'11 & 12 students...

"If everything is under control, schools for the rest of classes will be reopened and later, coaching classes will be allowed to reopen. All this will be done in a phased manner. But, everybody will have to follow Covid protocol." Chouhan said in the programme. School education minister Inder Singh Parmar said that almost all government school teachers have been vaccinated. "Teachers who haven't been vaccinated yet will not be allowed to take classes," said the minister.

Parents apprehensive...

President of the Palak Mahasangh, Kamal Vishwakarma said that the state government has buckled under the pressure of private school operators. They had issued a warning and closed the schools only for a day and the government gave up. "We have given in writing to the government that schools should only be opened after completing the vaccination process of all students and teachers," said Vishwakarma.

State govt can...

Intermediaries include social media companies, websites, mobile apps, e-commerce websites, online aggregators, internet service providers, web hosting providers etc on objectionable content and tell them to remove it with immediate effect. The home department order says the objectionable contents available in computers and other platforms which are illegal as per the law not only are creating law and order problems but also promoting sexual crimes. There is a growing need by the day to remove or disable access to such objectionable contents. The order also gives reference of Supreme Court judgment Shreya Singhal Versus Union of India, March 2015, whereby authorized 'Appropriate Government or its agency' has been empowered to remove illegal material/ contents from such platforms immediately and issue notices to the concerned persons. Reacting on the development Congress spokesperson Narendra Saluja said that the worried Shivraj government has now started scuttling the voice of social media and trying to snatch expression of free speech.

Verma cleared for...

According to police, IAS officer Santosh Verma, now suspended, was arrested on Saturday based on investigation in connection with an FIR lodged against him by a special judge in Indore with MG Road police station on June 26. He was booked under sections 120-B (criminal conspiracy), 420 (forgery), 467 (forgery of valuable security), 471 (using forged documents as genuine) and certain other sections of Indian Penal Code (IPC). After his arrest Verma was produced before a court on Sunday which remanded him to police custody till July 14, as per officials. Principal secretary, GAD Deepti Gaud Mukherjee said, "Fate of Santosh Verma would be decided after the investigation into the alleged forged orders." She said the department was also mulling on corrective measures on how to check recurrence of such an incident. However, such an incident had taken place for the first time in the state. Despite efforts current IG police Harinarayanchari Mishra could not be reached for his comments. He didn't respond to the phone call and text message.

RSS TAKES OVER...

Champat Rai (75), hailing from Bijnor district in Uttar Pradesh, was summoned to Chitrakoot by Bhagwat on July 8 during the conclave and conveyed the new arrangement made to put an end to the controversies in which he had embroiled the trust recently in the purchase of additional land around the temple site for various facilities. He was reportedly told by Bhagwat to take guidance of Joshi in the day-to-day work and maintain "transparency" in the construction of the temple to prevent recurrence of the controversies in future. The Indore-born Joshi, who handed over the reins of the RSS to Dattatreya Hosabale (66) to be the general secretary because of not keeping good health, is not a new face for Ayodhya as he has been associated with the Ram temple movement for many years.

My Yatra, My...

Justice Nariman said he had read in newspapers on Wednesday that Uttar Pradesh has chosen to continue with the annual ritual while Uttarakhhand, with hindsight of experience, had said there will be no yatra. "We wish to know the stand of the respective governments. The citizens of India are completely perplexed. They do not know what is going on," the Bench said, noting that such decisions were being taken even though Prime Minister Narendra Modi has said that 'we cannot compromise even one bit'. "The 'Kanwar Yatra' is an annual pilgrimage of devotees of Shiv Temple who walk hundreds of kilometres barefoot in groups chanting 'Bol Bom' and singing Bhajans and consecrate the holy water of the river Ganga.

PAWAR WON'T PLAY ALONG

WON'T ASSUME any leadership role in '24 polls against Modi SCOFFS AT reports about his being Oppn nominee for the prez election

Shiv Sena MP Sanjay Raut said that the NCP chief and former Union minister Sharad Pawar could be the opposition's prime ministerial candidate to strongly take on PM Narendra Modi in the 2024 general elections. "It will be difficult to fight PM Modi unless there is an able and effective opposition leader against

him. Sharad Pawar is a senior leader and he could become the face of the Opposition in 2024," proposed Raut on Wednesday. Earlier, Raut had pitched for Pawar as the UPA chairperson. However, a few hours after Raut's statement, Pawar clarified that he would not assume any leadership role in the 2024 Lok Sabha elections. "Nothing has been decided so far, be it the 2024 general elections or state elections. The election is far away and the political situation keeps changing. I am not going to assume any leadership in the 2024 elections," he



maintained. He also rubbished reports about him being the Opposition's presidential candidate in the 2024 Presidential Elections. The NCP chief termed such media reports as 'false', saying that the party with 300 parliamentarians would have the upper hand. "It is absolutely false that I will be a candidate for the Presidential election. I know what the result will be, given the party that has more than 300 MPs. I will not be a candidate for the Presidential election," said Pawar. On his meetings with the poll strategist Prashant Kishor, the NCP chief said,

"Prashant Kishor met me twice, but we only talked about his company. No discussion was held on leadership for the 2024 elections or the Presidential election. Prashant Kishor told me that he had quit the field of formulating poll strategies." Last month, Kishor had said there were no discussions regarding the third front. "A front formed by a few parties is not enough to beat Modi. All third and fourth fronts are futile exercises against Modi," he said. NCP chief spokesman Nawab Malik also said, "There has been no discussion within the party so far, regarding the Presidential poll. If someone's circulating this news, then I'd like to clarify that it's not true."

Didi makes a sudden visit to Dhankhar

Amidst loggerheads and war of words against each other, West Bengal Chief Minister on Wednesday suddenly visited Governor Jagdeep Dhankhar at Governor's House. "Governor wanted to know about Vidhan Parishad and so the CM came to inform him about the same and they also spoke on the budget," said the sources. Notably, soon after Banerjee left Governor's House, video of the two meeting was posted from Dhankhar's Twitter handle with caption give as 'Hon'ble CM @MamataOfficial called on Hon'ble Governor Shri Jagdeep Dhankhar at Raj Bhawan today. The two had an hour-long interaction without aides."

NANDIGRAM POLL-POURRI Drama, tension continues

Kolkata: Calcutta High Court Justice Shampa Sarkar on Wednesday had instructed Election Commission to preserve all the EVMs and VVPAT machine and other election related materials secure till August 12 which is the next hearing date of the Nandigram recounting case. "The petition filed by Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee was without any defect," said Justice Sarkar. The Calcutta High Court also directed to serve a notice to Leader of Opposition Suwendu Adhikari, who defeated Mamata Banerjee in the Nandigram seat.

As Justice Chanda was seen attending BJP's programs TMC Supremo feared biased verdict and appealed for his recusal. Incidentally, the saffron camp leaders including the party chief Dilip Ghosh had several times claimed that Justice Kaushik Chanda has no connection with the BJP. Meanwhile, Suwendu Adhikari moves SC of the Nandigram recounting case fearing that Mamata can influence the verdict of the case in Calcutta HC.

According to close aide of Suwendu it was learnt that Suwendu appealed before the Supreme Court C to High Court of any states as he thinks the way Justice Kaushik Chanda was forced to step down from the division bench, the verdict of Calcutta High Court might also be influenced.

Centre asks states not to file cases under scrapped Section 66A of I-T Act

NEW DELHI: Cases cannot be registered under the defunct Section 66A of the Information Technology Act, the Centre told states and Union Territories today. The police should be asked to stop filing such cases and any case under the scrapped law should be immediately withdrawn, the home ministry said in an order on Wednesday evening.

Section 66A-- a controversial law that allowed the police to arrest people for posting "offensive" content online-- was scrapped by the Supreme Court in a landmark judgment of March 2015.

In a recent hearing, the court expressed shock when it heard that more than 1,000 cases had been filed under it. "It is shocking. We will issue notice," a three-member bench of Justices R Nariman, KM Joseph and BR Gavai said. "Amazing. What is going on is terrible," Justice Nariman had added. The judges had also said strict action will be taken against officials who used the law.

The top court had struck down the contentious law in 2015 in a bid to maintain the constitutional right to freedom of speech online. Sister Lucy Kalappura, who appeared in the court to argue her own case following the withdrawal of her counsel from arguing it, told the court she was a nun seeking justice and appealed to it not to throw her at the "mercy of the streets".
