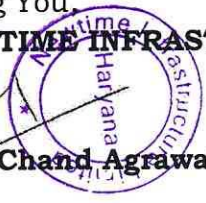

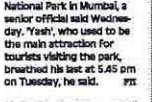

Residents stand in queue with plastic vessels to collect water from a distribution tanker in Chennai on Wednesday. AFP



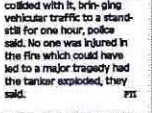

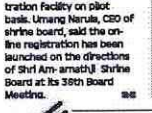

'More TMC MLAs & councillors will join BJP'

KOLKATA, 29 MAY

More MLAs and councillors of the TMC may soon join BJP after former Jeeo 50 councillors and two MLAs, who joined BJP in Delhi yesterday. BJP leader Mukul Roy said today six more MLAs of the Trinamool Congress will join BJP within Saturday.

North Bengal will join BJP. In another job to the TMC, its MLA Monirul Islam joined the BJP on Wednesday, the third legislator to desert the ruling party in West Bengal after the reverses in the Lok Sabha polls.

The BJP projected the decision of TMC's Muslim MLA Islam as a victory. The decision of Prime Minister Narendra Modi's slogan of 'Sabka Saath, Sabka Vikas, Sabka Vishwas' (together with all development for all, trust of all).

Three MLAs, including BJP leader Mukul Roy's son Subhrajit Roy, and over 50 councillors, most of them from the TMC, joined the saffron party on Tuesday as it works to consolidate its position in the state following impressive show in the Lok Sabha polls.

Pratap Banerjee announced her decision not to attend the swearing-in of Prime Minister Narendra Modi at the Capital tomorrow. Congress, CPI-M and BJP leaders were vocal in her criticism today.

Pratap Banerjee said that the chief minister should not have stayed away from the culmination of the festival of democracy. She said she would not call it a wise political move on her part, he felt.

BJP activists who became victims of political violence denounced the chief minister's enthusiasm to attend the Prime Minister swearing-in ceremony, he said.

Chandra Kumar Bose, a BJP leader and the party's losing candidate for Kolkata South constituency, said Banerjee cannot escape responsibility for the political killings as she also holds the home portfolio.

Addressing the first Cabinet meeting of the newly constituted ministry, he said 'the world should know that Odisha's time has come and our time starts now'.

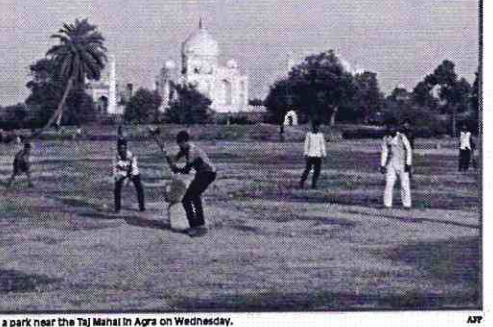
Naveen's team for the fifth term indicated a fresh start. Many who were regarded as 'powerful, yet controversial' had been dropped out of the ministry.

Considering the challenge faced by the Left, he said, the national executive wants reworking of strategies and re-energising of party activities.

CPI general secretary S Subramanian Reddy today said his party's national executive was deeply concerned over the marginalisation of Left parties in the General Election, and wanted 'reunification' of the Communist movement to face the situation.

While issues like unemployment, price-rise, attacks on minorities and Dalits, mending up of the economy went under the carpet. Only DMK showed foresight in working out reasonable seat sharing in Tamil Nadu. The BJP was able to score big on the slogan of nationalism and national security.

Answering a question on Congress president Rahul Gandhi's election from Wayanad, he said his party too had opposed Gandhi's coming to Wayanad, but it actually helped union secularism in some other constituencies also.

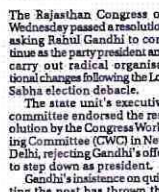

Raj Congresses resolution, asks Rahul not to resign

The Rajasthan Congress on Wednesday passed a resolution asking Rahul Gandhi to continue as the party president and carry out radical organisational changes following the Lok Sabha election debacle.

The state unit's executive committee endorsed the resolution by the Congress Working Committee (CWC) in New Delhi, rejecting Gandhi's offer to step down as president.

Gandhi's insistence on quitting the post has thrown the Congress into turmoil and the Rajasthan meeting was among the attempts made by the party to make him change his mind.

The unanimous resolution by the executive committee of the Pradesh Congress Committee (PCC) was addressed to Rahul Gandhi.

He said the party has full confidence in Gandhi, urging him to continue with his effective leadership.

The Pradesh Congress executive committee accepts all those challenges, failures and shortcomings which led to this mandate. AICC general secretary-in-charge of Rajasthan Avinash Pandey told reporters, ding out the resolution. He said all members of the executive committee authorised the

and down before. Democracy is in danger and we have to work for protecting constitutional values, and work actively under the leadership of the Congress president," he said in a statement.

He accused the BJP of inciting religious and casteist feelings and making the Army's vote an election issue to divert attention from the real issues. Rajasthan Congress president Sachin Pilot said the party will analyse the reasons behind people voting for the BJP, just months after they elected a Congress government in the state.
