Amendment part of new CSR rules notified on Friday

he corporate social responsibility rules that came into effect from Friday have

given implementing agencies such as trusts and societies time till April 1 to register with the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, and have set a three-vear time limit for CSR projects.

"It is a one-time registration in a simple, single-page form, where details of the members, PAN number, etc. has to be provided. which can help us identify on the MCA21 portal," a senior government official told Business Standard. This will also serve as a database of authentic agencies and **PROVISION FOR CSR RULES.** promote transparency, the official said.

While the national CSR fund that was meant to pool

unspent funds has not been specified yet, all such money will be transferred to any of the schedule VII funds.

International organisations recognised under section 3 of the United Nations Privileges and Immunities Act, 1947, have also been allowed to undertake design monitoring, evaluation, and capacity building work for CSR programmes to bring in global best practices.

Each CSR project would be given a unique registration number upon submission of the Form CSR-1, which can be used to track

According to corporate affairs ministry data, CSR expenditure has increased from ₹10,066 crore in financial year 2014-15 (FY15) to ₹18,655 crore in FY19, with a cumulative total of ₹79,000 crore having been spent throughout India.

The rules have decriminalised the provision for CSR, but have increased disclosures for companies. Every company that has aver-

age CSR obligation of ₹10 crore or more in the three preceding financial years, will have to undertake an impact assessment study of its projects through an independent agency.

Such a study has to be done for projects with outlay of ₹1 crore or more, and which have been completed not less than one year before the

> impact study. The board has to ensure that the administrative overheads of CSR activity do not exceed five per cent of total CSR expenditure of the company for the financial vear Any surplus will also not form part of the business profit of a company and be ploughed back into the same project or transferred to the Unspent CSR

Companies are also allowed to create or acquire capital assets through CSR in the name

of beneficiaries or a public authority or registered trust, society or section 8 company. This has been done in line with sustainable development goals that talk about building partnerships

Account.

The company's board has to mandatorily disclose the composition of the CSR Committee, and CSR policy and projects on their website for public access. Companies with CSR liability less than ₹50 lakh will not have to form a CSR committee.

The ministry had set up a High-Level Committee on CSR in 2018 chaired by then Corporate Affairs secretary Injeti Srinivas. "The amendments to law aim to strengthen the CSR ecosystem, by improving and strengthening disclosures and by simplifying compliances. It also aims to address the inadequacies of the present CSR architecture by removing ambiguities, bringing in objectivity, and by simplifying language," corporate affairs ministry said.



The directorate general of anti-profiteering (DGAP) had earlier served a notice on a real estate company over a com-

plaint by a home buyer that the builder had not passed on the benefit of input tax credit to him for a unit bought by it in a residential complex, said Abhishek Rastogi, partner at Khaitan & Co.

Through the notice, DGAP had sought voluminous details from the builder relating to tax an anti-profiteering complaint. returns filed for the relevant period, tax payments, input tax credit availed and contracts that builder had entered into with the flat buvers

court against the DGAP probe, saying the complainant had booked the unit in a residential project in the 2018-19 financial year after the introduction of goods and services tax (GST) and hence there was no change in the GST rate or availment of input tax credit during such period which

would necessitate investiga-As such, the prima facie evidence as required under the the CGST Act does not exist, according to the petitioner. The case is not pertinent to

one home builder, but an order would set a precedence for all those home builders who sold their flats after GST came into effect, said Rastogi. He said anti-profiteering provisions could apply when there is change in either output tax rate or increased input tax credit

After the GST Council decision, the governments have given real estate players to opt for one of the two regimes — 5 per cent GST without input tax credit or 12 per cent GST with input tax credit. This option was given till March 31. 2019 after which the lower tax regime came into operation.

On 19 November 2020, the Company through its wholly owned subsidiary, Mphasis Consulting Limited, obtained control of Datalytyx Limited and its subsidiaries ('Datalytyx') by acquiring 100% of its shares in cash. Datalytyx is a next-gen data engineering and consultancy company providing next-gen data Engineering. Data Oos and Master Data Management solutions on Snowflake and Talend environments. The acquisition seeks to strengthen the Group's next-gen data strategy and build capabilities relevant to the digital priorities of its clients. The acquisition was executed through a share purchase agreement for a consideration of GBP 11.55 million (₹ 1,141.92 million). The excess of the purchase consideration paid over the fair value of assets acquired has been attributed to goodwill. Net assets acquired include ₹ 151.32 million of cash and cash equivalents and trade and other receivables valued at ₹ 278.59 million. Trade and other receivables are expected to be collected in full. Goodwill of ₹ 583.52 million comprises value of acquired workforce and expected synergies arising from the acquisition. The goodwill is not tax-deductible and has been allocated to the Datalytyx Cash Generating Unit ('CGU'). The fair value of contingent consideration linked to continuing employment is being accounted for as a post combination expense in the

MOTOR INSURANCE INCHING UP

The retail health segment is driving the growth in the nonlife insurance industry, with motor insurance inching up, albeit slowly. In December, while the retail health segment recorded 24 per cent growth, government health schemes made a comeback as premiums in this segment more than doubled YoY. Among other segments, fire insurance has registered 45 per cent growth in December premiums. Motor insurance registered 14 per cent growth in premiums, up from 7 per cent YoY growth in November, 3 per cent YoY growth in October, and 4 per cent YoY decline in Q2FY21. Increasing new vehicle sales and strong momentum in retail sales

during the festive season supported growth. "A gradual rise in freight volumes and utilisation of rates supported premiums," according to a report by Kotak Institutional Equities. Despite the fact that retail health segment growth has been strong in the April-December period of FY21 - with general insurers witnessing 38 per cent rise and standalone health insurers recording 21 per cent growth, taking the industry growth to over 30 per cent experts cautioned about unsustainability as there is gradual softening in risk aversion among probable customers as Covid cases continue to decline. **SUBRATA PANDA**

On 19 November 2020, the Company through its wholly owned subsidiary, Mphasis Consulting Limited, obtained control of Datalytyx Limited and its subsidiaries ('Datalytyx') by acquiring 100% of its shares in cash. Datalytyx is a next-gen data engineering and consultancy company providing next-gen data Engineering, Data Ops and Master Data Management solutions on Snowflake and Talend environments. The acquisition seeks to strengthen the Group's next-gen data strategy and build capabilities relevant to the digital priorities of its clients. The acquisition was executed through a share purchase agreement for a consideration of GBP 11.55 million (₹ 1,141.92 million). The excess of the purchase consideration paid over the fair value of assets acquired has been attributed to goodwill. Net assets acquired include ₹ 151.32 million of cash and cash equivalents and trade and other receivables valued at ₹ 278.59 million. Trade and other receivables are expected to be collected in full. Goodwill of ₹ 583.52 million comprises value of acquired workforce and expected synergies arising from the acquisition. The goodwill is not tax-deductible and has been allocated to the Datalytyx Cash Generating Unit ('CGU'). The fair value of contingent consideration linked to continuing employment is being accounted for as a post combination expense in the
