The chimera of Opposition unity

On Friday, June 23, Nitish Kumar can have the satisfaction of a meeting of a few Opposition leaders in Patna, in his latest quest to unite all against the BJP ahead of the 2024 Lok Sabha election. Such is the mood of cynicism even among the Opposition parties that the interest lies not so much in as to what outcome will emerge from this one-day talkathon, but mainly in who will respond to the invitation of the Bihar CM, who has donned anti-BJP colours in his latest avatar. Given his frequent change of partners from Lalu Yadav to BJP and then back and forth, if there is some lingering doubt that he may once again go back to supping with the saffron party, nobody can be blamed.

Anyway, the agenda for the Friday meeting is still not clear, aside from the general claim that it would discuss ways to oppose the BJP in an effective manner without dividing the anti-BJP vote. It is a laudable objective. But achieving it may not be easy. To begin with, there has to be a semblance of a programmatic unity. Merely saying that the one-point agenda is to avoid multiple candidates against the BJP in the parliament poll without offering a cogent agenda, a workable action plan, and, above all, a common leader around whom there is a general consensus such unity will flounder at the first step. Besides, the over-sized egos and contrary agendas of various Opposition leaders would need to be reconciled. Who among the entire Opposition bloc commands such a moral authority to be able to resolve seemingly irreconcilable contradictions for the sake of attaining a larger goal of defeating the Modi-led BJP. That the unity project is fraught with irresolvable contradictions can be gauged from the fact that right now the BJP, Congress and the CPI(M) find themselves on the same page in opposing the ruling Trinamool Congress's highhandedness in the on-going panchayat polls. The three parties have welcomed the Calcutta High Court order directing the central forces to oversee the elections while the Trinamool Congress has bitterly opposed it, appealing in the Supreme Court against it, though unsuccessfully. Is it anyone's case that the bitter rivals in West Bengal can put aside their recriminations and hostilities and work together in the Lok Sabha poll? The voter is not a fool.

Or take the on-going campaign by the Delhi Chief Minister against the central ordinance taking over the control of services. Arvind Kejriwal, the latest gadfly in politics who cannot sleep without throwing a stone or two at the central government to hide his own failures to provide meaningful governance, now seeks the support of all Opposition parties to defeat the ordinance in parliament. Given that he has unleashed a barrage of criticism against the Congress in general and the Rajasthan government in particular with an eye on the election in the State later this year, there is naturally a division in the Congress ranks over lending support to the AAP. Despite Kejriwal seeking to meet Rahul Gandhi and nominal Congress President Mallikarjun Kharge there has been no response as yet. Why should the Congress lend support to a party which has taken away its main support-base both in Delhi and Punjab. It is unlikely that Nitish Kumar, the self-appointed sutradhar of the Opposition, will have any cogent solution to resolve these huge contradictions among various non-BJP groups. Yes, Chief Minister Stalin can happily mark his presence in Patna because he faces no challenge from any party that is likely to join the conclave, the Congress Party in Tamil Nadu being a minor ally of the ruling DMK. Maybe Akhilesh Yadav too can come and fulminate to his heart's content against the BJP but the sub-text of his message will be that the Opposition unity is contingent on the Congress not muscling in on the anti-BJP space in UP. In short, Opposition unity is a chimera, easier said than done. And of the people Nitish Kumar, the convener of the unity meet, has little bargaining power himself even in Bihar, with his following shrinking to his own caste brothers. However, as a talkathon it can dominate news headlines for a day.

Truth and reconciliation in Manipur

Manipur is in need of truth and reconciliation. But just how well is the "truth" of the violence-torn state understood and portrayed? The question arises in the context of a passionate editorial in an Imphal-based newspaper last week, inveighing against armchair and parachute journalism on the troubled border state. One-sided narratives, it said, were exacerbating the conflict.

That the "mainland" press had probably never heard of Meiteis, Kukis and the district of Churachandpur before the horrific events of May 3, 2023, is a fact. The subsequent reportage and analysis, not to mention the social media narratives, are indeed conflicting. Why the strife between the majority Meitei community and the Kuki hill tribes? What led to the gratuitous violence and torching of villages? Who were the perpetrators? Who were the victims? That seems to be a matter of perspective, although it is clear that the attacks have been on both sides.

As the editorial said, the accounts are coloured by ideology,

and cherry-picking narratives to fit agendas further vitiates the atmosphere. 'What's worse...is that the work and ethics of the few local media houses based in Imphal is being questioned in reports written by mainland journo...completely oblivious to their own parachute journalism', it added.

Behind the ethnic conflict in the northeastern state is a complex history of colonialism and migration, and an equally complex web of legislation. To reduce all of that to a Hindu supremacist agenda, just because the Meiteis are largely Hindu and the Kukis largely Christian, is misleading.

It is instructive to read the reports in the Manipur press. A number of issues relevant to the current situation emerge from the local newspapers. By and large, the factors at play seem to be land ownership, illegal migration, the drug and arms trade, forest protection and the territorial integrity of Manipur. All of which are related to the troubles across the border in Myanmar.

Land ownership rights are certainly an issue. Newspaper articles point out that the Meiteis are 'boxed in' into some 10 per cent of the total land area and are not permitted to purchase land outside of the valley as they do not — unlike the hill tribes — enjoy scheduled tribe status. Indeed, the May 3 violence was sparked by a rally in protest against the proposal to

bring Meiteis into the ST fold (thereby leveling the playing field and sparking fears of the hill tribes being alienated from their lands).

Then there's drug-running. In the Supreme Court last month, the Centre and state government attributed the ethnic conflict to the crackdown on poppy cultivation in the hills. A lot has been written on the subject in the local press. One article holds that the "tribal elites" will not brook interference in this lucrative trade, which has substantially enriched them and led not only to a high incidence of

drug addiction but the spectre of narco-terrorism. Illegal migration appears to be a bone of contention. From 1974 onwards (when the military junta took over in Myanmar) refugees have streamed across the 390-km, porous border into Manipur. The numbers multiplied significantly after the return of the junta in 2021. The allegation is that the hill tribes have welcomed the refugees owing to a shared ethnicity and settled them illegally in protected or reserved forests. (Some might argue that this is a human rights issue.)

Further, the North East Peoples' Organisation holds that under cover of the 'Suspension of Operations' (SoO) agreement with the government of India, militants are said to have facilitated illegal immigration, flouted forest laws and accumulated wealth and weapons through the drug trade.

How valid are claims of Meitei-sponsored 'ethnic cleansing' against the Kukis? Or allegations of systematic attacks and arson by the hill tribes against Meitei villages? Does the solution lie in a 'separate administration', or in doing away with the SoO, instituting a National Register of Citizens, cracking down on illicit drugs and arms, and land reforms? The truth must out, if a reconciliation is to be effected.

The central issue is that of territorial integrity. That 10 Kuki MLAs — including two ministers of the BJP-ruled state — have demanded a separate administration for Kuki-dominated areas on the grounds that the ruling dispensation had failed to protect the Chin-Kuki-Mizo-Zomi tribes from the Meiteis, certainly seems to argue a sense of persecution. What is going wrong with live-in relationships?

Recently, news reports about live-in relationships in India going awry have raised a pertinent question regarding the utility, stability and feasibility of such bonds. The Aftab-Shradha case in Delhi, the Manoj Sane-Saraswati Vaidya episode in Mumbai, a young live-in couple in Bengaluru facing the same fate and many more such cases with a violent end of one of the partners — often the woman — may not be isolated cases.

So, it's imperative to analyse live-ins in the context of our societal ethos, needs and aspirations. First of all, a live-in relationship is not something drastically different. It's just a rough version of marriage sans certain nuptial commitments. In other words, it's a kind of an opportunistic, stop-gap arrangement which vindicates the English adage of eating the cake and having it too.

This casual and often lack of serious approach in all live-in relationships may snowball into quick differences that may lead to indifference and not-so-happy separation. Agreed, a separation is never happy. It's an oxymoron like happily married because you're either happy or married! Both cannot go to-

gether. But a separation can always happen on a decent and courteous note. Unfortunately, this seldom happens, when either of the partners wants to get out of a live-in arrangement. We've seen this happen in all the aforementioned cases.

Sociologists, psychologists and marriage counsellors are of the view that a live-in relationship is often euphoric. The bubble bursts soon. It's like starting with a bang, but ending with a whimper. Lack of commitment is often seen as lack of seriousness and also as lack of (intense) love. That may create insecurity because live-in couples are often footloose and fancy-free, albeit in the beginning. Men as well as women long for lasting emotional stability, security and anchorage. A woman is always more in need of emotional stability. It has been found that though man and woman may have decided to stay together without tying the knot, a point came in their lives when one of them wanted to give the stamp of social sanctity and security to their relationship. But if the other one/partner is not willing, it may create troubles and turn outright nasty.

In a live-in relationship, you get to know your partner's "other" side. Maybe all this time you were convinced your partner was a sweet, dimpled darling who can do no wrong. Then you move in with them and see them as the living, breathing, alarmingly human mess we all are. Living with a person teaches you a lot about them.

Dating a person and sharing the same space with them are very different things and the latter comes with its own unique set of challenges. He always leaves the toilet seat up. She puts so much spice in the food he can't eat it. He finds out her eyelashes are fake. Mind you, all of this happens in a marriage too, of course, but hey, there you have to go to an actual courthouse to get out of it. But what can you do in a live-in relationship? There's no legal angle to it.

Then come trust issues. You love

Things from a distance always look rosy but you get to know the reality when you come to it. Don't they say in Persian, "Aawaaz-e-dudhul az door khush me numayad" (English equivalent: Blue are the hills that are far from us)?

सीधी • जिले में दर्दनाक घटना से जुड़ा मामला सामने आया है, यहां एक मां ने अपने दो मासूम बच्चों को साथ में लेकर कुएं में छलांग लगा दी है। इस झकड़ोर देने वाले घटनाक्रम में मां समेत दोनों बच्चों की डूबने से मौत हो गई है। घटना की जानकारी लगते ही मौके पर पहुंची पुलिस ने ग्रामीणों की मदद से शवों को कुएं से बाहर निकालकर पोस्टमार्टम के लिए अस्पताल खाना कर दिया है। घटना के बाद से इलाके में हड़कंप मच गया है। ये हिराण कर देने वाली घटना जिले के अंतर्गत आने वाले सिटी कोतवाली थाना इलाके के मुड़ी गांव में घटी है। फिलहाल, इस बात की पुष्टि नहीं हो सकी है कि, महिला ने अपने साथ दो बेटों को लेकर कुएं में छलांग क्यों लगाई है। डूबने से मां सहित दोनों बेटों की दर्दनाक मौत हो गई। इस घटनाक्रम के सामने आने के बाद गांव में सनसनी फैल गई है। वहीं सूचना मिलते ही मौके पर पुलिस टीम भी घटनास्थल पहुंची और कुएं से तीनों शवों को रस्क्यू कर बाहर निकाला। इस दौरान मौके पर ग्रामीणों की भीड़ जमा हो गई। फिलहाल तीनों के शव को पोस्टमार्टम के लिए अस्पताल भिजवा दिया गया है। वहीं, मर्ग कायम कर मृतिकों के परिजन से पूछताछ शुरू कर दी गई है। फिलहाल, पुलिस मौते के कारणों का पता लगाने में जुटी है कि, आखिरकार महिला ने अपने बच्चों के साथ कुएं में छलांग लगाकर आत्महत्या की है या उन तीनों को किसी ने कुएं में फेंका है।

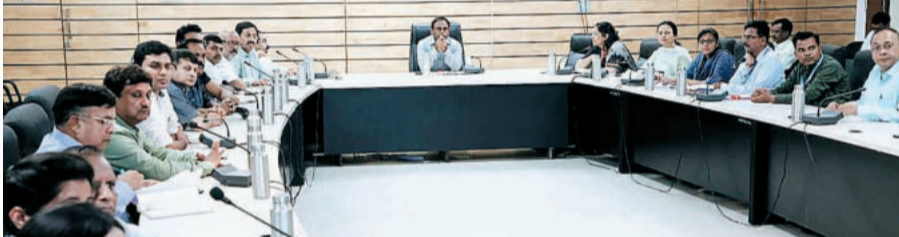
