Ukraine says 9 Russian warplanes destroyed in Crimea blasts

Russian authorities sought to downplay the blasts, saying all hotels and beaches were unaffected on peninsula, which is a popular tourist destination

KYIV (Ukraine): Ukraine's air force said Wednesday that nine Russian warplanes were destroyed in massive explosions at an air base in Crimea amid speculation they were the result of a Ukrainian attack that would represent a significant escalation in the war.

Russia denied any aircraft were damaged in Tuesday's blasts or that any attack took place.

Ukrainian officials have stopped short of publicly claiming responsibility for the explosions, while poking fun at Russia's explanation that munitions at the Saki air base caught fire and blew up and also underscoring the importance of the peninsula that Moscow annexed eight years ago.

In his nightly video address several hours after the blasts, Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy vowed to retake the peninsula, saying that this Russian war against Ukraine and against all of free Europe began with Crimea and must end with Crimea's liberation. On Wednesday, Russian authorities sought to downplay the blasts, saying all hotels and beaches were unaffected on the peninsula, which is a popular tourist destination for many Russians. The explosions, which killed one person and wounded 13, sent tourists flee-



ing in panic as plumes of smoke towered over the nearby coastline. They knocked out windows and caused other damage in some apartment buildings.

Russian warplanes have used Saki to strike areas in Ukraine's south on short notice, and Ukrainian social networks were abuzz with speculation that Ukrainian-fired long-range missiles hit the base.

Officials in Moscow have long warned Ukraine that an attack on Crimea would trigger massive retaliation, including strikes on decision-making centers in Kyiv.

A Ukrainian presidential adviser, Oleksiy Arestovych, who is more outspoken than other officials, cryptically said Tuesday that the blasts were caused either by a Ukrainian-made long-range weapon or were the work of guerrillas operating in Crimea.

The base on the Black Sea peninsula that dangles off southern Ukraine is at least 200 kilometers (some 125 miles) away from the closest Ukrainian position out of the range of the missiles supplied by the U.S. for use in the HIMARS systems.

The Ukrainian military has successfully used those missiles, with a range of 80 kilometers (50 miles), to target ammunition and fuel depots, strategic bridges and other key targets in Russia-occupied territories. HIMARS could also fire longer-range rockets, with a range of up to 300 kilometers (about 185 miles), that Ukraine has asked for.

But U.S. authorities have refrained from providing them thus far, fearing that it could provoke Russia and widen the conflict. But the explosions in Saki raised speculation on

social media that Ukraine might have finally got the weapons.

Ukrainian military analyst Oleh Zhdanov said that the Ukrainian forces could have struck the Russian air base with a Ukrainian Neptune anti-air missile that has a range of about 200 kilometers (about 125 miles) and could have been adapted for use against ground targets and could be fired from Ukrainian positions near Mykolaiv northwest of Crimea.

The Ukrainian military also might have used Western-supplied Harpoon anti-air missiles that can also be used against ground targets and have a range of about 300 kilometers (about 185 miles), he said. AGENCIES

Trump refuses to answer questions in NY attorney general probe

NEW YORK: Former US President Donald Trump said on Wednesday he refused to answer questions during an appearance before New York state's attorney general in a civil investigation into his family's business practices, citing his constitutional right against self-incrimination.

Trump, his son Donald Trump Jr. and daughter Ivanka Trump, had fought unsuccessfully to avoid appearing for testimony in state Attorney General Letitia James's probe into whether the Trump Organization inflated real estate values to obtain favorable loans and understated asset values to get tax breaks. "I declined to answer the questions under the rights and privileges afforded to every citizen under the United States Constitution," Trump said in a statement issued roughly an hour after he arrived in a motorcade to the attorney general's office in lower Manhattan.

The Constitution's Fifth Amendment protects against self-incrimination. Trump's decision not to answer questions still could carry consequences. Should the investigation lead to a trial, jurors could take his silence into account. Politically, it also could give adversaries ammunition about whether Trump has something to hide as he mulls another run for the presidency in 2024.

James has said her investigation has uncovered significant evidence that the Trump Organization, which manages hotels, golf courses and other real estate, gave banks and tax authorities misleading financial information to obtain benefits. Trump, a Republican, in his

statement again denied wrongdoing and sought to portray the investigation by James, a Democrat, as part of a years-long vendetta against him by her and others including the news media. "I once asked, 'If you're innocent, why are you taking the Fifth Amendment?'" Trump said in his statement. "Now I know the answer to that question."

Trump added, "When your family, your company, and all the people in your orbit have become the targets of an unfounded, politically moti-

ated Witch Hunt supported by lawyers, prosecutors, and the Fake News Media, you have no choice." In the statement, Trump also made disparaging comments about James and violent crime in New York state.

Trump attempted to link the state attorney general's investigation to Monday's FBI search of his Florida home Mar-a-Lago, which represented an escalation a federal probe into whether he illegally removed records from the White House as he left office in January 2021, Reuters reported.

Neither a spokeswoman for James nor a lawyer for Trump immediately responded to requests for comment.

Trump raised his fist as he left Trump Tower on Wednesday morning, wearing a blue suit with a flag pin on his lapel, before heading to the attorney general's office. New York City police officers and Secret Service personnel stood guard as the motorcade transporting Trump arrived. AGENCIES

China says it successfully completed military drills around Taiwan

BEIJING: China on Wednesday announced that it has successfully completed its high-voltage 10-day-long military drills around Taiwan in protest against the visit of US House Speaker Nancy Pelosi to Taipei.

The People's Liberation Army's (PLA) Eastern Theatre Command said the joint military operations around the Taiwan island have been completed successfully, the state-run Global Times newspaper tweeted.

The state-run Xinhua news agency quoted Senior Colonel Shi Yi, the spokesman for the Eastern Theatre Command, as saying that the Command recently organised a series of joint military operations in the seas and airspace around Tai-

wan island and successfully completed various tasks, effectively testing the military's integrated joint combat capability.

The PLA Theater Command will keep a close eye on the changing situation in the Taiwan Straits, carry out training and war preparation, regularly organise combat readiness police patrols across the Taiwan Straits, and resolutely safeguard national sovereignty and territorial integrity, Yi said. The drills involved forces drawn from all wings of the PLA in the busy Taiwan Strait virtually laying siege to the breakaway island which Beijing claims as part of its mainland, sparking global concerns of possible military assault by China to annex Taiwan. Yemen officials say fresh infighting kills 35 in south

SANAA (Yemen): Infighting among pro-government Yemeni forces has killed 35 troops in a southern province in the past 24 hours, officials said, a development that threatens a ceasefire in the country's wider conflict.

They say that an artillery duel that start in the late hours of Tuesday hit areas around a local airport in the city of Ataq, the capital of the southern Shabwa province.

Five civilians were among the dead, they added, speaking on condition of anonymity because they were not authorized to brief the media.

The fighting comes after months of tensions within the pro-government, Saudi-led coalition that has been fighting a common enemy the Houthi rebels since 2015.

Earlier violence late on Sunday erupted in the area after the province's governor, backed by the United Arab Emirates, decided to sack a police commander known to have an anti-UAE stance, the officials said. AGENCIES

Biden formalises US support for Finland, Sweden joining NATO

WASHINGTON DC: President Joe Biden formally welcomed Finland and Sweden joining the NATO alliance Tuesday as he signed the instruments of ratification that delivered the U.S.'s formal backing of the Nordic nations entering the mutual defense pact, part of a reshaping of the European security posture after Russia's invasion of Ukraine.

In seeking to join NATO, Finland and Sweden are making a sacred commitment that an attack against one is an attack against all," Biden said at the signing as he called the partnership the indispensable alliance.

The U.S. became the 23rd ally to approve NATO membership for the two countries. Biden said he spoke with the heads of both nations before signing the ratification and urged the remaining NATO members to finish their own ratification process as quickly

as possible. The Senate last week approved the two, once-nation-aligned nations joining the alliance in a rare 95-1 vote that Biden said shows the world that "the United States of America can still do big things with a sense of political unity. The countries sought out NATO membership earlier this year to guarantee their security in the wake of Russian Presi-

dent Vladimir Putin's offensive in Ukraine.

The North Atlantic Treaty Organization's rules require the consent of all of its 30 existing members before Finland and Sweden can officially accede into the alliance, which is expected in the coming months.

The candidacies of the two prosperous Northern European nations have won ratification from more than half of the NATO member nations in the roughly three months since the two applied.

It marks one of the speediest expansions of the pact of mutual defense among the United States and democratic allies in Europe in its 73-year history.

US State and Defense officials consider the two countries net security providers, strengthening NATO's defense posture in the Baltics in particular. AGENCIES

Russian oil shipments to central Europe expected to resume

BRATISLAVA (Slovakia): Oil shipments from Russia through a critical pipeline to several European countries should resume soon after a problem over payments for the transit was resolved, Slovakia's economy minister said on

Wednesday. Russian state pipeline operator Transneft said on Tuesday that it halted shipments through the southern branch of the Druzhba oil pipeline, which flows through Ukraine to the Czech Republic, Slo-

vakia, and Hungary. Transneft cited complications due to European Union sanctions for its action on August 4, saying its payment to the company's Ukrainian counterpart was refused. The Slovak minister, Rich-

ard Sulik, said the payments would be made on Wednesday by Slovak refiner Slovnaft after both the Russian and Ukrainian sides agreed to the solution. Slovnaft is owned by Hungary's MOL energy group.

I expect the oil shipments to resume in hours, Sulik said.

Slovakia receives practically all its oil through the Druzhba pipeline. Sulik said the payment is worth some 9.10 million euros (up to USD 10.2 million). AGENCIES

AMID WATER CRISIS

Britain braced for another heatwave

LONDON: The UK's Meteorological (Met) Office on Wednesday issued a four-day amber extreme heat warning as the country braces for another heatwave this week following the record high temperatures of last month and a looming water crisis.

The Met Office warning covers much of the southern half of England as well as parts of eastern Wales, and will be in force from Thursday through until the end of Sunday with impacts possible to health, transport and infrastructure.



Temperatures are likely to rise into the low-to-mid 30s Celsius for those within the warning area but not expected to be as extreme as those experienced in July when new national records were set.

Thanks to persistent high pressure over the UK, temperatures will be rising day-on-day through this week and an extreme heat warning has been issued, said Dan Rudman, Met Office Deputy Chief Meteorologist.

Temperatures are expected to peak at 35C on Friday and Saturday, or even an isolated 36C on Saturday. Elsewhere will see temperatures widely into the high 20s and low 30s Celsius. Coupled with the high daytime temperatures there will be some warm nights, with temperatures expected not to drop below the low 20s Celsius for some areas in the south, he said.

Temperatures in this week's heatwave are unlikely to hit the 40 degrees Celsius peak of July

but the extreme heat is expected to last over a longer period. The UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA) emphasised it was important vulnerable people, like the elderly who live alone or anyone with underlying health conditions, were "prepared for coping during the hot weather".

"The most important advice is to ensure they stay hydrated, keep cool and take steps to prevent their homes from overheating," said Dr Agostinho Sousa.

One of the UK's largest water suppliers is considering temporarily limiting water use amid fears of water shortage. "Given the long term forecast of dry weather and another forecast of very hot temperatures coming this week we are planning to announce a temporary use ban in the coming weeks," Thames Water said.

England is experiencing drought-like conditions with its driest July since 1935, according to the Met Office. AGENCIES
