**27,55,433 REGISTERED VOTERS IN THE DISTRICT CAN EXERCISE THEIR FRANCHISE**

One of the most awaited days in a democracy - to elect the representative for the State Assembly has come. A total of 27,55,433 registered voters of the district will be exercising their franchise today. Voting will be conducted from 7 am to 6 pm at 2,561 polling booths set up in the district. The district election office had made elaborate arrangements to conduct free & fair elections. Certain innovations have been introduced this time like model polling booths set up under a particular theme. Pink polling booths have also been set up, which will

be run by all women's teams. The process of mock poll will start at 5:30 am, one and a half hours before the start of voting. This process will take place in the presence of the candidate or their authorised agent. If any candidate or his agent is not present at the polling station at 5:30 am, the start of the process will be deferred by 15 minutes, after which the process of mock poll will be started in the presence of polling parties and other members. There is a provision to conduct the mock poll with a minimum of 50

votes, in which NOTA will also be included. Before starting the process of mock poll, the ballot unit and VVPAT will be kept in the VVPAT compartment. The control unit will have to be placed on the table of the presiding officer or the table of the polling officer. Collector and district election officer Ilayaraja T informed that there are a total of 27,55,433 registered voters in the district. Of these, 13,92,509 male and 13,62,818 female voters are registered. According to the number of voters, assembly constituency no. 208 (Indore-5)

has the highest number of voters at 4,12,048 and assembly constituency no. 206 (Indore-3) has the least number of voters at 1,87,161. In the assembly constituency no. 207 (Indore-4), the number of female voters (1,19,875) is more than the number of male voters (1,19,702). There are 26 overseas, 11,815 disabled, 30,142 80+ and 1,894 /- service voters registered in the district.

### Polling stations

Following the inclusion of 75 auxiliary polling stations in the 2,486 polling stations, the total number of polling stations is 2,561. Of these, 1,840 polling stations are located in urban areas and 721 polling stations are located in rural areas. Assembly constituency number wise 208 (Indore-5) has 364 polling stations, the highest number. Assembly constituency no. 206 Indore-3 has the lowest number of polling stations at 193. A total of 709 Sakhi polling stations, 08 handicapped polling sta-

tions and 104 model polling stations have been set up.

### Critical polling stations

A total of 583 polling stations were identified as critical polling stations. As per the instruction of the Commission, the webcasting of 50% polling stations including critical polling stations will be done.

### Manpower deployment

A total of 11,264 polling personnel have been appointed for 2,561 polling stations of all the nine assembly segments for elections. A total of 616 micro observers including reserves have been appointed for 583 critical polling stations. A total of 238 sector officers and 238 police sector officers have been appointed for the smooth conduct of elections. Medical kits along with material are being provided to all the polling parties for medical facilities. Apart from this, medical teams have also been formed with each sector.

# WAVELESS, FACELESS MP POLL COULD GO DOWN TO THE WIRE

Will the battle for Madhya Pradesh be narrow, nip-and-tuck pointedly indicating that the poll-bound state electorally sits on the margins for both the Congress and BJP? What initially started as Advantage Congress has now inched to a close fight, with both parties claiming 135 seats. If anti-incumbency, Shivraj Singh Chauhan fatigue and corruption allegations of 50 per cent commission 'Sarkar' have marred the BJP's prospects, for the Congress, it's the rebels who have queered the pitch, to some extent. The video of Kamal Nath versus Digvijay on who will wear whose clothes has caused soaring spirits to run aground. For the grand old party, prospective CM Kamal Nath seems to have raised the electoral bat on his own terms, driving the campaign narrative to the extent of spearheading the Hindutva bogey, much to the chagrin of secularists within Congress. So, the question is, is this bipolar contest on an even keel? For this, I drove down 700 kilometres to the Bhopal-Nagpur highway, interacting with school-teachers, youths, women, farmers and small 'dhabawalas' and tribals as well, which offered a kaleidoscopic panorama of how the two parties sit. One dominant and popular refrain I heard village after village was the

'Laadli Behna' scheme, which gives Rs 1,250 monthly, to every woman. This, of course, women remember as a gift from Mama Shivraj. In fact, the women don't see this as coming from the BJP, which is at a variance from the party stand. I asked BJP General Secretary Kailash Vijayvargiya about this dichotomy and he said, "Why should Shivraj Chauhan alone get the credit, it's the BJP as a party which has rolled out the scheme." For the voter, this brews more confusion than makes for a solid explanation. The BJP too, has no new story to tell except for Modi's oft-heard rant, "MP ke man mein Modi (Modi resides in the hearts of the people of MP)". One look at the billboards and posters of the Ram temple in Ayodhya put up by the BJP across the state also indicates that the BJP is again banking on Ram. The posters announce, 'Bhavaya Ram Mandir bankar ho raha hai taiyyar, fir iss baar BJP Sarkar (A grand Ram temple is being readied, this time again there will be a BJP government)'. The question is whether Ram can save the BJP in Madhya Pradesh, a party riled with rape cases in Ujjain, the urination episode in Sidhi, coupled with the secular issues of employment, price rise inflation and corruption. There has been no dominant emotive issue, the Hindutva force of the BJP having been neutralised to a large extent by Kamal Nath, who projects himself as a Hanuman devotee. I asked Kamal Nath why he

entertained Baba Bageshwar and preachers of a Hindu Rashtara, and he categorically said, "If I touch Baba Bageshwar's feet if he is in my constituency of Chhindwara, where's the politics? Nath even said, "BJP gets stomach ache when they see me praying." Freebie culture, which started in the south and was imbibed by Arvind Kejriwal in Delhi, has spread like a contagious political norm, be it Rajasthan, Chhattisgarh or Madhya Pradesh. For both parties, cylinders at subsidised rates, high-procurement cost for wheat and paddy, houses, free education from KG to PG is the underlying theme and the biggest allurements, apart from unofficial cash and liquor; thereby, battlelines have become blurred. The biggest advantage for the BJP is the 'Laadli' scheme and the biggest hope for the Congress is the hunger for change, the promise of a new regime with clean governance. Pollsters have predicted a change in government which could well be the case but the BJP is also not on a very weak footing. So, is it a battle of equals this time in Madhya Pradesh? Well, largely yes. In 2018, the Indian National Congress won the state election with 114 seats and the BJP was a close second, with 109 seats. However, the vote-share of the BJP was 41.02 per cent, higher than the Congress's 40.89 per cent. The BSP bagged 5.01 per cent votes that year. In 2013, the BJP won the state election with its largest vote as well as seat

share. The vote share of the saffron party stood at 44.88 per cent, while the runner-up, the Congress, had bagged 36.38 per cent of the vote share and the BSP had claimed 6.29 per cent. In the 2008 Madhya Pradesh assembly elections, the BJP had won with 37.64 per cent of the vote share, the Congress had secured 32.39 per cent and the BSP, 8.97 per cent. To sum up, the Madhya Pradesh contest in 2023 is no less than an India-Pakistan match which could influence the Lok Sabha elections of 2024 psychologically and electorally. If the Congress manages to trounce the BJP, it would be its biggest comeback in the Hindi heartland state. If Modi has put his might behind Shivraj Singh Chauhan, the Congress's Gandhi, along with party veteran and octogenarian Mallikarjun Kharge and Kamal Nath are not far behind. Public sab jaanti hai. It's the junta who will hand over the final reins. Who knows, the Madhya Pradesh election could well be poised to go down to the wire, in which case the fear of Operation Lotus will loom large. What if MP goes through a repeat of the downing of the Kamal Nath government in 2020? Will the BJP cultivate another Jyotiraditya Scindia from inside the Congress? Well, that's what everyone fears. But for now, happy voting with a happy mind.

# Two held with liquor worth Rs 70,000
