Board Games Win Big in Fight Against Boredom

Kolkata | New Delhi: Here is one non-essential segment which is seeing sales booming at higher levels than pre-Covid lockdown days. Indians are rediscovering games like ludo, carrom, business and scrabble, with all-time high sales of these board games in retail chains and e-commerce market-places, as well as gaming app downloads.

Big Bazaar, Snapdeal and Paytm Mall said they reported highest ever sales of board game sales since non-essentials were allowed in certain markets earlier this month, while ludo and carrom app downloads are topping the charts with Indians installing highest number of gaming apps during lockdown as per tracker App Annie.

Paytm Mall senior vice president Srinivas Mothey said families spending quality time together at home has boosted the demand. "With more red zones turning orange and green, the demand is set to rise further," he said.

Hyper market chain Big Bazaar has sold out its stock of board games in the 25-odd stores it is operational right now. It sold over 20,000 units of ludo and another 3,000 units of carrom boards. An Amazon India spokesperson said apart from board games, games like chess, Smartivity, Minecraft and Lego also reported surge in orders. Snapdeal said the surge in demand for board games started days before the lockdown with sales tripling between March 15-25. India went into the lockdown from March 25. And in the first week of May, the category orders exceeded the pre-lockdown surge by 2.5 times. When government barred non-essential sales due to lockdown, there was a surge in download of gaming apps. As per App Annie data from March 25 till May 3, download of games peaked at 197 million during the April 12-18 week when the lockdown was extended, up 75% from the weekly average in Q4 2019. This is as compared to 30% surge in downloads of non-gaming apps.

Of these, Ludo King and Carrom Pool topped the charts in India ahead of global favourites like Save The Girl and

PUBG Mobile, as per App Annie.

Ludo King studio Gametion Technologies founder Vikash Jaiswal said the number of daily users has increased from 13 million to 50 million during the lockdown.
