CONCERNS OVER CLASSES 10, 12 RESULTS

GSHSEB awaits EC's reply to hold key meet on copying cases

MORE THAN 10 days after approaching the Election Commission to hold a key meeting to decide on the copying cases in exams for classes 10 and 12, the Gujarat Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Board (GSHSEB) has said it is still awaiting a response.

Amid the delay, the Akhil Gujarat State School Management Mahamandal on Monday demanded a quick decision. The association of schools has expressed concern that the delay in meeting will have a bearing on the results. With the Model Code of Conduct (MCC) in place in view of the Lok Sabha elections, the GSHSEB earlier this month sought permission from the Election Commission to hold a meeting and decide upon the copying cases, GSHSEB Vice Chairman Dinesh Patel told *The Indian Express*.

In 2023, the state board had declared Class 12 results on May 2, followed by Class 10 results.

Officials revealed that the request was sent over 10 days back and the response is still awaited.

The board is likely to either keep results of such candidates reserved or on hold or delay the results.

Clarity is needed if the election body's permission is needed to hold the key meeting, which is business as usual, and if it falls under the MCC ambit, said GSHSEB member Priyavadan Korat. "With the work of the examination committee pending, there are several issues...like the fate of a larger number of candidates who are suspects hangs in balance. With this, there will be a delay in the supplementary examination process," Korat told this paper. The board's Examination Committee conducts physical hearings of suspected candidates, and their parents along with the examination building in-charge.

Following this, based on the Committee's decision, the candidate's result is declared. The hearing may take two-three weeks depending upon the cases. These copying cases are those detected by the flying squads, caught on CCTVs of examination centres, and detected during assessment of answer sheets, for instance, mass copying.

FIRING OUTSIDE SALMAN KHAN'S HOUSE

Mumbai cops launch search op in Surat, recover firearm from Tapi

A 12-MEMBER team of the Mumbai Crime Branch Monday recovered a firearm – allegedly used for firing outside Salman Khan's home earlier this month – from Tapi river in Surat amid an extensive search operation, said officials. The search is set to continue on Tuesday to recover another firearm which was carried by the accused.

Senior police inspector Daya Nayak also travelled to Surat for the search operation. Apart from police officers from Surat, local divers and fishermen helped the team in the operation.

Vicky Gupta (24) and Sagar Pal (21), the two accused who were arrested last week from a temple in Bhuj for allegedly firing outside the Bollywood actor's house at the Galaxy Apartment in Bandra area of Mumbai, carried two weapons to commit the crime, said officials.

According to police officials, the search operation was initiated after Gupta and Pal said that they disposed of the weapons in the river while escaping to Bhuj. "We have learnt in their interrogation

that Gupta and Pal, both were carrying weapons. But as we can see in the video, only Pal used the weapon that was given to him and fired at Khan's residence after which they escaped," a Mumbai Police officer said.

The officer said that both shooters were instructed to open fire at Khan's residence; however, only one of them managed to open fire. The incident took place in the early hours on April 14. The two accused claimed that they boarded a Bhuj-bound train and

while passing the river, they threw the two weapons from the train.

On Monday, a Surat police officer said the search operation began at 9 am, and one of the two firearms was recovered in the afternoon.

In the firing incident, as per the preliminary investigation, officials in Mumbai have learnt that the accused allegedly committed the crime on the instruction of gangsters Lawrence Bishnoi and his younger brother Anmol. The

two brothers have been named as "wanted accused" in the case. "It appears that they wanted to scare the actor and create a terror in the environment that would have helped them in extorting money at least from others," an officer said.

The Mumbai Crime Branch will soon take custody of Lawrence Bishnoi for questioning. "We are collecting evidence for now and as soon as we have sufficient evidence, we will seek his custody," an officer added. Bishnoi is currently lodged in Sabarmati Central Jail in Gujarat while Anmol is believed to be either in the United States or Portugal.

LAND ALLOTMENT CASE

SC seeks state govt's response on bail plea of former IAS officer Pradeep Sharma

THE SUPREME COURT on Monday sought the Gujarat government's response on a bail plea of retired IAS officer Pradeep Sharma in a case of alleged illegal allotment of government land for monetary benefit during his tenure as the Kutch district collector.

A bench of Justice Abhay S Oka and Justice Ujjal Bhuyan issued a notice to the state government and sought its response in four weeks.

Senior advocate Devadatt Kamat, appearing for Sharma, said, "I am the usual whipping boy of the state, who is seeking relief in the matter." The bench said, "Alright, we are issuing the notice." Sharma has challenged the March 20 order of the Gujarat High Court rejecting his bail plea in the case.

The high court had observed that it was not inclined to favour the applicant-accused (Sharma) given the fact that there have been several FIRs registered against him in similar offences "while sitting over the highest post of the government".

Meanwhile, in another appeal of Sharma against the January 31 order of the high court rejecting his plea seeking preliminary inquiry before registration of FIR in the land allotment case, the apex court bench asked the state government to file its response.

Kamat said that on March 11, the court had issued a notice in the appeal and they had expressed apprehension that an FIR would be registered against him in the case. "It happened exactly that way. An FIR was registered and he was arrested in a fresh case," Kamat said.

Solicitor General Tushar Mehta, appearing for the state government, said it is a serious matter and some time be granted to him to file a response to the plea.

The bench then allowed the state government to file its response in the second matter of Sharma, which challenged the January 31 decision of the high court. Multiple FIRs have been lodged against Sharma in cases of illegal allotment of land.

Currently, Sharma is in judicial custody in connection with the land allotment case which was filed by CID Crime at Bhuj in Kutch district in September last year.

It was alleged that Sharma, as collector of Kutch district between May 2003 and June 2006, committed illegalities while granting non-agriculture permission for a parcel of land in Bhuj city in connivance with co-accused to get undue monetary benefits.

Central University set to change logo for 3rd time

THE CENTRAL University of Gujarat in Gandhinagar is set to change its university logo. The logo, which will be changed for the third time since the inception of the varsity in 2009, will 'represent' Gujarat and the university, the authorities said.

The Academic Council approved the new logo on Friday. Om Prakash Pandey, a council member, said that the decision to change it was taken because the current logo had no representation of the varsity or Gujarat.

The new logo, which is yet to be approved by the Executive Council, has been inspired from 'Om', a conch and Gir cow head that represent women power, Dwardkadeesh and Gujarat re-

spectively, Pandey said. He added that the logo will also have a state map embedded.

The earlier transitions the university went through were in 2013 and 2014. Amid objections

to the use of Ashoka Chakra in the logo approved by the Executive Council in 2010, it was changed in 2013.

A year later, this was partially modified into the current logo to

include the name of the university in Hindi and English.

The university was established by parliament in 2009 through the Central Universities Act, as per its website.
