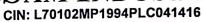

- 1 The above results have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at their respective meetings held on 31st July 2020.
- On 11 March 2020, the World Health Organization characterized the outbreak of the new coronavirus ("COVID-19") as a pandemic. This outbreak of COVID-19 is causing significant disturbance and slowdown of economic activities globally and in India. But the operations of the Company were not materially impacted in FY 2019-20 due to nationwide lockdown ordered by the Government of India. The management has considered the possible effects in FY 2020-21, that may result from the pandemic on the Company's operation including the impact on carrying value of receivables, inventories, assets and investments as on March 31, 2020. Based on the current indicators of future economic conditions the management expect to recover the carrying amount of these assets in total without any loss. However the management will continue to closely monitor any material changes to future economic conditions
- Adoption of Ind AS 116- Leases:The Company has adopted Ind AS 116. Leases, using modified retrospective method, Accordingly, the comparatives have not been retrospectively adjusted. The effect of this adoption is insignificant on the profit for the period and earning per share.
- The figures for the corresponding previous quarter have been restated / regrouped whenever necessary, to make them comparable.
- The figures of last quarter are the balancing figures between audited figures in respect of full financial year and the published year to date figures upto the third quarter of the current financial year.
