This is further to our disclosure dated 28th April 2024, intimation is hereby given under Regulation 30 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, that the Company has received a judgement from Hon'ble Delhi High Court (HC) wherein the HC has quashed and set aside the demand order issued u/s 73 proposing total demand of ₹ 1.81 Crs. (including interest) in the name of Digilife Distribution and Marketing Services Limited (Presently merged with the Company) on account of the following:

- (a) Mismatch in turnover declared in GSTR-1 as compared to turnover declared in GSTR-9;
- (b) Mismatch in input tax credit availed in returns as compared to input tax credit auto-populated on GST portal.
