Man threatens and attacks construction site supervisor, booked

A 30-YEAR-OLD man was booked on Saturday for extortion and attempted murder after he allegedly demanded money from a site supervisor of an under construction building and subsequently attacked him with a knife when he refused to give the money.

According to police, the complainant Imran Khan who works at a construction site at Saki Vihar road in Powai, told them that the accused, Mubarak alias Lallu Momeen Khan, first demanded money after visiting their site around three days ago.

"After he trespassed into our land, he inquired about the builder and contractor. He went to threaten and claimed that they will have to pay money to continue the work at this site," an officer said.

Police added that on Friday, Mubarak again went to the site at around 5.30pm where he de-

manded money from the complainant and his friend Javed. He threatened them saying he has committed a lot of murders along with another person, Amin, and that if they want to continue their work, they will have to pay him.

When Khan refused, Mubarak took out a knife from his pocket and attacked them. Khan got stabbed on his face, said police.

"Javed raised an alarm for help and local residents gathered around the spot," said a police officer.

Mubarak went charging at them as well and then escaped in his bike, police said, adding the complainant was then taken to a hospital where he is being treated.

The police later recorded the statement of the victim after which a case of extortion, attempt to murder and criminal intimidation under sections of IPC was registered.

"Mubarak is absconding and we are trying to trace him," said a police officer.

Real estate agent, wife found dead in house

A 61-YEAR-OLD real estate agent and his wife were found dead inside their house in Kandivali late Friday. While the agent allegedly hanged himself, it is not known how his wife died, police said.

According to police, the deceased have been identified as Pramod Sonkar (61) and Apita Sonkar (57). A note was recovered from their apartment that indicated financial problems as the reason. Senior police inspector Pravin

Rane said, "The couple did not have children and our probe has revealed that they were facing financial difficulty, which would have led to this."

Police said that the couple died a couple of days before their bodies were recovered. On Friday evening, police were informed about foul smell from their apartment.

"The couple did not speak to anyone in the society, so nobody could contact them but as soon as we received the information, a team was sent to the spot. We broke open the door after which we found their bodies," said Rane.

MU to open 75 start-up clinics to encourage entrepreneurship

Clinics will be powered by varsity's own MU IDEAS Foundation Incubation Centre

PALLAVISMART MUMBAI, MUMBAI MAY 19

IN A bid to encourage entrepreneurship among collegians, University of Mumbai will open 75 start-up clinics in its jurisdiction across seven districts.

The varsity has invited applications from affiliated colleges and institutes to set up these clinics, which will be powered by varsity's own incubator—MU IDEAS Foundation Incubation Centre, which is a Section 8 company and funded by Maharashtra State Innovation Society.

With an objective to create a more diverse and vibrant ecosystem of start-ups, these clinics will handhold budding ventures by students coming from various educational backgrounds.

As per information shared by Dr Sachin Laddha, director, Innovation, Incubation and Linkages at the MU, the initiative will start with 20 each for Mumbai city and suburban districts in the initial phase followed by 15 for Thane and five each for Palghar, Sindhudurg, Raigad and Ratnagiri. Each clinic will be governed by a dedicated council led by a nominated faculty from the particular college. But its activities will not be restricted to that particular college. Instead, it will function as a start-up support for budding student entrepreneurs from colleges from the vicinity.

Dr. Laddha said, "The Startup Clinic is a programme offered by MU IDEAS for Entrepreneurs to support and empower student entrepreneurs. The programme provides resources and support,

such as mentorship, networking opportunities, and access to expertise, knowledge, resources and technology available at the MU IDEAS, to help student-led start-ups grow and succeed. The goal of the programme is to increase diversity and inclusion in the start-up ecosystem and to provide a supportive community for student entrepreneurs."

It will be a free virtual/physical mentorship programme which will provide resources such as mentorship, networking, and access to MU IDEAS's expertise and technology. Apart from helping student entrepreneurs with idea, product design and technology strategy, the clinics will soon also help students reach investors for funding possibilities.

"One of the objectives of opening these clinics is to provide a di-

rect access to varsity's own incubator—MU IDEAS Foundation Incubation Centre located in Kalina campus, which otherwise would have been out of reach for many," said Laddha, adding these clinics will be a joint venture between affiliated college and MU IDEAS Foundation Incubation Centre. The idea, according to Dr. Laddha, is to encourage, guide and support enterprises by students coming from varied courses of higher education. While the principal of the college will be chairperson for these clinics, it will have an in-charge faculty member. The clinics will also comprise three entrepreneurs, two faculty members who are passionate about entrepreneurship, three students and a representative nominated by Director Innovation, Incubation and Linkages at the MU.

Yellow warning issued as Mumbai set to vote

AS MUMBAI and its neighbouring districts go to polls on Monday, the India Meteorological Department (IMD) has sounded a yellow warning in the city as well as Thane and Palghar. The temperatures are slated to oscillate around 33-35 degrees Celsius, while scientists have indicated "discomfort due to high humidity".

On Sunday, the IMD's Santacruz recording station registered a maximum temperature of 34.6 degrees Celsius, while the Colaba coastal observatory recorded 35 degrees on the mercury scale, marking a departure of one degree above normal. Despite the temperatures hovering around 35 degrees,

Mumbaikars complained of extreme discomfort due to humid conditions, with scientists attributing it to the westerly winds. Sunil Kamble, director of IMD Mumbai, told The Indian Express, "The humidity levels are in the

range of 70-80 per cent. The city is currently receiving westerly winds because of which the temperatures are relatively lower but the humidity has spiked. However, this is a typical summer phenomenon."

The IMD has also issued guidelines to the district administration that are gearing up for the fifth phase elections. "We have issued special guidelines along with three-hour bulletins with details about the weather developments of the day. There is unlikely to be any rain activity on the polling day," added Kamble.

The district collector has also made provision of drinking water, shade for protection from sun as well as facilities to ensure voters' comfort. "We have made medical arrangements and will provide ORS in case some voters experience discomfort," said an officer on poll duty in the suburbs. Meanwhile, the city is set to seek some respite from Tuesday, with the IMD issuing no alert for a few days thereafter. The weather bureau has forecast dry days ahead.

2 bike-borne men throw 'chemical' on student, rob her

TWO BIKE-BORNE men allegedly flung some chemical substances on a 26-year-old woman and fled with her bag containing laptop and other valuables in Kalyan area on Saturday night. The Kolsewadi police, who are on a lookout for the two men, said the complainant is a UPSC aspirant and was going to meet her friend when the incident took place.

According to the police, the woman sustained injuries and was rushed to hospital from where she was discharged after administering first-aid.

The woman alleged that after attending her classes in Andheri, she came to Kalyan to hand over the laptop to her friend. "While I was walking on the footpath, suddenly two bike-borne men came from behind, threw some chemical substance on me which caused some burning sensation. My dupatta also got torn in the attack," the victim said.

The two accused then snatched her bag and escaped from the spot, said the 26-year-old.

The officials from Kolsewadi police said a case of robbery was registered at the police station. "We have formed a special team and an inspector-rank officer is overseeing the probe. We have also started scrutinising the CCTV footage and have alerted our human intelligence," said a police officer.

Menstruation festival to be celebrated in 11 countries from May 21

Thane: Maasika Mahotsav, a week-long festival that aims to destigmatise periods through sports, arts and cultural programmes, will be celebrated from May 21 in 11 countries.
