WR COLLECTS RECORD AMOUNT IN FINES DURING INTENSIVE TICKET CHECKING DRIVES FROM APRIL TO DECEMBER 2022

Ahmedabad, In order to ensure hassle-free, comfortable travel & better services to all bonafide passengers over Western Railway, intensive ticket checking drives are being carried out continuously over Mumbai suburban local services, Mail/Express as well as passenger trains & holiday special trains so as to curb the menace of ticketless/irregular passengers. The highly motivated ticket checking team under the supervision of senior commercial officers of Western Railway organized several ticket checking drives during the period from April to December 2022, thereby recovering an amount to the tune of Rs. 135.58 crore.

According to a press release issued by Shri Sumit Thakur - Chief Public Relations Officer of Western Railway, during the month of December 2022, an amount of Rs. 9.87 crore was recovered through detection of 1.58 lakh

ticketless/irregular passengers, including unbooked luggage cases. It is pertinent to mention that during the period from April to December 2022, total 20.12 lakh ticketless/irregular passengers were detected, as against 11.76 lakh cases detected during the corresponding period last year, which is an increase of over 71.10%. Fine of Rs. 135.58 crore was recovered from ticketless passengers which is an increase of 99.15% over corresponding period of last year, which was Rs. 68.08 crore. To prevent unauthorized entry in AC local trains, frequent surprise ticket checking drives are carried out. As a result of these drives, more than 31,500 unauthorized passengers have been penalized since April 2022.

Shri Thakur added that the job of a ticket checker not only requires skill, tactness to detect deceitful passengers traveling without a ticket among genuine travellers but also requires good knowledge of rules and convincing skills to collect penalty amounts from deceitful passengers. Western Railway is proud to have such skillful & devoted ticket checking staff. Through his zeal & dedication to his duties, Shri Zahid K Qureshi, Dy. Chief Ticket Inspector, Mumbai has collected the highest ever ticket checking fines amounting to over Rs. 1 crore. From 11,684 persons traveling without tickets and 1,432 irregular travellers in the year 2022. WR appreciates the hard work he has put in his 26 years of service and his commendable devotion to work. It is noteworthy that Shri Qureshi collected fines to the tune of Rs. 21.41 lakh in the month of October 2022, which is a record for the highest monthly fines. Pele, the name that binds us all



Pele. It's more than just a four-letter word. It's more than just a name. It's a symbol of hope and everything beautiful. A light at the end of a dark tunnel. It's a metaphor. You know about Pele before you know how to kick a ball or run around in your backyard. Even before you learn nursery rhymes. It's powerful yet mysterious. You know about Pele even before you figure out where Brazil is. No name has touched more lives than Pele's. He transcends the human world, he permeates into the world of the poor, he moves around in the society of the rich, he is in the classrooms, he is in boardrooms, he is everywhere. Pele is so popular that his name—Edson Arantes do Nascimento—is tucked into the folds of quiz books. We have yet to determine its origin. There are various theories, but even Pele could not give a clear picture. Pele's rise to greatness is not just on the football field and the game he played but what he represented. Born in a poor family in Trés Corações, a small town in Minas Gerais,

he was raised in poverty. A Black player who had magic in his feet. He became the youngest player to score in the World Cup at the age of 17 when he helped football-crazy Brazil win its first trophy. Until then, the nation was looking for a hero—someone to deliver the proverbial Holy Grail. He went on to win two more in 1962 and 1970. He turned Santos into a brand with 25 titles in the sixties. He scored 1,283 goals in 1,363 matches, which remains a record. He gave meaning to football, turning it into 'jogo bonito' (a beautiful game). He even came out of retirement to popularise the game in the United States, where he played for New York Cosmos. His iconic words—love, love, love—still unify the fissured world. Capitalist or communist, dictatorship or democracy, one can never help falling in love with Pele. He gave belief to the world when there was none. He was toasted by classicists and romantics alike. In an ethnically and racially divided Brazil, Pele, also known as Black Pearl, brought everyone together irrespective of class, colour and creed. His name resonated across the world and remained untouched and unharmed until this day and perhaps never will. The eternal king of football lives on.

In Surat, the wife made a fatal attack on the husband



A shocking case has come to light in Dindoli area of Surat. In Surat, there was a fatal attack on a young laborer living on the footpath who earned his livelihood by doing labor work. In it, the wife made a plan to kill her husband. The wife called the lover to Surat from Dahod and decided to kill the husband who became an obstacle in love. During the night, the husband was sleeping on the footpath. Then the lover stabbed her husband in the chest and ran away. In this incident, the husband is dying in the civil hospital. On the other hand, the police have also arrested the wife and her lover. On the early morning of last December 28, Khamanbhai Mangabhai Bhuria, a laborer working at the construction site of the Atmiya Sansardham complex near Dindoli Sania Kanda village, was sleeping in a sheet shed with his wife and baby girl. At that time, an unknown person wearing a blanket attacked Khamanbhai's wife Giteben on the chest with a paddle and escaped causing serious injury. In the meantime, the laborers living in the paper shed around woke up and took Khamanbhai to the Civil Hospital for treatment. In this whole matter, Khamanbhai's wife Giteben filed an unknown complaint in Dindoli police station. Police registered a complaint against the attacker and conducted further investigation. "As soon as the incident was reported, the

police was working actively and seriously in this matter. Due to this, Surat's Dindoli police conducted a thorough interrogation of other working class people living around him when the working class youth was attacked. After that, the police also interrogated Khamanbhai's wife Giteben in depth about the incident. In it, police cross-examined his wife, suspicious of her answers, in which she broke down and confessed to the crime, saying that she had hatched the plan to kill her husband. The wife Giteben, who broke down and confessed to the crime under strict police interrogation, said that her husband had been having an affair with Lala Bhuria, a family brother from the village, for the past five years. During the Corona lockdown, lovers Lala Bhuria and Geeta Bhuria and husband were working together at different construction sites in Surat city. My husband came to know about our affair. Due to this, there was a quarrel with her husband Khaman Bhuria and lover Lala Bhuria at her village Bilwan.

Kerala police must know duty, autonomy go hand in hand

If there is something common in the first and second Pinarayi Vijayan-led LDF governments, it is the shoddy performance of the home department. IIFL Finance Offers Rs 9% Interest on Bonds, to Raise Rs 1000 Crore

Ahmedabad, IIFL Finance, one of India's largest Non-Banking Financial Companies, will open a public issue of secured bonds on January 6, 2023, to raise up to Rs. 1,000 crore, for the purpose of business growth and capital augmentation. The bonds offer up to 9% yield and high degree of safety. The NCD is available in tenors of 24 months, 36 months and 60 months. The frequency of interest payment is quarterly. The bonds are available on an annual and at maturity basis. The credit rating has been A1 Stable by CRISIL which indicates that the instruments are considered to have a high degree of safety for timely servicing of financial obligations and carry very low credit risk. Accident on Banas Bridge in Disa: Iron pipes loaded in trailer suddenly braked and entered cabin

After 3 hours of work body trapped in cabin was pulled out

An incident has come to light that the driver died on the spot when a trailer full of pipes met with an accident on Banas Bridge in Disa. The driver was crushed to death when the trailer suddenly braked and the full pipes entered the cabin. Following the accident, Disa Police has conducted further investigation. A trailer loaded with iron pipes from Nagthane in Maharashtra was going to Barmer in Rajasthan. The trailer was passing through Banaskul in Disa. At that time, the driver hit the brakes suddenly and caused an accident. As the chain and safety belt of the trailer became loose as soon as the brake was suddenly pressed, the iron pipes entered the cabin and the driver Pokharsinh Rawat was crushed and died tragically on the spot. Following the incident, the surrounding people rushed and started such relief operations.

While a team of Disa taluka police and 108 ambulance vans also reached the spot and the people along with the system struggled for three hours to get the body



trapped between the cabins crushed by the iron pipes. Later, the body of the deceased was shifted to the government hospital on behalf of the PM.
