Sitharaman to Meet CMs to Push Infra Projects, Investments

Focus to be on state-level issues; FM to also meet heads of PSU banks & financial institutions

New Delhi: Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman will meet chief ministers and state finance ministers to identify measures on Monday to facilitate investments and big infra and infrastructure projects to take the country to high growth trajectory, officials said on Friday.

The transaction will seek to create a policy discourse and a facilitative environment to attract investment and growth.

Sitharaman will also meet heads of public sector banks and financial institutions to review credit flow to various departments and industries. Action points emerging from these discussions will then be presented to Prime Minister Narendra Modi on the second day of the meeting beginning November 17.

Briefing reporters on Friday about the meeting with chief ministers, finance secretary T V Srinivasan said the meeting comes in the backdrop of strong economic recovery after two Covid waves and the big push by the Centre to boost capital expenditure.

"The focus of this interaction will be on state-level issues, opportunities and challenges, which will enable us to go to a higher trajectory of investment and growth," he said.

SMEs will share their ideas and vision for making the investment climate more leading to broad consensus regarding the trajectory to be undertaken for India to become the fastest growing economy, Srinivasan said.

"There is capital expenditure from the government side and there is a positive sentiment from the private sector side, though perhaps not fully channelised into actual investment in big scale," he said, adding that this positive sentiment needs to be capitalised in order to take India forward to a high growth trajectory. Growth engines "is an opportunity - an opportunity that we should not miss."

The finance secretary said global political developments are impacting India's economic growth. In relative terms, a more advanced, stable, diversified investment both domestic and foreign.

"The purpose is to use this present juncture not only to drive growth through capital expenditure but also to share along, hence, the focus of the meeting would be the economic impulsion of the states and not on state revenues."

"To take India to higher growth, certain actions need to be taken by the private sector and some policy actions by the government, Srinivasan said.

While some of these policy actions are in the domain of the central government, several others are in state's domain, he said.

Sitharaman will also meet heads of public sector banks and financial institutions to review credit flow to various departments and industries. Action points emerging from these discussions will then be presented to Prime Minister Narendra Modi on the second day of the meeting beginning November 17.

Worries spiral as admissions delayed

Civic officials attribute the disrupted schedule to the pandemic

It's almost the end of the year and RTE (Right to education) admissions are now being conducted in Maharashtra. The delay of four months has made matters worse for parents and children seeking admissions in RTE schools.

In the Mumbai region, the total number of schools under RTE is 352. While 4,985 students were selected, only 3,106 were admitted and 233 students were rejected in the first round of selection. It turns out that 1,646 students, however, didn't seek admission. In selection round 2, 1,198 students were selected, from which only 463 were admitted and 32 rejected. A total of 720 students didn't seek admission. Out of 410 total seats in the third round (second waiting list), only 17 have been selected and more students can be admitted as the last date is November 20. The schools have been asked to complete all pending work as soon as possible, as no extension is expected this time.

An official from the administration department of BMC

schools attributed the disrupted schedule to the pandemic. The official said, "The last year's admissions were late, affecting this year's admission. Another reason is that when the first selection round was held many parents were out of town and could not admit their children."

With the second waiting list round starting, many schools are trying to fill the vacancies. The official pointed out that there may only be two waiting lists. He said the next year's RTE admissions will probably start in December itself.

Mohsin Haider, a former corporator who now conducts RTE awareness programmes for economically backward sections of society, said students have been badly affected by the delay. He added that if the seats are vacant at the entry time, they stay vacant till the end. "The

remaining seats should be filled with RTE students only, so it is utilised in the best way," he said.

Free Press Journal spoke to a person who helps parents fill out the forms. He said, "It is so difficult for backward sections to fill the form and they get easily rejected by schools. They are not even allowed to enter the schools sometimes."

Parents, meanwhile, have been hoping their wards' names will appear in the next waiting list. One of the parents said he has visited the school many times but was always asked to come back the next day. "I don't know what to do. My child has been sitting idle for the last few months in the hope of admission," said another parent, who did not wish to be named. Most parents spoke on the condition of anonymity as they are scared it may cost their child's future.

However, BMC education officials said if schools give any trouble related to verification, parents can approach the verification office, and address is provided on every allotment letter or admit card.



Another major fire in Mankhurd

15 godowns affected, no casualties reported

The scrap warehouse at Mankhurd's Mandala area near Kurla was once again engulfed in flames on Friday. The major blaze (Level 3) that broke out at around 3.12 am on Friday affected 15 other godowns next to it, no casualties were reported, officials said.

It took five hours of long fire fighting by the Mumbai Fire brigade personnel to control and extinguish the fire. The fire brigade pressed 13 fire engines and 12 water tankers to the spot, according to information from the Mumbai fire brigade. Assistant Commissioner of the M/East ward, Mahendra Ubale, who was at the site said, "Over

15 other structures (all godowns) have been affected by the fire as it spread quickly. The land is owned by the collector and leased to those who are operating the godown. The cause of the fire has not been ascertained yet." Meanwhile, the police have also registered a case suspecting arson and are investigating further. This is not the first arson case in godowns in the Mandala area. There are fire incidents almost every year. There are various scrap godowns including textiles, wood, plastics, and chemicals, etc. These are all combustible materials and hence fire spreads quickly officials said. "Luckily, there is no residential settlement nearby, otherwise the risk casualties would have increased," an official said.

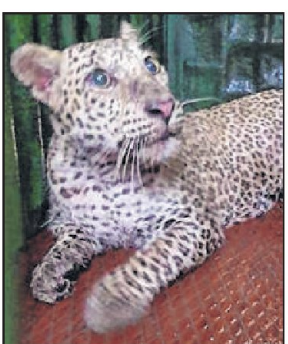
Students of Vasantrao Naik Government Medical College and Hospital in Maharashtra's Yavatmal continued their strike for the second consecutive day on Friday, demanding a fast-track court hearing and financial assistance to the family of a final-year student who was allegedly murdered on campus.

Two suspects were taken into custody by the police, while the incident prompted other students and resident doctors at the government hospital to go on a strike on Thursday.

The Maharashtra Forest Department on Friday informed that it has radio-collared a female leopard C33 and released it back into the wild on Tuesday. C33, aged around two years, was the first to get trapped in the cage set up to capture the problem leopard C32 at Aarey Milk Colony.

The female leopard C33 is the sibling of leopard C32 which was responsible for the recent spate of human-animal conflicts in Aarey Milk Colony in which nine people have been injured in the past two months.

C33 was radio-collared in collaboration with Wildlife conservation society (WCS)-India under the project where five leopards were to be radio-collared for getting a much better and detailed understanding of movements of leopards and how they use the landscape in and around SGNP.

The officials of Sanjay Gandhi National Park (SGNP) and the forest department have teamed up with a group of wildlife biologists. They have already radio-collared two leopards earlier this year and named them as Savitri (on Savitri bai Phule) and Chhatrapati (on Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj). C33 is the third leopard to be radio-collared under this project and will throw more light on her movements. The forest department is also contemplating officially naming her. Besides this in an event of a leopard attack in Aarey in the future, whether C33 was near the spot at the time of the attack will be tracked through radio collar, making it easier for the officials to zero down on the problem leopard, Forest Department officials said.
