In the event of settlement of the proceedings, details of such settlement including terms of the settlement, compensation/ penalty paid (if any) and impact of such settlement on the financial position of the listed entity. Both the parties have agreed to settle the litigation and the Company has paid ₹ 450.0 million to settle the litigation. The necessary order disposing of the matter has been passed by the NCDRC, New Delhi.
