WET SPELL DUE TO TWO CYCLONIC CIRCULATION

'Vigorous' monsoon leads to heavy rain in Saurashtra, Kutch

THE SOUTHWEST monsoon was "vigorous" in Saurashtra and Kutch, with widespread rain received by Saurashtra in the last 24 hours ending at 6 am on Tuesday, according to the India Meteorological Department (IMD).

According to the State Emergency Operation Centre (SEOC) in Gandhinagar, 143 of the 251 talukas in the state received significant rain from 6 am on Monday. The data showed that Vanthali taluka in Junagadh received 361 mm rain in the 24-hour period ending 6 am on Tuesday. It was followed by Visavadar taluka (336 mm), Junagadh taluka (297 mm), Junagadh city (297 mm) and Keshod taluka, where 248 mm of rain was recorded in 24 hours.

Other places where heavy downpour was recorded in the last 24 hours include Bardoli taluka of Surat (239 mm), Khambhalia taluka of Devbhumi Dwaraka (229 mm), Manavadar of Junagadh (224 mm) Navsari taluka of Navsari district (214 mm) and Kalyanpur taluka of Devbhumi Dwaraka (200 mm).

In all, 10 talukas of Saurashtra and south Gujarat regions received over 200 mm of rain in 24 hours. From 6 am to 6 pm on Tuesday, Lakhani in Banaskantha received 229 mm of rain. Vav and Suigam in

Banaskantha recorded 79 mm and 77 mm of rain, respectively. Mehsana and Becharaji in Mehsana received 96 mm each of rain, followed by Chikhli in Navsari at 94 mm. Nearly 170 talukas received rain on Tuesday. Ahmedabad city recorded an average of 12.53 mm of rain till 6 pm on Tuesday. Areas that received heavy rain include Paldi (28 mm), Jodhpur (23.5 mm) and Maninagar (22 mm).

While the maximum temperature in Ahmedabad was recorded at 29.8 degree Celsius, Vadodara 30.6 degree Celsius, Surat 30.2 degree Celsius, Amreli 31.6 degree Celsius, Bhuj 31.9 degree Celsius, Naliya and Kandla Port 32 degree Celsius each, Rajkot 32.6 degree Celsius, Surendranagar 32.8 de-

gree Celsius and Bhavnagar 33.6 degree Celsius.

On July 3, the IMD predicted very heavy rain in Surat, Navsari, Valsad and in Daman and Dadra Nagar Haveli. Gujarat is experiencing a wet spell due to two cyclonic circulation over north as well as south Gujarat, it added.

Relief Commissioner Jenu Devan on Tuesday chaired a meeting in Gandhinagar to discuss IMD's forecast of the state receiving heavy rain until July 4. The National Disaster Response Force officials who attended the meeting said while 10 teams have been deployed, five are on standby. Also, State Disaster Response Force teams have been deployed wherever required.

In Gujarat, the total average rain this season has been recorded as 17.85 per cent — 28.82 per cent in Saurashtra, 25.1 per cent in Kutch, 10.96 per cent

in east-central zone and 7.16 per cent in north Gujarat.

At Valsad district, schools and colleges in Valsad taluka were shut on Tuesday. According to the data shared by the district flood control department of Valsad, between 6 am on Monday and 4 pm on Tuesday, Valsad taluka received 132 mm of rain, followed by Vapi (94 mm), Kaprada (84 mm), Umargam 74 mm, Dharampur (63 mm) and Pardi (53 mm).

Ansuya Jha, In-charge district collector of Valsad, said: "Due to heavy rain from Monday night to Tuesday morning, we have decided to keep all schools, colleges, anganwadi and ITIs in Valsad taluka closed..."

At least 33 roads — six at Olpad, four at Palsana, 20 at Bardoli and three in Mandvi talukas — in Surat district were shut because of heavy rain since Tuesday morning. As per the disaster management department, between 6 am on Monday and 4 pm on Tuesday, Mahuva received 203 mm of rain, followed by Bardoli (259 mm), Palsana (222 mm), Olpad (145 mm), Kamrej (110 mm), Surat city (105 mm), Mandvi (95 mm), Umargam (82 mm) and Choryasi 43 mm.

Surat Collector Dr Sourabh Pardhi said: "Because of heavy rainfall, 33 roads have been shut, as water is overflowing. Since afternoon, as rainfall has decreased, water has started receding... No casualties have been reported so far."

HC dismisses plea seeking removal of blanket ban on gaming zones

THE GUJARAT High Court on Tuesday dismissed an application moved by an event and fun fair organising firm, seeking removal of "blanket ban" on gaming zones, which was ordered by the HC following the fire at TRP Game Zone in Rajkot, which claimed 27 lives on May 25.

Dav Event Organizers, through manager Amarpalsing Shyamsing Chauhan, moved an application before Chief Justice Sunita Agarwal and Justice Pranav Trivedi, seeking modification for

the order dated May 27 2024.

The state had closed all gaming zones following the fire in the TRP Gaming Zone and the order had recorded the same, with a direction that the gaming zones would remain closed until further orders.

According to the applicant, they were permitted to organise a fun fair event in Ahmedabad from May 9 to June 9 with permission from requisite authorities including the permit to fix the event's entry fee by Joint Commissioner of Police in the city.

However, it was halted following the Rajkot fire incident.

According to the applicant

they have submitted an application before the competent authority but there has been no development to the authorities' end owing to the HC order, which was passed suo motu.

The bench recorded that the application was "misconceived" and held that the court's direction is not an impediment as it did not qualify as a gaming zone.

Additionally, the court also recorded that the state has proposed actions against the applicant firm and closed their events on the account of violation of statutory conditions/guidelines for running such activities.

Inspector who assaulted, tried to run over toll plaza staff suspended

TWO DAYS after he was booked for allegedly attempting to murder two employees of a toll plaza on National Highway 8D in Junagadh, Inspector RA Bhojani, in-charge of Kodinar police station in neighbouring Gir Somnath district, was suspended from service on Tuesday.

The Junagadh police is looking for Bhojani, who is on the run, after he and 20 others were booked on Sunday in a case of attempt to murder, assault and rioting.

Bhojani had an argument with the staff of Gadoi toll plaza near Vanthali on the highway after he was asked to show his identification card by Bhavesh Tatamiya, the staffer manning the toll booth. Later, Bhojani and the other accused allegedly tried to run their car over Tatamiya and Rajesh Chhalya, the toll plaza supervisor, threatened them with guns and allegedly assaulted them with wooden sticks and steel pipes.

"The IG (inspector general) of Junagadh range has suspended Bhojani. We have transferred him from Kodinar police station and appointed him as inspector (leave reserve)," said Gir Somnath SP Manoharsingh Jadeja.

Bipin Thacker, deputy superintendent of Keshod sub-division of Junagadh district police and the investigating officer of the case, said: "Investigation has revealed that the Scorpio car in which Bhojani was travelling is owned by him. CCTV cameras at the toll plaza have captured the initial tussle between the victim and the accused. Efforts are on to arrest the accused."

ARRESTED FOR ATTEMPT TO MURDER

Woman constable was carrying liquor from Rajasthan, police tell court

THE HEAD constable attached to CID (Crime), who was arrested with an alleged bootlegger on Monday for allegedly trying to run over police officers who were chasing them, was carrying liquor from Rajasthan in the car, the police told a local court in Bhachau town of Kutch on Tuesday.

While the Kutch East police sought custody of the two accused — head constable Nita Chaudhary and Yuvrajsinh Jadeja — the court of Bhachau Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate D S Dabhi sent them to judicial custody.

In charge inspector of Bhachau police station, J M Jadeja, had on Monday produced Nita and Yuvrajsinh be-

fore the court.

Nita and Yuvrajsinh, a resident of Juni Moti Chirai village near Bhachau town, allegedly tried to run over six policemen while driving in a Thar car without registration plate on Sunday evening. The police had seized 16 bottles of liquor and two tins of beer from the car, which Yuvrajsinh stopped only when Dineshkumar Zala, a sub-inspector of Bhachau police station, fired on it.

In his remand application, J M Jadeja stated that Nita had brought the liquor consignment from Abu Road town in Rajasthan's Sirohi district, bordering Gujarat, and that Yuvrajsinh had joined her at a hotel in Samakhia village on National Highway 41 in Kutch's Bhachau taluka.

The court heard the remand application further on Tuesday.

Opposing the application, Dilip Joshi, advocate of Nita and Yuvrajsinh, questioned the police version of the event.

"I raised the question that if she was carrying liquor from Abu Road, how did she make it all the way to Kutch and was not caught anywhere in Banaskantha and Patan districts that she crossed? Why was she not stopped if she was driving the car with no vehicle registration plate," Joshi told *The Indian Express*.

He added that he told the court that Nita was framed by Kutch East police. "She is part of a team of CID (Crime) conducting a confidential investigation in the area in a smuggling case registered in Mundra last year, in which two IPS officers, two inspectors and other officers are facing the fraud. Therefore, the local police framed her."
