## কলকাতা ও শহরতাল

## আজ মধ্যমগ্রামে মমতার প্রশাসনিক বৈঠক, বিরোধী এমপি-বিধায়করা আমন্ত্রণ পাননি

## একই দিনে বারাকপুরে ঝাভা ছাড়াই বাম-কংগ্রেসের যৌথ মিছিল

নিজম্ব প্রতিনিধি, কলকাতা: লোকসভা ভোটের ফল প্রকাশের পর দলের সংগঠনের দিকে বাড়তি নজর দিয়েছিলেন মুখ্যমন্ত্রী তথা তৃণমূল সুপ্রিমো মমতা বন্দ্যোপাধ্যায়। নবান্নের রুটিন প্রশাসনিক কাজ সারলেও গত দু'মাসে তিনি নিজের রেওয়াজ মেনে তাই জেলা সফরে বেরননি। তার আগে নির্বাচনী বিধির কারণে আরও প্রায় তিন মাস সরকারি সফরে বেরননি মুখ্যমন্ত্রী। কিন্তু তাঁর জেলাওয়াড়ি প্রশাসনিক বৈঠকের সাফল্যের কথা মাথায় রেখে আজ, শুক্রবার থেকে ফের সেই পথে হাঁটতে চলেছেন তিনি। আজ বারাসতের কাছে মধ্যমগ্রামের নজরুল মঞ্চে উত্তর ২৪ পরগনা জেলার প্রশাসনিক বৈঠক দিয়েই মমতা লোকসভা ভোট পরবর্তী পর্যায়ের কর্মসূচি শুরু

মমতার এই বৈঠকে অবশ্য শেষ পর্যন্ত বিরোধী দলের নির্বাচিত প্রতিনিধিরা ডাক পাচ্ছেন কি না, তা বৃহস্পতিবার রাত পর্যন্ত স্পষ্ট নয়। জেলায় বিরোধীদের মধ্যে সিপিএম ও কংগ্রেসের পাঁচ বিধায়ক এবং বিজেপির এক বিধায়ক ও দুই সাংসদের কেউই বৈঠকে যোগ দেওয়ার জন্য প্রশাসনের তরফে কোনও চিঠি পাননি এদিন সন্ধ্যা পর্যন্ত। এ নিয়ে জেলাশাসক চৈতালি চক্রবর্তীর সঙ্গে যোগাযোগ করা হলে তিনিও কিছু খোলসা করেননি। সম্প্রতি বিধানসভার অধিবেশন চলাকালীন একদিন সদনের নৌশাদ আলি কক্ষে আয়োজিত একটি বৈঠকে মুখ্যমন্ত্ৰী শাসক ও বিরোধী উভয় শিবিরের তফসিলি জাতি ও উপজাতি বিধায়কদের সঙ্গে মুখোমুখি আলোচনায় বসেছিলেন। তারপর আদিবাসী সম্প্রদায়ের উন্নয়নের লক্ষ্যে গঠিত একটি সরকারি কমিটির বৈঠকেও বিজেপি বিধায়ক তথা পরিষদীয় দলনেতা মনোজ টিগ্গা ডাক পেয়েছিলেন। সর্বোপরি, পরিষদীয় রাজনীতির ক্ষেত্রে সেই সময়ই শাসকপক্ষ বিরোধী বাম-কংগ্রেসের সঙ্গে পূর্ব তিক্ততা অনেকটাই কমিয়ে আনার চেষ্টা করে। যদিও বিজেপির বিরুদ্ধে যৌথ আন্দোলনের ব্যাপারে মখ্যমন্ত্রীর দেওয়া বার্তাকে বাম ও কংগ্রেস উভয়েই



নস্যাৎ করে। তবুও বিরোধী পক্ষের পরিষদীয় নেতৃত্বের সঙ্গে নানা ইস্যুতে একাধিকবার দেখা করার সৌজন্য মমতা দেখান। আগের তুলনায় এই দুই বিরোধী পক্ষের সঙ্গে সম্পর্ক তুলনামূলকভাবে কিছুটা ভালো হওয়ার লক্ষণ দেখা দেওয়ায় মনে করা হয়েছিল, এবার থেকে জেলাওয়াড়ি প্রশাসনিক বৈঠকগুলিতে বিরোধী বিধায়করাও ডাক পাবেন। কিন্তু সম্প্রতি নবালে অনুষ্ঠিত পঞ্চায়েতের তিনটি স্তরের নির্বাচিত প্রতিনিধিদের সঙ্গে মুখ্যমন্ত্রীর বৈঠকে বিরোধীদের কাউকে ডাকা হয়নি। তার পরিপ্রেক্ষিতে জেলার প্রশাসনিক বৈঠকেও তাঁরা ডাক পাবেন না বলেই ধরে নিয়েছে দুই বিরোধী শিবির। এ ব্যাপারে বিরোধী দলনেতা কংগ্রেসের আব্দুল মান্নান ও বাম পরিষদীয় দলনেতা সুজন চক্রবর্তী এদিন একসুরেই বলেন, রাজ্যে একদলীয় শাসন ব্যবস্থা কায়েম করার ব্যাপারে সরকার তথা মুখ্যমন্ত্রীর মনোভাবের কোনও

পরিবর্তন হয়নি। ওঁর মুখে এরপর গণতন্ত্রের কথা কিছুতেই মানায় না।

এদিকে, মুখ্যমন্ত্রীর জেলা সফরের দিনেই বাম ও কংগ্রেস উত্তর শহরতলির বারাকপুরে এক যৌথ রাজনৈতিক কর্মসচির ডাক দিয়েছে। ভাটপাডাকাণ্ডের পরিপ্রেক্ষিতে গোটা তল্লাটে এখনও শান্তি ফেরানোর ক্ষেত্রে প্রশাসনিক ব্যর্থতার অভিযোগে আজ বারাকপুর স্টেশন থেকে পুলিশ কমিশনারের অফিস পর্যন্ত মিছিল করবেন উভয় পক্ষের নেতা-কর্মী-সমর্থকরা। তবে এই কর্মসূচি হবে সংশ্লিষ্ট দলগুলির ঝান্ডা ছাড়াই। মিছিলে বামপক্ষের বিমান বসু, সুর্যকান্ত মিশ্র. মঞ্জকুমার মজুমদারদের পাশাপাশি প্রদেশ সভাপতি সোমেন মিত্র সহ কংগ্রেসের নেতারা পা মেলাবেন একত্রে। এর আগেও একদিন এই ইস্যতে ভাটপাড়ায় যৌথ কর্মসূচিতে শামিল হয়েছিলেন বাম ও কংগ্রেসের রাজ্য নেতারা। *- নিজস্ব চিত্র*

বিএনএ, বারাকপুর: বৃহস্পতিবার বড়সড় দুর্ঘটনা থেকে রক্ষা পেল আপ নৈহাটি লোকাল। শিয়ালদহ মেন শাখায় শ্যামনগর স্টেশনের ২৫বি লেভেল ক্রসিংয়ে একটি বালি বোঝাই লরি বিকল হয়ে পড়ায় গেট পড়েনি। গেট না পড়লেও সবুজ সিগন্যাল পেয়ে এদিন সকাল ১১টা ৩০ মিনিটে প্ল্যাটফর্ম থেকে ছেড়ে দেয় আপ নৈহাটি লোকাল। গেটম্যানের তৎপরতায় লেভেল ক্রসিংয়ের কয়েকজ গজ দূরে থামে ট্রেনটি। ফলে বডসড দুর্ঘটনা থেকে রক্ষা পেল ওই ট্রেন। স্থানীয় সূত্রে জানা গিয়েছে, দিনের ব্যস্ত সময়ে এই লেভেল ক্রসিং দিয়ে বাইক, সাইকেল আরোহী ও পথচলতি মানুষ পারাপার হচ্ছিলেন। এমন সময় তাঁরা দেখেন, আপ লাইনে একটি ট্রেন এগিয়ে আসছে। অথচ ক্রসিংয়ের গেট খোলা রয়েছে। সকলেই প্রায় ট্রেন লাইনের কাছে এসে দাঁড়ান। ট্রেন দেখে চমকে যান গেটম্যানও। তিনি তড়িঘড়ি কেবিন থেকে হটলাইনে ফোন করেন শ্যামনগরের স্টেশন ম্যানেজারকে। স্টেশন মাস্টার আবার ওয়াকিটকিতে চালককে ট্রেন থামানোর নির্দেশ দেন। সকলকে স্বস্তি দিয়ে ক্রসিংয়ের কয়েক গজ দূরে নৈহাটি লোকাল থামে। সূত্রে জানা গিয়েছে, লেভেল ক্রসিং পেরোনোর সময় বালি বোঝাই একটি লরি বিকল হয়ে যায়। তার ফলে গেট বন্ধ হচ্ছিল না। কিন্তু গেট বন্ধ না হওয়া সত্ত্বেও কীভাবে ট্রেনটি সবুজ সিগন্যাল পেল, তা নিয়ে প্রশ্ন উঠেছে।

দক্ষিণ সিঁথি (বিটি রোড) থেকে দমদম স্টেশন পর্যন্ত রুটের অটো চালকরা। তাঁদের

অভিযোগ, দীর্ঘদিন ধরেই বহিরাগত অটোর দাপট এই রুটে বেড়ে চলেছে। বারবার

এবিষয়ে প্রশাসনকে বলেও কোনও লাভ হয়নি। তাই এদিন বাধ্য হয়েই অটো

রুটকে বন্ধ করে দেয় চালকরা। ফলে ব্যাপক ভোগান্তিতে পডতে হয় স্থানীয়

বাসিন্দাদের। বিশেষ করে সকালে অফিসযাত্রীদের মারাত্মক ভোগান্তি হয়। উল্লেখ্য,

এই রুটে একদিকে বিটি রোড এবং অন্যদিকে দমদম স্টেশন— দু'দিকেই প্রচুর

অফিস যাত্রীর নিত্য যাতায়াত। ফলে সকাল থেকেই অফিস যাত্রীদের চরম

চালকদের পক্ষ থেকে দাবি করা হয়েছে, এই রুটে মোট ৫০টি অটো চলে। তবে

বিভিন্ন সময় নেতারা 'কাটমানি' খেয়ে এই রুটে অন্য জায়গার বহু অটোকে ঢকিয়ে

দিয়েছে। যেহেতু এই রুটটি অত্যন্ত ব্যস্ত এবং লাভজনক— তাই এই রুটের উপর

অনেক অন্য জায়গার অটো চালকদের নজর রয়েছে। এই অবস্থায় অন্যান্য জায়গা

নিজস্ব প্রতিনিধি, কলকাতা: রিজেন্ট পার্ক থানা এলাকার শান্তিনগরে তৃণমূল-বিজেপি সংঘর্ষ। বৃহস্পতিবার রাতে ঘটনাটি ঘটেছে। অভিযোগ, বিজেপি এদিন ওই এলাকায় সদস্য সংগ্রহের কাজ করছিল। সেই সময় তৃণমূলের লোকজন গিয়ে বিজেপি কর্মীদের বাধা দেয়। বিজেপি কর্মীদের মারধর করে। ক্যাম্প ভেঙে দেয়। এরপরেই দু'পক্ষের মধ্যে সংঘর্ষ শুরু হয়ে যায়। তৃণমূলের পাল্টা অভিযোগ, তাদের কর্মীদের আগে মারধর করা হয়। রিজেন্ট পার্ক থানার পুলিস গিয়ে পরিস্থিতি নিয়ন্ত্রণে আনে। রাতে দু'পক্ষই থানার

## এক লক্ষ 'ইয়াবা' ট্যাবলেট সহ ধৃত ২

নিজম্ব প্রতিনিধি, কলকাতা: কলকাতায় ফের বিপুল পরিমাণ 'ইয়াবা' ট্যাবলেট সহ দু'জনকে গ্রেপ্তার করল পুলিস। বৃহস্পতিবার সন্ধ্যায় গোপন সূত্রে খবর পেয়ে কলকাতা পলিসের এসটিএফ প্রগতি ময়দান থানা এলাকার অন্তর্গত বাসন্তী হাইওয়েতে একটি গাড়িকে আটক করে। তল্লাশি চালিয়ে সেই গাড়ির দরজায় একটি বিশেষ 'খাপ' খুঁজে পায় পুলিস। সেখান থেকেই বিপুল পরিমাণ 'ইয়াবা' নামক নিষিদ্ধ মাদক উদ্ধার করা হয়। সূত্রের খবর, কলকাতাতেই এই নিষিদ্ধ মাদক আসছিল। তাই কার জন্য এই নিষিদ্ধ মাদক আনা হচ্ছিল? সেবিষয়ে ধৃতদের আরও জিজ্ঞাসাবাদ করতে চায় প্রলিসও।

পুলিসের পক্ষ থেকে জানানো হয়েছে, ধৃতদের কাছ থেকে এক লক্ষ 'ইয়াবা' ট্যাবলেট উদ্ধার করা হয়েছে। যার ওজন প্রায় ১০ কেজি। নিষিদ্ধ মাদক হিসেবে এই মুহুর্তে 'ইয়াবা'র মূল্য বেশ চড়া। পুলিস সূত্রের দাবি, এক কেজি 'ইয়াবা'র মূল্যই প্রায় এক কোটি টাকার কাছাকাছি। সেক্ষেত্রে ১০ কেজি 'ইয়াবা'র মূল্য প্রায় ১০ কোটি টাকার কাছাকাছি হবে। এই ঘটনায় ধৃতরা হল, রিপন হোসেন ওরফে ইব্রাহিম এবং রিপন শেখ। এদের দু'জনেরই বাডি যথাক্রমে মুর্শিদাবাদের সৃতি এবং রঘনাথগঞ্জে। ধতদের জিজ্ঞাসাবাদ করে এই বিপল পরিমাণ 'ইয়াবা' ট্যাবলেট কোথা থেকে তারা পেল এবং কোথায় পাঠানো হচ্ছিল? এখন সেই হদিশ পেতে চাইছেন এসটিএফেব গোয়েন্দাবা।

উল্লেখ্য, এর আগেও কলকাতায় একাধিকবার কেন্দ্রীয় সংস্থা নারকোটিক্স ক্রাইম ব্যুরো (এনসিবি) এবং কলকাতা পুলিসের গোয়েন্দা বিভাগও 'ইয়াবা' ট্যাবলেট উদ্ধার করেছিল। এনসিবি কয়েকবার বিপুল পরিমাণ ইয়াবা ট্যাবলেট উদ্ধার করেছিল। সেই সময়েই তদন্তে জানা গিয়েছিল, এই ইয়াবা ট্যাবলেট মূলত তৈরি হয়ে থাকে চীনের ইউনান প্রদেশে। সেখান থেকেই এই ট্যাবলেট মায়ানমার সহ দক্ষিণ-পূর্ব এশিয়ার বিভিন্ন দেশে ছড়িয়ে পড়ে চোরাই পথে। তারপরে সেখান থেকে চোরাই পথে সেই ট্যাবলেট এতদিন বাংলাদেশে আসত। গত একবছরেরও বেশি সময় ধরে বাংলাদেশ থেকে আবার চোরাই পথে সেই ট্যাবলেট কলকাতা সহ ভারতের বিভিন্ন বড শহরে ছডিয়ে পডছে। এমনকী এর আগের ঘটনাগুলির তদন্তে নেমে এনসিবি জানতে পেরেছিল, মুর্শিদাবাদে এই ইয়াবা ট্যাবলেট নকল তৈরি করা হচ্ছে। সেগুলি আবার সস্তায় ভারত সহ বাংলাদেশ এবং প্রতিবেশী বিভিন্ন দেশে বিক্রি করার চেষ্টা করছে একটি চক্র। এবারেও কলকাতা যে দু'জন ধরা পড়েছে তারা মুর্শিদাবাদের। তাই এসটিএফের গোয়েন্দাদের প্রাথমিক অনুমান, এই ইয়াবা ট্যাবলেটের অধিকাংশটাই মুর্শিদাবাদে তৈরি। অল্প কিছু বিদেশি ট্যাবলেট রয়েছে। সেক্ষেত্রে সেগুলি মুর্শিদাবাদে কোথায় তৈরি হচ্ছে এবং কীভাবে কলকাতায় আনা হচ্ছে? সেবিষয়ে ধৃতদের জিজ্ঞাসাবাদ করে বিস্তারিত জানতে চায় পুলিস।

• *মাকে অত্যাচার, গ্রেপ্তার ছেলে:* বৃদ্ধা মাকে মানসিক অত্যাচার ও বাড়ি থেকে বেরিয়ে যেতে বাধ্য করার অভিযোগে ছেলেকে গ্রেপ্তার করল প্রলিস। ঘটনাটি ঘটেছে বিষ্ণুপুরের গোতলাহাটের সুলতানগঞ্জের কৃষ্ণপুরে। পুলিস জানিয়েছে, বৃহস্পতিবার ছেলেকে ধরার পর বৃদ্ধাকে গাড়ি করে তাঁর বাড়ি পৌঁছে দেওয়া হয়েছে। জানা গিয়েছে, কার্তিক মণ্ডল তার মা সন্ধ্যা মণ্ডলের উপর মানসিক অত্যাচার চালাচ্ছিল। ঘটনাটি সঠিক জানার পর বৃহস্পতিবার গ্রেপ্তার



করা হয়েছে ছেলে কার্তিককে।

## বোতলবন্দি জল: বড়বাজারের দুই সংস্থার বিরুদ্ধে ব্যবস্থা নিচ্ছে পুরসভা

পাইকারি বিক্রি ও সরবরাহের জন্য লাইসেন্স নিয়ে চলছিল পানীয় জল উৎপাদন। সেই জল জারে ভরে বিক্রি করা হচ্ছে খোলা বাজারে। বড়বাজার এবং স্ট্র্যান্ড রোড সংলগ্ন চত্বরে পানীয় জল উৎপাদনের তিনটি সংস্থার কারখানায় বৃহস্পতিবার অভিযান চালান পুরসভার ডেপুটি মেয়র তথা খাদ্যে ভেজাল প্রতিরোধ বিভাগের দায়িত্বে থাকা অতীন ঘোষ ও পুর-আধিকারিকরা। সেই অভিযানে দু'টি ক্ষেত্রে অবৈধ কারবারের চিত্র সামনে আসে। এর মধ্যে একটি সংস্থা জল বিক্রি ও সরবরাহের লাইসেন্স নিয়ে পুরসভার জল ধরে তা সামান্য 'কুলিং' করার পর পিউরিফায়ারে দিয়েই জারবন্দি করছিল। আরেকটি সংস্থা জল উৎপাদনের অনুমোদন নিয়ে রাখলেও যে পদ্ধতিতে জারবন্দি পানীয় জল উৎপাদন করা উচিত, তার কোনও পদ্ধতি ও নিয়মই মানেনি। সেই দু'টি উৎপাদক সংস্থার ট্রেড লাইসেন্স বাতিল করা হবে বলে জানিয়েছেন অতীনবাবু। পাশাপাশি কেন্দ্রীয় সরকারের খাদ্য নিরাপত্তা আইন অনুযায়ী তাদের বিরুদ্ধে আইনি ব্যবস্থাও নেওয়া হবে বলে অতীনবাবু জানিয়েছেন। তিনি বলেন, আমি চিফ ম্যানেজার (লাইসেন্স)-কে বলেছি, আমাদের পুরসভা থেকে যতজনকে পানীয় জল বিক্রি ও বন্টনের (হোলসেলার এবং ডিস্ট্রিবিউটর) লাইসেন্স

যেমন-তেমনভাবে জল উৎপাদন করে এভাবে বাজারে চালিয়ে দিচ্ছে, তা খতিয়ে দেখতে হবে। পুরসভার খাদ্যে ভেজাল প্রতিরোধ বিভাগের এক পদস্থ আধিকারিক জানান, জলের জারগুলিতে কোনও এক্সপায়ারি ডেট লেখা নেই। তাছাড়া 'রিভার্স অসমোসিস' পদ্ধতিতে কেউ জল শোধন করছে না। একটিমাত্র সংস্থা তা মেনে চলছে। তাই অবৈধ সংস্থাগুলির বিরুদ্ধে এবার কড়া ব্যবস্থা নেওয়া হবে।

উত্তর ও মধ্য কলকাতায় পানীয় জলের সঙ্কট সেভাবে না থাকলেও দক্ষিণ কলকাতার একটা বড় অংশের মধ্যবিত্ত, উচ্চবিত্ত নাগরিকরা এখনও বোতল ও জারবন্দি পানীয় জলের উপর নির্ভর করেন। তার একটা অন্যতম কারণ, পুরসভার পরিশ্রুত পানীয় জলের সরবরাহ যথেষ্ট নয়। সম্প্রতি দক্ষিণ কলকাতার যাদবপুর, গড়িয়া, বাঘাযতীন অঞ্চলে ডায়েরিয়া, জন্ডিসের মতো জলবাহিত সংক্রমণ ছড়িয়েছে। জার ও বোতলবন্দি জলের বিরুদ্ধে এদিনের অভিযানে যে চিত্র ধরা পড়েছে, তাতে একটা বিষয় স্পষ্ট যে, প্রশাসনের নজর এড়িয়ে কোনও নিয়মকানুন ও স্বীকৃত পদ্ধতির তোয়াক্কা না করেই দিনের পর দিন চলছে পানীয়

## অবৈধ নির্মাণের বিরুদ্ধে ব্যবস্থা: ইঞ্জিনিয়ারদের বলির পাঁঠা করা হচ্ছে কেন, প্রশ্ন তুলল পুরকর্মীদের সংগঠন

নিজস্ব প্রতিনিধি, কলকাতা: বেআইনি নির্মাণের বিরুদ্ধে ব্যবস্থা নেওয়ার ক্ষেত্রে অ্যাসিস্ট্যান্ট ইঞ্জিনিয়ার (এ ই) এবং সাব-অ্যাসিস্ট্যান্ট ইঞ্জিনিয়ারদের (এস এ ই) ক্ষমতা সীমিত। কোনও অবৈধ নির্মাণ ভেঙে দেওয়া বা সেটিকে পুরসভার আইন মেনে 'বৈধ' করে দেওয়ার কোনও ক্ষমতা তাঁদের হাতে নেই। অথচ অবৈধ নির্মাণের অভিযোগের ক্ষেত্রে কার্যত তাঁদেরকেই 'বলির পাঁঠা' করা হচ্ছে। সম্প্রতি চালু হওয়া মেয়রের লাইভ ফোন-ইন অনুষ্ঠান 'টক টু মেয়র'-এ আসা একাধিক অবৈধ নির্মাণের অভিযোগের ভিত্তিতে যেভাবে মেয়র সরাসরি সংশ্লিষ্ট এ ই বা এস এ ই'কে শো-কজ করার নির্দেশ দিচ্ছেন, তাতে নীচের স্তরের ইঞ্জিনিয়ারদের মনোবল ধাক্কা খাচ্ছে বলেও অভিযোগ উঠছে। বহস্পতিবার এই অভিযোগ করেছে কলকাতা পরসভার ইঞ্জিনিয়ারদের সংগঠন কেএমসি ইঞ্জিনিয়ার্স অ্যান্ড অ্যালায়েড সার্ভিসেস অ্যাসোসিয়েশন। সংগঠনের সম্পাদক মানস সিনহা বলেন, মেয়র যেভাবে নাগরিকদের সঙ্গে সরাসরি যোগাযোগ

মাস ধরে চিকিৎসাধীন ছিলেন। পরে তিনি সুস্থ হন। আদালত সূত্রের খবর, জগদ্দল থানার মথুরাপুর এলাকায় বেআইনি মাটি কারবারের রমরমা রয়েছে। হাসিয়া বকুলতলার

## Karnataka: Speaker disqualifies 3 rebel MLAs

Reading out the decision, Kumar said he has disqualified rebel Congress MLAs Ramesh Jarkiholi, Mahesh Kumathalli and Independent MLA R Shankar (who had merged his party the Karnataka Pragnyavantha Janatha Party with the


The three MLAs are now disqualified for the entire term of current Assembly. They were disqualified under the 10th Schedule of the Anti-defection law. "They cannot be part of this Assembly in any form...They cannot contest till 2023," said the

"I still have many cases with me and I may require more days to act on them, I will come with others (the cases) in a couple of days," he added.

Reacting to the development, KPCC president Dinesh Gundurao tweeted: "Speaker #RameshKumar disqualifies 3 MLA's, R Shankar, Ramesh Jarkiholi & Mahesh Kumatalli for the entire term of the present Karnataka Vidhana Sabha. Wholeheartedly welcome the verdict. #VictoryForDemocracy."

This decision of the speaker leaves the BJP in a state of uncertainty.

# + Lok Sabha passes Triple Talaq Bill; Congress walks out

The Bill is required to ensure gender equality, justice: Ravi Shankar Prasad

New Delhi, July 25 Angry outbursts and threats of a walkout by the Congress in the Lok Sabha on Thursday preceded the passage of the Muslim Women (Protection of Rights on Marriage) Bill which makes the practice of instant triple talaq illegal with up to three years in jail for the offender.

The Bill was passed with 303 MPs voting in favour and 82 against.

Three Ordinances have so far been promulgated, as a similar bill moved by the previous government could not get Parliament's nod. A fresh bill was introduced by the government in June during the ongoing Parliament session.

The main objections against the proposed legislation pertained to why divorce, a civil matter, was being turned into a criminal act; what was the reason to bring a law when the Supreme Court had already termed the practice of triple talaq as null and void; and from whom is the wife expected to get her subsistence allowance if the husband is serving a jail term.

Law Minister Ravi Shankar Prasad, who piloted the bill, underlined its significance saying that it is required for ensuring gender equality and justice. He added that despite the August 2017 Supreme Court verdict striking down

the practice, women are still being divorced through the practice of talaq-e-biddat. He said since January 2017,

as many as 574 triple cases and more than 300 since the Supreme Court order, were reported by media. The Law Minsaid "20 Muslim countries in the world, including Pakistan and Malaysia,

have banned the practice. Why can't a secular country like India do it?" he said.

Revolutionary Socialist Party (RSP) MP NK Premachandran said the Bill has been brought with an 'ulterior political motive to target the Muslim community' and 'specific political agenda of the BJP'. "You are bringing the Bill on the basis of the minority judgment of the court. If you are so concerned, why don't you bring a legislation to end the incidents of mob lynching. What is your stand on Sabarimala temple," he said.

We allocate money to the States under the scheme and it is up to them to decide the menu. The Centre also allocates money if a State comes up with innovative ideas for the scheme," said an official from the Ministry of Human Resources and Development.

The Hyderabad-based National Institute of Nutrition has pointed out in multiple recommendations guidelines that egg is a complete food for children. "Egg is proven to be a wholesome food, especially for children below two years. It provides the nutrients that a child requires," said Veena Shatrugna, former deputy director of Na-

tional Institute of Nutrition. Despite the political resistance, piecemeal efforts were made in certain districts of Madhya Pradesh to provide eggs and they bore fruit, said Sachin Kumar Jain, a social researcher. However, such initiatives were later discontinued because of political pressure.

Reacting to the development, KPCC president Dinesh Gundurao tweeted: "Speaker #RameshKumar disqualifies 3 MLA's, R Shankar, Ramesh Jarkiholi & Mahesh Kumatalli for the entire term of the present Karnataka Vidhana Sabha. Wholeheartedly welcome the verdict. #VictoryForDemocracy."

Nagpur, July 25 The Nagpur Bench of the Bombay High Court on Thursday issued notices to Union Minister Nitin Gadkari and the Election Commission, on a bunch of petitions challenging Gadkari's election to the Lok Sabha in 2019 polls.

A single-judge Bench of Justice AS Chandurkar took up for hearing three separate petitions filed by Congress leader Nana Patole, Vanchit Bahujan Aghadi (VBA) candidate Manohar Dabrase and Nafis Khan, alleging electoral malpractices in the poll process.

Patole and Dabrase were pitted against Gadkari in the election. The BJP stalwart defeated Patole by 1.97 lakh votes.

While Patole claimed that the procedure was not followed by the State Election Commissioner during the election process, Dabrase in his petition alleged that defective electronic voting machines were used in polling.

After hearing the arguments from counsel for petitioners, Justice Chandurkar ordered notices to Gadkari, the EC and the collector, who was the Returning Officer for Nagpur, and directed them to file their affidavits responding to the allegations. Further hearing in the case is scheduled for August 22.

New Delhi, July 25 Angry outbursts and threats of a walkout by the Congress in the Lok Sabha on Thursday preceded the passage of the Muslim Women (Protection of Rights on Marriage) Bill which makes the practice of instant triple talaq illegal with up to three years in jail for the offender.

The Bill was passed with 303 MPs voting in favour and 82 against.

Three Ordinances have so far been promulgated, as a similar bill moved by the previous government could not get Parliament's nod. A fresh bill was introduced by the government in June during the ongoing Parliament session.

The main objections against the proposed legislation pertained to why divorce, a civil matter, was being turned into a criminal act; what was the reason to bring a law when the Supreme Court had already termed the practice of triple talaq as null and void; and from whom is the wife expected to get her subsistence allowance if the husband is

serving a jail term. Law Minister Ravi Shankar Prasad, who piloted the bill, underlined its significance saying that it is required for ensuring gender equality and justice. He added that despite the August 2017 Supreme Court verdict striking down

New Delhi, July 25

Angry outbursts and threats of a walkout by the Congress in the Lok Sabha on Thursday preceded the passage of the Muslim Women (Protection of Rights on Marriage) Bill which makes the practice of instant triple talaq illegal with up to three years in jail for the offender.

The Bill was passed with 303 MPs voting in favour and 82 against.

Three Ordinances have so far been promulgated, as a similar bill moved by the previous government could not get Parliament's nod. A fresh bill was introduced by the government in June during the ongoing Parliament session.

The main objections against the proposed legislation pertained to why divorce, a civil matter, was being turned into a criminal act; what was the reason to bring a law when the Supreme Court had already termed the practice of triple talaq as null and void; and from whom is the wife expected to get her subsistence allowance if the husband is serving a jail term.

Law Minister Ravi Shankar Prasad, who piloted the bill, underlined its significance saying that it is required for ensuring gender equality and justice. He added that despite the August 2017 Supreme Court verdict striking down

wadis reveals. Available data shows that it is mostly the schools in the southern and eastern region which serve eggs. In the north, Jammu and Kashmir, and Uttarakhand provide eggs to students in schools.

Also, the policy is haphazardly implemented with Jammu and Kashmir, Uttarakhand, Assam and Kerala serving only one egg per week under the programme, while Andhra Pradesh and Tamil Nadu serve five eggs per week. Most States, including larger ones such as Maharashtra, Gujarat and Rajasthan, do not serve eggs. "The Centre has no role to play in it. We allocate money to the States under the scheme and it is up to them to decide the menu. The Centre also allocates money if a State comes up with innovative ideas for the scheme," said an official from the Ministry of Human Resources and Development.

The Hyderabad-based National Institute of Nutrition has pointed out in multiple recommendations guidelines that egg is a complete food for children. "Egg is proven to be a wholesome food, especially for children below two years. It provides the nutrients that a child requires," said Veena Shatrugna, former deputy director of Na-

tional Institute of Nutrition. Shatrugna added that while certain private contractors may not be okay with eggs on the menu, a State can always disburse separate funding to schools for providing eggs in mid-day meals, as in

# + Lok Sabha passes Triple Talaq Bill; Congress walks out

The Bill is required to ensure gender equality, justice: Ravi Shankar Prasad

New Delhi, July 25 Angry outbursts and threats of a walkout by the Congress in the Lok Sabha on Thursday preceded the passage of the Muslim Women (Protection of Rights on Marriage) Bill which makes the practice of instant triple talaq illegal with up to three years in jail for the offender.

The Bill was passed with 303 MPs voting in favour and 82 against.

Three Ordinances have so far been promulgated, as a similar bill moved by the previous government could not get Parliament's nod. A fresh bill was introduced by the government in June during the ongoing Parliament session.

The main objections against the proposed legislation pertained to why divorce, a civil matter, was being turned into a criminal act; what was the reason to bring a law when the Supreme Court had already termed the practice of triple talaq as null and void; and from whom is the wife expected to get her subsistence allowance if the husband is serving a jail term.

Law Minister Ravi Shankar Prasad, who piloted the bill, underlined its significance saying that it is required for ensuring gender equality and justice. He added that despite the August 2017 Supreme Court verdict striking down

the practice, women are still being divorced through the practice of talaq-e-biddat. He said since January 2017,

as many as 574 triple cases and more than 300 since the Supreme Court order, were reported by media. The Law Minsaid "20 Muslim countries in the world, including Pakistan and Malaysia,

have banned the practice. Why can't a secular country like India do it?" he said.

Tense atmosphere

During the debate, ruling party MPs raised a strong objection to Rampur MP Azam Khan's address to the Deputy Speaker Rama Devi, who was presiding at the time.

Asaduddin Owaisi, who said that for a crime to be committed, both intent and act need to have occurred, "When there is no actus reus (action which is the constituent element of a crime), how can there be a crime. The Supreme Court has already declared talaq-e-biddat as null and void. So for what action is the government proposing to jail the husband?" he asked.

Owaisi asserted this was an 'anti-women' legislation.

"When the husband pronounces triple talaq, which the Supreme Court has declared null and void, the government sends the husband to jail. What is the wife supposed to do when he comes back from jail after three years. Will she say baharo phool barsao mera mehboob aya hai (let flowers rain on my beloved)'. What kind of absurdity is this?" he said, asking that when all serious offences such as homosexuality and adultery are being legalised in a marriage, why is a Muslim man being sent to jail for divorcing his wife?

Revolutionary Socialist Party (RSP) MP NK Premachandran said the Bill has been brought with an 'ulterior political motive to target the Muslim community' and 'spe-BJP'. "You are bringing the Bill on the basis of the minority judgment of the court. If you are so concerned, why don't you bring a legislation to end the incidents of mob lynching. What is your stand on Sabarimala temple," he said.

## Eggs in noon-meal scheme: Why some States chicken out lust one-third of States provide eggs to

Sunday ho ya Monday, roz khao ande (be it Sunday or Monday, eat an egg daily) — has been relegated to nostalgia. Just one-third of States in India provide eggs to children ungovernment programmes, an analysis of supplies made to mid-day meal

wadis reveals. Available data shows that it is mostly the schools in the southern and eastern region which serve eggs. In the north, Jammu and Kashmir, and Uttarakhand provide eggs to students in schools.

Also, the policy is haphazardly implemented with Jammu and Kashmir, Uttarakhand, Assam and Kerala serving only one egg per week under the programme, while Andhra Pradesh and Tamil Nadu serve five eggs per week. Most States, including larger ones such as Maharashtra, Gujarat and Rajasthan, do not serve eggs. "The Centre has no role to play in it. We allocate money to the States under the scheme and it is up to them to decide the menu. The Centre also allocates money if a State comes up with innovative ideas for the scheme," said an official from the Ministry of Human Resources and Development.

The Hyderabad-based National Institute of Nutrition has pointed out in multiple recommendations guidelines that egg is a complete food for children. "Egg is proven to be a wholesome food, especially for children below two years. It provides the nutrients that a child requires," said Veena Shatrugna, former deputy director of Na-

tional Institute of Nutrition. Shatrugna added that while certain private contractors may not be okay with eggs on the menu, a State can always disburse separate funding to schools for providing eggs in mid-day meals, as in
