# Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samridhi Kendra (PMKSK): Empowering Indian Agriculture

As per Economic Survey 2022-23, around 65 % of the country's population lives in the rural areas and 47 per cent of the population is dependent on agriculture for livelihood. Agriculture is a time bound activity that requires right agrinputs at right time to maximise the production and productivity. Agri-inputs are essential ingredients of agriculture and an efficient delivery system of agri-inputs and services play a crucial role in the growth of farm income.

In India, network of input services is fragmented and there are separate dealer networks for seeds, fertilizers, pesticides and implements acting in silos promoting their respective interests. In addition, need for testing of soil, seed, fertilizers and information regarding different farmer oriented schemes reaches farmers through different agencies in a disjointed and piece meal manner. This approach fails to provide technology based holistic information to the farmers for taking informed decisions. The solution lies in providing holistic solution to the farmers under one umbrella/ roof backed by government that the farmer can trust and follow. In the past, the private sector has tried to replicate the model of umbrella centres for farmers' inputs and services but more or less those attempts remained unsuccessful.

Thus, the idea of transforming the existing fertilizer retail shops that are mostly frequented by farmers into Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samridhi Kendra (PMKSK) , a one-stop shop solution, has come up as a sustainable and long term solution to cater to the

needs of the farmers. The programme launched by the Modi Government, has ushered in a revolutionary transformation in the country's agricultural sector. With a vision to empower farmers and boost agricultural growth, this pioneering initiative aims to simplify access to agricultural inputs, information, and services, uplifting the lives of farmers and contributing to the nation's progress.

Under the PMKSK initiative, around 2, 80,000 active retail fertiliser shops are undergoing a phased conversion into comprehensive one-stop shops for farmers. At its core, the PMKSK initiative focuses on offering a diverse range of agri-inputs, including fertilizers, seeds, and pesticides, small farm machinery/ implements to the farmers including drone services for spraying of fertilizers and pesticides in a hassle-free and convenient manner. A vital aspect of the PMKSK initiative is the provision of soil and seed testing facility. By equipping farmers with knowledge about their specific soil and crop conditions, these facilities enable informed decision-making, optimised resource utilisation, and higher yields. This promotes precision agriculture and resource-efficient farming practices. Moreover, PMKSKs serve as knowledge hubs, disseminating crucial information on crops and government welfare schemes. Bridging the information gap, these centres empower farmers to make informed choices, thereby enhancing their efficiency and income. The aim is to simplify the lives of millions of farmers. The initiative will ensure better farm productivity and overall prosperity of the farming community.

Recent developments demonstrate the success of the Pradhan Mantri

Kisan Samridhi Kendra initiative. In a significant event named 'PM-Kisan Sammelan' held in Sikar, Rajasthan, on July 27, 2023, the Hon'ble Prime Minister dedicated 1,25,000 PMKSKs to the nation. The widespread participation of nearly 2 crore farmers across the country shows an affirmative stamp by the end users to this initiative.

The success of the initiative can also be gauged from the feeling of oneness and sense of pride among different stakeholders. The recent survey indicated that there is already 15-20% increase in number of farmers visiting the centres and it is found that they are happy with the transformation right from ambience of the PMKSK to the facilities and inputs available at the centres. Thus, PMKSK initiative is proving to be a game changer in empowering the farmers and strengthening the backbone of the nation's economy. By simplifying access to agricultural inputs and knowledge, empowering farmers with modern technologies, and fostering sustainable practices, PMKSKs are ushering in a new era of prosperity for the farming community. With unwavering government support and collective efforts from stakeholders, PMKSKs will continue to drive positive change, strengthening the agricultural backbone of the nation and contributing to a thriving and self-reliant agrarian ecosystem. # New BNS Bill proposes to do away with IPC provisions on unnatural sex, adultery

NEW DELHI, AUG 13/--/ The Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS) Bill which is proposed to replace the British-era Indian Penal Code (IPC) does away with two contentious provisions on unnatural sex and adultery that were diluted and struck down respectively by the Supreme Court in 2018.

Under the IPC, Section 377 says "whoever voluntarily has carnal inter course against the order of nature with any man, woman or animal, shall be punished with [imprisonment for life], or with imprisonment of either description for a term which may extend to ten years, and shall also be liable to fine". On September 6, 2018, a five-judge bench unanimously decriminalised a part of Section 377. However, the provision still stood in the statute book to deal with unnatural sexual offences against minors, against their consent and bestiality. In the new BNS Bill, there is no provision on "unnatural sex".

On September 27, 2018, a five-judge bench of the Supreme Court unanimously struck off from the statute books Section 497 of IPC which made adultery a criminal offence for men but did not penalise women.

Under Section 497, "Whoever has sexual intercourse with a person who is and whom he knows or has reason to believe to be the wife of another man, without the consent or connivance of that man, such sexual intercourse not amounting to the offence of rape, is guilty of the offence of adultery, and shall be punished with imprisonment of either description for a term which may extend to five years, or with fine, or with both. In such case the wife shall not be punishable as an abettor".

The top court had said that acts of adultery will not qualify as a crime, although they would still be grounds for civil action and divorce. Under the BNS Bill, there is no provision related to the offence of adultery.

Attempt to commit suicide was a punishable offence under Section 309 of the IPC until the passing of the Mental Healthcare Act in 2017, which in effect decriminalised suicide by creating a massive exception to Section 309. Under section 115 of the Mental Healthcare Act of 2017, there was a

presumption of severe stress in case of an attempt to commit suicide.

It said that notwithstanding anything contained in section 309 of the Indian Penal Code, any person who attempts to commit suicide shall be presumed, unless proved otherwise, to have severe stress and shall not be tried and punished under the said Code. It further said the appropriate government shall have a duty to provide care, treatment and rehabilitation to a person, having severe stress and who attempted to commit suicide, to reduce the risk of recurrence of attempt to commit suicide.

However, in the BNS Bill, 2023, there is no mention of the separate offence of an attempt to commit suicide as in section 309 of IPC.

The new bill does have Section 224 which criminalises an attempt to commit suicide to compel or restrain exercise of lawful power. According to Section 224 of the BNS Bill, "Whoever attempts to commit suicide with the intent to compel or restrain any public servant from discharging his official duty shall be punished with simple imprisonment for a term which may extend to one year or with fine or with both or with community service." There are similar other various provisions related to defamation and offence against women, which are being sought to be changed. One of the highlights of the BNS Bill, 2023 is that it seeks to repeal the offence of sedition under the IPC and provides capital sentence as the maximum punishment for crimes such as mob lynching and rape of minors. While the IPC has 511 sections, the BNS Bill contains 356 provisions.

Under the IPC, Section 124-A deals with offence of sedition and prescribes a sentence of life imprisonment or imprisonment which may extend to three years, to which a fine may be added.

In the BNS Bill, provision 150 under the chapter pertaining to

offences against the State talks about acts endangering the sovereignty, unity and integrity of India.

"Whoever, purposely or knowingly, by words, either spoken or written, or by signs, or by visible representation, or by electronic communication or by use of financial mean, or otherwise, excites or attempts to excite, secession or armed rebellion or subversive activities, or encourages feelings of separatist activities or endangers sovereignty or unity and integrity of India;

or indulges in or commits any such act shall be punished with imprisonment for life or with imprisonment which may extend to seven years and shall also be liable to fine," section 150 of the BNS Bill says. While the punishment for the offence of murder is covered under Section 302 of the IPC, it has been covered under Provision 101 of the BNS Bill. The punishment for murder, that is life term or death sentence, remains unchanged.

The new bill proposes to make mob lynching a separate offence. As per provision 101 (2) of the BNS Bill, "When a group of five or more persons acting in concert commits murder on the ground of race, caste or community, sex, place of birth, language, personal belief or any other ground each member of such group shall be punished with death or with imprisonment for life or imprisonment for a term which shall not be less than seven years, and shall also be liable to fine." Similarly, the BNS Bill seeks to make a new provision on "snatching" under Section 302 which says, "Theft is 'snatching' if, in order to commit theft, the offender suddenly or quickly or forcibly seizes or secures or grabs or takes away from any person or from his possession any moveable property." The Bill says that whoever commits snatching shall be punished with imprisonment of up to three years and shall also be liable to a fine. (PTI)

# AIIMS doctor provides IVF patient's eggs to two women without consent; NMC lets her off with warning

NEW DELHI, AUG 13/--/ A doctor of the AIIMS-Delhi's gynaecology department who provided some eggs from a patient undergoing IVF treatment to two women without her consent in violation of ICMR's guidelines has been let off by the National Medical Commission with a warning almost six years after the incident. Issuing the warning on July 18, the NMC noted the doctor has contributed immensely to the field of reproductive medicine. "In spite of the fact that the act in question was done in good faith to benefit the poor patients without accruing any personal gain, it cannot be denied that prevailing guidelines were violated. So, the doctor is warned to be more careful in future," the order read. The doctor had appealed to the National Medical Commission after the Delhi Medical Council

(DMC) in September last year ordered the suspension of her license for one month. According to the complaint received by the DMC in 2017, 30 eggs were retrieved from the patient on August 12 of that year for an IVF procedure. Of these, 14 were taken by the doctor from the embryologist and provided those to two patients without the consent of the woman, said Dr Girish Tyagi, the secretary of DMC. A disciplinary committee of the DMC investigated the complaint. Following this, the DMC observed that "sharing a patient's eggs/oocytes is not only illegal, as sharing/donation of such nature is prohibited as per the ICMR guidelines, but also unethical, moreover, when no written consent of the donor as well as recipient as per the guidelines have been made available to the Delhi Medical Council." # Left Front announces candidates for Tripura Assembly bypolls

AGARTALA, AUG 13/--/ A day after meeting Tipra Motha and Congress leaders, the CPI(M)-led Left Front on Sunday announced its candidates for the September 5 bypolls in Dhanpur and Boxanagar assembly constituencies in Tripura's Sepahijala district. While Kaushik Chanda will be the Left Front's candidate from Dhanpur constituency, Mizan Hussain will contest from Boxanagar, front convenor Narayan Kar said. In the last Assembly elections, Chanda had lost to Union Minister Pratima Bhoumik from Dhanpur, but the CPI(M) managed to retain the Boxanagar seat defeating the BJP candidate in a triangular contest.

Mizan is the son of Boxanagar CPI(M) MLA Samsol Haque who passed away in July causing a vacancy. The bypoll in Dhanpur was necessitated after Bhoumik resigned from the Assembly days after her election. "The two candidates will submit their nomination papers on August 15," Kar told a press conference. CPI(M) state secretary Jitendra Chowdhury told reporters he had a meeting with two opposition parties Tipra Motha and Congress on Saturday and discussed about the polls. "We told the leaders of both parties that the CPI(M) has a strong political base in Dhanpur and Boxanagar. (PTI)
