# Govt brings new 'BH' registration series for personal vehicles

New Delhi, August 28

**TO ENSURE SEAMLESS** transfer of personal vehicles across states, the road transport ministry has come up with a new registration mark for new vehicles — Bharat Series (BH-series).

In this regard, the government has notified a new vehicle registration regime that will free vehicle owners from re-registration process when they shift from one state/Union Territory to another.


"This vehicle registration facility under 'Bharat series (BH-series)' will be available on voluntary basis to defence personnel, employees of central government/ state government/central/ state public sector undertakings and private sector companies/organisations, which have their offices in four or more states/Union Territories," the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (MoRTH) said in a statement.

This scheme, it said, will facilitate free movement of personal vehicles across states/Union Territories of India upon relocation.

The statement further said that an IT-based solution for vehicle registration is one such effort as "one of the pain points in the vehicle registration process that needed attention was re-registration of a vehicle while moving to another state".

It further said that 2% extra charge will be levied for diesel vehicles, while electric vehicles will be charged 2% less tax.

The MORTH through a notification dated 26th August 2021, has introduced a new registration mark for new vehicles i.e. "Bharat series (BH-series)". A vehicle bearing this registration mark shall not require assignment of a new registration mark when the owner of the vehicle shifts from one state to another", the statement further explained.

According to the notification, the motor vehicle tax levied by the state and Union Territories at the time of registration in respect to BH-series non-transport vehicle will be 8% in case of vehicles costing up to ₹10 lakh, 10% in case of vehicles costing between ₹10-20 lakh and 12% in case of vehicles costing above ₹20 lakh.

The format of BH-series registration mark will be YY BH #####XX.YY denotes the year of first registration, BH is code for

bears BH-series registration mark, the motor vehicle tax shall be levied electronically.

The new rules also called Central Motor Vehicles (Twentieth Amendment) Rules, 2021, shall come into force with effect from September 15, 2021. The registration mark for BH-series vehicle will be generated randomly through the portal.

Currently, a person is allowed to keep vehicle for a maximum of 12 months in any state other than the state where it is registered. The owners has to get such vehicles re-registered before the expiry of 12 months.

At present, a passenger vehicle owner for re-registration of vehicle has to take no objection certificate from the parent state for assignment of a new registration mark in another state.

Also, the assignment of new registration mark is done after the road tax on prorata basis is paid in the new state.

## We are fast progressing in FTA discussions with nations like UK, UAE: Goyal

**INDIA IS FAST** progressing in discussions on different free-trade agreements (FTAs) with countries, including the UK and the UAE, to further enhance trade and investment ties, Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal said on Saturday.

Under an FTA, two trading partners reduce or eliminate customs duties on the maximum number of goods traded between them.

Besides, they liberalise norms to enhance trade in services and boost investments. Goyal said India is engaging for such pacts with economies having transparent rule of law and with whom India can have confidence that it will get a fair deal and reciprocal benefits.

"We are fast progressing in our discussions with the UK, with the UAE and other GCC (Gulf Cooperation Council) countries. Canada and Australia are really on a fast track," Goyal said while addressing the JITO Trade Mahakumbh. The minister also

stated that recently, he had discussions with the USA's Chargé D'Affaires in Delhi Atul Keshap, and both agreed to aspire for a \$500-billion trade between the countries at the earliest possible time. The world is looking for a trusted partner and that partner is India's business community, he added.

He added that whether it is FDI (foreign direct investment), forex reserves, food-grain reserves, agriculture production or manufacturing, all sectors are on a growth path.

## 'No outages in facility linking Aadhaar with PAN, EPFO; all services stable'

**THE UNIQUE IDENTIFICATION** Authority of India (UIDAI) on Saturday said there have been no outages in its Aadhaar-PAN/EPFO linking facility, which is authentication-based, and asserted that all its services are "stable". The comment came amid reports of UIDAI system outages in linking Aadhaar with PAN and EPFO. The reports said that the glitch had left Aadhaar users in a lurch, even as EPF and PAN linking deadline looms.

# American forces keep up airlift under heightened threat warnings

**AMERICAN FORCES WORKING** under heightened security and threats of another attack pressed ahead in the closing days of the US-led evacuation from Afghanistan after a devastating suicide bombing, and US officials said they had killed a member of the extremist group that the United States believes responsible for it.

A US drone strike early Saturday in eastern Afghanistan killed a member of the country's Islamic State affiliate, US Central Command said.

"US military forces conducted an over-the-horizon counterterrorism operation today against an ISIS-K planner. The unmanned airstrike occurred in the Nangarhar province of Afghanistan. Initial indications are that we killed the target," Capt Bill Urban, spokesperson of US Central Command, said on Friday.

"We know of no civilian casualties," he said.

Earlier in the day, the White House said President Joe Biden does not want the terrorists, who planned the attack at the Kabul airport, to live any longer.

The next few days "will be our most dangerous period to date" in the evacuation, White House press secretary Jen Psaki said, hours before the US issued a security alert for four of the airport gates. Thursday's bombing marked one of the most lethal attacks the country has seen. The US said it was the deadliest day for American forces in Afghanistan since 2011.

Jamshad went to the airport Friday with his wife and three small children. He clutched an invitation to a Western country he didn't want to identify.

"After the explosion I decided I would try. Because I am afraid now there will be more attacks, and I think now I have to leave," said Jamshad, who like many Afghans uses only one name. The Pentagon said Friday that there was just one suicide bomber—at the airport gate—not two, as US officials initially said. A US official said that the bomber carried a heavier-than-usual load of about 25 pounds of explosives, loaded with shrapnel. The US official spoke on condition of anonymity to discuss preliminary assessments of the attack. The officials said that some gates were closed and other security measures put in place. They said there were tighter restrictions at Taliban checkpoints and fewer people around the gates.

As the call to prayer echoed Friday through Kabul along with the roar of departing planes, the anxious crowds thronging the airport in hope of escaping Taliban rule appeared as large as ever, despite the scenes of victims lying closely packed together in the aftermath of the bombing.

Around the world, newly arriving Afghan evacuees, many clutching babies and bare handfuls of belongings in plastic bags, stepped off evacuation flights in the United States, in Albania, in Belgium and beyond.

The American dead were 11 Marines, a Navy sailor and an Army soldier.

Many had been tiny children when US forces first entered Afghanistan in 2001.

One, Marine Lance Cpl Karem Mae'lee Grant Nikoui, sent a video to a family friend in the United States just hours before he was killed, showing himself smiling and greeting Afghan children. "Want to take a video together, buddy?" Nikoui asked young boy, leaning in to be in the picture with him. "All right, we're heroes now, man."

British officials said two of the country's citizens and the child of another Briton were among those killed. On the morning after the attack, the Taliban used a pickup truck full of fighters and three captured Humvees to set up a barrier 500 meters (1,600 feet) from the airport, holding the crowds farther back from the US troops than before. US military officials said that some gates were closed and other security measures put in place. They said there were tighter restrictions at Taliban checkpoints and fewer people around the gates.

In Kabul on Friday, Afghan families looked for loved ones among bodies, placed along a hospital sidewalk for identification, of bombing victims who died pleading for a seat on the US-run airlifts. Afghans, American citizens and other foreigners were all acutely aware the window was closing to get out via the airlift.
