BIG TECH ENTRY INTO BFSI SECTOR

Industry and RBI on the same page

'Cyber security, regulatory and data privacy risks could hit financial sector'

DEBANGANA GHOSH

Mumbai, June 2 In its annual report for 2022, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) cautioned against the systematic risks involved in allowing global Big Techs venturing into the BFSI sector. Industry experts called it a valid concern as market dominance, cyber security, regulatory and data privacy risks could hinder the sensitive financial sector.

The RBI report noted: "In parallel, the central bank, while encouraging innovation, is also factoring in the emerging risks in the FinTech segment. Greater use of technology accentuates the concerns related to cyber security. Further, the involvement of Big Techs in the

BFSI segment, also brings along the systemic risks."

It added: "All of the above have implications for financial stability, and it is the endeavour of the Reserve Bank to mitigate such risks through careful choice of technology and frameworks, while providing an impetus to the FinTech in a wide array of useful applications in the financial service

"The entry of Big Techs will indeed raise a new set of questions, which need careful consideration. From the fintech lending perspective, it will be important to ensure that reguincluding those around customer protection, uniformly apply to all and that



there is no arbitrage. Other critical aspects are ensuring competition, choice and innovation in the marketplace in the interests of the customers, so that they have suitable and affordable credit on a sustainable basis," Sugandh Saxena, CEO, Fintech Association for Empowerment Consumer (FACE), told *BusinessLine*.

"When large-scale operations are hinging upon 2-3 vendors for a lot of critical requirements, it increases the

risk. But when several vendors are involved, the risk gets mitigated, and this is true for all sectors and not just the BFSI sector. But the case is a bit peculiar for BFSI because of the sensitivity in the transactions involved. Every organisation today wants to de-risk themselves, that's why hybrid cloud, multi-cloud exists," said Sanchit Vir Gogia, Chief Analyst and CEO, Greyhound Research.

"However, the moment you add even an Indian big tech or co-location company and you step into new architecture like public cloud, API, you open up to a lot of new risks. That will continue to exist whether it is a local or an international vendor. It's important to have more vendors at multiple layers. Banks are doing open source offerings, which is great, but it cannot survive

without the Big Techs. Beyond a point, you cannot survive without Oracle, Microsoft or Google; these are very critical to your operations," he added.

Customer data

According to Sonam Chandwani, Managing Partner, KS Legal & Associates, cyber security risks and data privacy concerns rise with international Big Techs as they gain control over the customer's data.

"Data privacy is very crucial for financial services and that's what the RBI is concerned about. As the digital economy expands in India, the Big Techs anyway have a lot of control over the market; they have huge data sets of existing customers. This will give them an anti-competitive advantage as most clients would go to them," she said.

'IRDAI's use and file norms place greater responsibility on insurers'

Non-life insurers will have to be more responsible and accountable following the insurance regulator's decision to allow general and standalone health insurers to launch products without prior approval.

While insurers have welcomed the move as it gives them greater freedom and enhances efficiency in launching products, they also believe customer protection will have to be even more of a

Faster launch of products

"The new guidelines will support the industry to launch products faster. This also puts a lot of responsibility on insurers," said S Prakash, MD, Star Health and Allied Insur-

ance. Insurers must ensure that filing is done as per board-approved use and file policy, and ensure that product pricing is viable, selfsustainable and affordable. Revisions must be based on incurred claims ratio to make products viable and sustainable, while ensuring that they maintain proper data, Prakash added.

The guidelines, announced by the Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (IRDAI) on June 1, has extended the 'use and file' procedure for health insurance products and almost all general insurance products. "The guidelines show IRDAI's confidence in the industry, and it will help insurers launch products faster," said MN Sarma, Secretary General, General Insurance Council.

He added since the products are use and file, they will have to be filed with the IRDAI. If something is not right, the regulator may ask the insurer to withdraw the product, he noted.

Shanai Ghosh, Executive Director and CEO, Edelweiss General Insurance, said: "Insurers will now have a greater responsibility to ensure robust product development and pricing along with policyholder protection."

The IRDAI, too, in its circular, has made it clear that it would take action against any insurer found to be non-compliant with the procedure. In such cases, the IRDAI may direct the insurer to withdraw the product. It could also withdraw the use and file facility for the insurer for a period as may be determined.

Meta's Sheryl Sandberg quits; end of an era, says Zuckerberg

She helped build a world-class ad-buying platform

San Francisco, June 2 Sheryl Sandberg, the No 2 executive at Facebook-owner Meta, who helped turn its business from start up to digital advertising empire while also taking blame for some of its biggest missteps, is stepping down.

Sandberg has served as chief operating officer at the socialmedia giant for 14 years. She joined from Google in 2008, four years before Facebook went public.

"When I took this job in 2008, I hoped I would be in this role for five years. Fourteen years later, it is time for me to write the next chapter of my life," Sandberg wrote on her Facebook page on Wednesday. Sandberg has led Facebook's advertising business, and was responsible for nurturing it

from its infancy into an over \$100 billion-a-year powerhouse. As the company's second most-recognised face after CEO Mark Zuckerberg – Sandberg has also become a polarising figure amid revelations of how some of her business decisions for Facebook helped propagate misinformation and hate speech.

Not done enough, say some

As one of the most prominent female executives in the tech industry, she was also often criticised for not doing enough both for women and for others harmed by Facebook's

Reacting to her decision to call it a day, Zuckerberg wrote on his Facebook page: "It's the end of an era. When Sheryl joined me in 2008, I was only 23 years old and I barely knew anything about running a company. Sheryl architected our ads business, hired great people, forged our management culture, and taught me how to run a company. She created opportunities for millions of people around the world, and she deserves the credit for so much of what Meta is today.

"I'm going to miss running this company with Sheryl. But I'm glad that she'll continue to serve on our board of directors. Looking forward, I don't plan to replace Sheryl's role in our existing structure. I'm not sure that would be possible since she's a superstar who defined the COO role in her

Facebook sees 38% jump in hate speech

PRESS TRUST OF INDIA New Delhi, June 2

There was a rise of around 37.82 per cent in hate speech on social-media platform Facebook and 86 per cent jump in violent and inciting content on Instagram in April, according to a monthly report released by Meta.

The majority of the content in the report is based on detection by social-media platforms before users reported to them.

According to the report released on May 31, Facebook detected 53,200 hate speech in April, which is 37.82 per cent higher compared to 38,600 detected in March, on which the platform took action.

Action taken

The report showed that Instagram acted on 77,000 violence and incitement-related content in April, compared to

With a spate of big-ticket releases lined up across languages for the remaining part of 2022, the year is projected to close at a gross domestic box-office of ₹12,515 crore, which will be the highest-ever, beating the 2019 levels by a margin of ₹1,567 crore, the report

2022 is also the first time that the domestic gross boxoffice has crossed the ₹4,000 crore level in the Jan-April period.
