# 10% APPLICANTS ARE INDIANS: US issues 1.4 mn visas to Indians, sets record

Visitor appointment wait time down 75% from 1,000 days

PRESS TRUST OF INDIA New Delhi, January 29

THE US PROCESSED a record 1.4 million visas to Indians in 2023, bringing down visitor visa appointment wait times by 75%, the US Embassy said on Monday.

There was a 60% increase in visa applications from Indians compared to 2022.

Process improvements and investments in staffing have brought down appointment wait times for visitor visas from an average of 1,000 days to only 250 days around the country while wait times are minimal in all other categories, it said.

"In 2023, the US Embassy and Consulates in India processed a record-smashing 1.4 million visas, bringing down visitor visa appointment wait times by 75%. Demand across all visa classes was unprecedented, with a 60% increase in applications compared to 2022. Indians now represent one out of every 10 US visa applicants around the world," the Embassy said in a statement.

Visitor visas (B1/B2) have rebounded to represent the second highest number of applications in the US Mission's history at more than 700,000.

"The US Embassy and Consulates met this demand through a three-month staffing surge in Mumbai early in the year, by increased permanent staff levels and through the

employment of innovative technical solutions. Process improvements and investments in staffing have brought the appointment wait time for visitor visas down from an average of 1,000 days to only 250 days around the country. Wait times are minimal in all other categories," it said.

In 2023, the US consular team in India issued more than 140,000 student visas -- more than in any other country, setting a record for the third year in a row.

"Taken individually, Mumbai, New Delhi, Hyderabad and Chennai now stand as the top four student visa processing posts in the world. As a result of these surging numbers, Indian students have become the largest group of international graduate students in the United States and make up more than a quarter of the over one million foreign students studying in the United States," the US Embassy said.

"Employment visas remain a top priority. Consular team in India consolidated most petition-based visa processing in Chennai and Hyderabad to

increase efficiency, leading to the processing of over 380,000 employment visas for Indians and their family members in 2023 and allowing the US Mission to maintain a minimal appointment wait time," it added.

The US Embassy also said a pilot programme will streamline the renewal process for H-1B visa holders in 2024.

"In 2024, a pilot programme will allow eligible H1B holders to renew their visas in the United States, further streamlining the process for this group," it added.

The US Embassy said the Consulate General, Mumbai, eliminated a queue of more than 31,000 immigrant visa cases delayed by the pandemic. "Those who have a pending immigrant visa petition and are ready for scheduling can now obtain an appointment within the standard, pre-pandemic appointment window. The US Mission continues to invest in the future of consular services in India and explore ways to provide more efficient and convenient services," the statement said.

As England players win the on-field battle, Barmy Army is an overjoyed lot

BARMY ARMY'S LEAD trumpeter Simon Finch had a task on hand for the day after, what he and other travelling England fans are calling, "the best away win ever". Having flown to India without a chant for Hyderabad's unexpected hero, the left-arm debutant spinner Tom Hartley, he was busy composing the background score.

With figures of 7/62 in the second innings of the first game of the tour, there was an urgency in the Barmy Army rank and file to come up with a special song for Hartley. By evening it was ready. "The chant is ready, it is inspired by the Whitney Houston song 'I wanna dance with somebody,'" he tells *The Indian Express*.

Late into the night on Sunday, 1,000-odd England fans in Hyderabad weren't complaining with the Houston-inspired chant. Gathered at the city's '10 Downing Street' watering hole, they sang and danced through the night. Finch would come up with an apt song in the alien hand - "Everywhere we go, the people want to know who we are". The in-house DJ would soon cut off his music and play his own. The Army was in no mood to complain or even to leave the place.

"We went on well into midnight for sure. They first switched off the music systems, but we still kept going. Then they switched off a few lights. We responded by getting even louder. And then they switched off all the lights, but we still carried on in complete darkness. We can't wait to be in Vizag," chuckles Finch.

At the stadium all through

the first Test, the English fans had made their presence felt. "It was just an unbelievable atmosphere, definitely better than what we get back home," Chuck Adolphy, who is Barmy Army's tour manager, tells *The Indian Express*. "We were interestingly placed in between the school children. Back home, we are the ones who usually keep the mood going. But these kids were louder than what we have seen. So it was a real challenge to build one atmosphere of our own. But it made for some lovely moments."

Despite not having won a Test series in India since 2012, according to Adolphy a record number of fans are expected to turn up in India through the course of the series. While Dharamshala - the venue which is hosting the final Test, is set to be the biggest attraction, according to Adolphy, there is no better crowd-puller than Bazball.

"They have shown us there is a new way to play Test cricket and they have imprinted their style. Even if they step down tomorrow, there is no way, we can go back to that traditional way of playing Test cricket. The travelling fans tell you how even they are brought into this approach and it is what you come to pay and watch. Since the Bazball came on we are witnessing more membership requests and with every Test, the ticket demand has only been increasing," says Adolphy who is making all the arrangements including hotel stay, commute to the ground and travel within India.

traditional centres, there were concerns if England fans would turn up. But according to Adolphy, it turned into an unexpected game changer. "A lot of them have been coming here for years. And since the venues were scattered all across, in a vast country like India, it is tough to manage the logistics. But apart from getting to watch Bazball most of them also wanted to explore Hyderabad, Vizag, Rajkot, Ranchi and Dharamshala as they have never been before," Adolphy says.

Meanwhile, Finch gives a low down of the chants that they have been ready with. The one for Mark Wood is inspired by the Beatles' track 'Twist and Shout'. But there is a problem too. "He takes way too long to finish an over! Since he is putting in too much energy, it goes for seven-eight minutes and then you have Stokes changing the field almost every ball. So to keep blowing the trumpet and the chant going for that long is really tiring. We are just hoping he gets a wicket every now and then so we get a break!" Finch says.

When Ollie Pope was changing the course of the match, the Barmy Army was there to lend him their voice. Chants of "Hot, hot, hot... Ollie Pope" hung in the air for several minutes as Pope completed the most enterprising century ever made by a visiting batsman on Indian soil.

During their pre-tour preparation camp in Abu Dhabi, one of the standing instructions from former Test star Graeme Swann, who coached the team's spinners, was to silence the local crowd. Once that is done, the English can expect the Barmy Army to make them feel at home.
