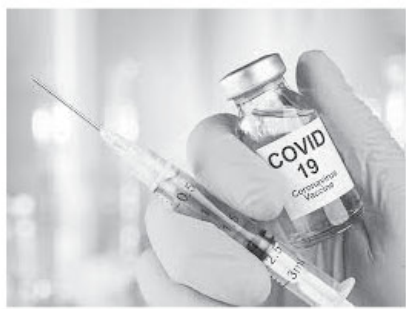
Pfizer starts dosing patients in oral Covid-19 drug trial



New Delhi : Pfizer Inc said on Wednesday it had started dosing in a mid-to-late-stage trial of its oral antiviral therapy for Covid-19 in non-hospitalized, symptomatic adult patients. The company and its rivals, including the US-based Merck & Co Inc and Swiss pharmaceutical Roche Holding AG, have been racing to develop the first antiviral pill to be taken on early signs of the illness. Pfizer's mid-to-late-stage trial in 1,140 participants would study the therapy, PF-07321332, in combination with a low dose of ritonavir, which has been used

with other antivirals too, the company said. (https://bit.ly/3kzWz9) PF-07321332 is designed to block the activity of a key enzyme that is needed for the coronavirus to replicate. To date, Gilead Sciences' remdesivir, administered intravenously, is the only approved antiviral treatment for covid-19 in the United States. Merck and partner Ridgeback Biotherapeutics' molnupiravir is already being studied in a late-stage trial in non-hospitalized patients to see if it reduces the risk of hospitalization or death. The companies said on Wednesday they had started a late-stage trial of molnupiravir for the prevention of covid-19 infection.

Vaccination: In the next phase, focus on hesitancy, the 12-18 age group, and booster shots



New Delhi : Two weeks ago, I wrote in this space that the coronavirus disease in India could soon stop being a pandemic and become endemic, an opinion that has since been aired by experts far more qualified than me. This also means that India could either dodge the third wave of the disease altogether — this is an opinion I have consistently articulated, despite the scare being created by some around a wave that affects young people or, at worst, see localised flare-ups. This, the pandemic-to-endemic transition, is a big and significant milestone, and it is coming soon.

There is another significant milestone that's coming too, perhaps as soon as the middle of October. This is the ceiling India will hit in terms of vaccine coverage. There are around 940 million people over the age of 18 in the country. The government has said it will vaccinate all of them by the end of the year — a stretch, but possible as long as supplies keep increasing as rapidly as they did in August.

The problem is that not all of them want vaccines. And short of vaccine mandates — I am all for

them, or creating some link between access to benefits such as grains under the public distribution system to vaccines, or even incentives — there is nothing that is likely to make them take the jab. I expect this ceiling at the 75-80% vaccination coverage level. That translates into 705-752 million people. The government, public health workers, employers, media, religious and charity organisations, influencers — all of us have a responsibility in making sure more people get vaccinated, but there are always those who will not.

The experience of the United States (US), where many infections, most hospitalisations, and almost all deaths currently being seen, are among the unvaccinated is a cautionary tale, but there are those who will still not learn from it. This means that India needs to start planning for the next phase of its vaccine drive, which could (and should) start mid-October. Ideally, this needs to have two legs.

The first will have to be vaccines for around 165 million people between the ages of 12 and 18; the ZyCoV-D, which is thus far the only one approved for use in this age group, should be reserved exclusively for people in this age group, with jabs being prioritised for the most vulnerable and also for those in Classes X and XII. There is simply nothing to be achieved by making this vaccine another in India's portfolio of vaccines being administered to those over the age of 18. That battle is won (or is in the process of being won).

Dilip Ghosh Threatens Strict Action Against two BJP MLAs Who Rejoined TM

New Delhi : Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) chief in West Bengal Dilip Ghosh on Wednesday threatened that he would take strict action against the defectors. This comes a day after two BJP legislators joined the Trinamool Congress on two consecutive days. Tanmoy Ghosh and Biswajit Das rejoined TMC on Monday and Tuesday, respectively. However, their move has left Ghosh fuming. Three party MLAs have returned to TMC in as many months.



"They were not BJP leaders. They won by getting party tickets. Action will be taken against them under the anti-defection law. If necessary, we will approach the court as well," Ghosh said after the dual setback. BJP won 77 of the 292 seats in the West Bengal assembly elections held earlier this year. While two of its MLAs resigned to retain their Parliament membership, three legislators have left the party. MLA Mukul Roy, who had switched to BJP from TMC in 2017, also returned to his old party in June this year. BJP's tally in the West Bengal Assembly is now 72.

BJP's Suwendu Adhikari, who is the Leader of Opposition in the state, has written letters to Tanmoy Ghosh and Biswajit Das after their defection. The letters contain newspaper cuttings of both of

them joining TMC. The opposition party is planning to use the anti-defection law against Tanmoy and Biswajit. In June, Adhikari had written to Assembly Speaker Biman Banerjee seeking dismissal of Mukul Roy from his MLA post after he returned to TMC.

Tanmoy Ghosh rejoined TMC on Monday in the presence of West Bengal Education Minister Bratya Basu. He had left the party in March, just days ahead of the assembly elections. Biswajit Das followed suit and came back to TMC the next day. He rejoined the party along with BJP councillor Manotosh Nath. A two-time MLA, Biswajit, had switched to BJP in 2019.
