddin Shaikh fake encounter case in 2015, said the complainant BJP corporator Krishnavadan Brahmhatt.
