Small Spinning Mills to Stop Buying Cotton

Wait for prices to come down, allege hoarding by multinationals and big traders

Pune: Small-sized cotton spinning mills, which make yarn from cotton for weaving fabric, have decided to stop buying cotton and close mills till prices cool down to comfortable levels. They also accused multinational companies and

big traders in the industry of hoarding and speculation amid crop shortages. Cotton prices have increased by more than 120% in a year to Rs 1.10 lakh per catty. Spinning mills with annual turnover of less than ₹50 crore are finding it tough to buy cotton at the current prices.

The allocation also included stone paving, creating a cycle track, as well as signage on the road leading to the ashram.

The plan includes a library and resource centre. Gandhi's 3-D image would be displayed at an interactive exhibition centre. Using 3D imaging and multimedia technology, Gandhi's thoughts on economy, religion, caste, and gender would be conveyed to the younger genera-

The order added that the applica-

tion filed by the Anjuman Ibtidaiyya Masjid Committee, which manages the mosque, filed under Order VII, Rule 11 (challenging the maintainability of the suit) shall be taken up on May 26 for final disposal.

The order is crucial since the proceedings on May 25 will decide whether the suit filed by five Hindu women (which has already led to the survey and the issue reaching the Supreme Court) could be entertained at all, and if the 1991 Places of Worship Act has to be interpreted in a way that a group for ascertaining religious character of place of worship again — an argument that forms the edifice of the argument of the Mosque committee.

This will also mean that the court will take a call on the 1991 legislation, which locks the position of religious identity of any place of worship as it existed on

August 15, 1947, a decision that may have ramifications for other similar disputes in Mahara.

In its two-page order, the district judge also permitted the limited plea of the Hindu petitioners to file objections and comments to the advocate commissioner's report on the survey of the mosque. During the survey, as ordered by a Varanasi court in April, he said that signs of Hindu relics and motifs were also found inside the premises. According to the lawyers appearing in the matter before the Varanasi court on Tuesday, the district judge orally directed during the proceedings that the survey report will be shared with

both sides in a day or two to enable them to file their comments within seven days. "The hearing on the maintainability of the case will take place on May 26. The district judge will hear the matter as per directions of the Supreme Court," said additional district government counsel Rana Sanjeev Singh.

Abhay Nath Yadav, one of the advocates representing the masjid management committee, said, "Hearing on our application under Order 7, Rule 11 will be taken in the district court on Thursday."

Subhash Nandan Charurvedi, one of the advocates for the Hindu petitioners, said, "Our stand is the case is maintainable. On Monday, we had urged the court that a copy of the commission report should be made available to us. We will study it and file objections, if any."

Grasim Industries Ltd on Tuesday said it will invest ₹10,000 crore in its paints business by FY25, double the ₹5,000 crore announced in 2021.

Market dynamics of the decorative paints segment have changed and the new capacity building initiatives backed by strong growth and outlook, the Aditya Birla group company said. Grasim is expanding production capacity to 1,332 million litre per annum (mtpa) and will commission plants by Q4 FY24.

"The business is focused on timely execution of capacities. Civil construction has already commenced at two plant sites (Panipat and Ludhiana). Work at the Chamanjanagar plant is expected to start shortly. The remaining three plants are at different stages of government approval processes," it said in a statement.

Rai who chaired a meeting with officials from Delhi Parks and Garden Society, Deputy Commissioner of Environment, Environment department and land-owning agencies like CPWD, PWD, DDA, DSIDDC and the revenue department said, "It was decided to revive and develop 20 lakes in Delhi in accordance with international standards in the first phase of this project. The Kejriwal government is dedicated to the preservation and enhancement of the city's lakes."

2 brothers among 3 from Delhi swept away by Ganga in Shivpuri

GAURAV TALWAR: Three tourists, including two siblings, from Delhi drowned in river Ganga near the ITBP camp in Shivpuri district on Tuesday evening. The tragedy occurred when the two brothers and their friend, all in their twenties, entered the water to take a bath but were swept away by the strong currents of the river, which was swollen due to heavy rainfall in upstream areas in the past 48 hours. A team of State Disaster Response Force (SDRF) personnel managed to recover the body of 22-year-old Shubham, a resident of sector 11, Rohini, New Delhi. His brother Kartik, 20, and another brother, brother of Harkul Viraj in Najafgarh, are still missing. Only so far, their first names are known so far. "We had recovered one body on Tuesday evening. The search operation will resume on Wednesday morning," said sub-inspector Sunil Pant, in charge of Shivpuri police chowki. Pant added that the three victims were part of a nine-member group of friends who arrived on Tuesday morning and were planning to stay till May 26 evening. "Harkul Viraj, brother of Kartik and Shubham, told TOI, "Kartik was studying in Class 12. While Shubham was working in a salon. Deepanshu was a photographer."

Saxena to take oath as LG tomorrow

NEW DELHI: Newly-appointed lieutenant governor Vinay Kumar Saxena will take the oath of office on Thursday. Officials said arrangements are being made at Raj Niwas for the ceremony. According to officials, acting chief justice of Delhi High Court Vipin Sanghi will administer the oath of office and secrecy to Saxena. Interestingly Saxena will be the first LG of Delhi from a "corporate" background. All previous lieutenant governors have either been retired officers from civil services of Indian administrative, foreign, or police. On a couple of occasions, retired officials of the armed forces have also been given the charge of Delhi LG. While Saxena has been credited with turning around the Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC), the outgoing LG, was a career bureaucrat who worked on several important posts in Delhi and the Centre.

Give 'Vande Mataram' same status as 'Jana Gana Mana': Plea in HC

NEW DELHI: Senior BJP leader Ashwini Kumar Upadhyay has moved a public interest in Delhi High Court, seeking legal action for the song, 'Vande Mataram', as the national anthem, 'Jana Gana Mana'. It is likely to come up for hearing on Wednesday. He has also sought a decision from the Centre and state governments that both 'Jana Gana Mana' and 'Vande Mataram' are played and sung in all schools and educational institutions each working day. Upadhyay said "Vande Mataram, which played a historic part in the struggle for freedom, should be honoured like 'Jana Gana Mana' and have equal status with it in the spirit of the statement made by the Constituent Assembly Chairman Dr Rajendra Prasad with regard to the national Anthem in 1950. India is a union of states and not an association or confederation of states with just one or two states in India, and it is the duty of every Indian to respect 'Vande Mataram', he said. "In order to keep the country united, it is the duty of the government to frame a national policy to promote propagate Jana Gana Mana and Vande Mataram. There is no reason why it should evoke any other sentiment as the both are decided by Constitution makers," Upadhyay said in the petition.

Delhi gets centre for oral health, tobacco cessation

NEW DELHI: To check tobacco addiction among people, the Delhi government has come up with a National Resource Centre for Oral Health and Tobacco Cessation in the city. The centre, which the government claims to be first of its kind in the country, was inaugurated by the state health minister, Satyendar Jain, on Tuesday. It has been established at Maulana Azad Institute of Dental Sciences (MAIDS) with the objective of spreading awareness about the ill-effects of tobacco and drugs to provide better training to dentists and to conduct research on dental health. "It is the first national resource centre among the total 315 dental colleges in the country," the government said. "The centre will play a key role in developing the range of dental health professions in patient care, research and tobacco cessation," said Dr Sangeta Talwar, director, MAIDS.
