Opinion

We have audited the accompanying statement of quarterly and year to date standalone financial results of STEEL STRIPS INFRASTRUCTURES LIMITED (the "Company") for the quarter ended March 31, 2024 and for the year ended March 31, 2024 ("Statement"), attached herewith, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirements of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended (the "Listing Regulations").

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the Statement:

- i) is presented in accordance with the requirements of the Listing Regulations in this regard; and
- ii) gives a true and fair view in conformity with the applicable Indian accounting standards and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, of the net Loss and total comprehensive loss and other financial information of the Company for the quarter ended March 31, 2024 and of the net loss and total comprehensive loss and other financial information of the Company for the year ended March 31, 2024.

Basis for Opinion
