
The mode of voting was e-voting. The details of voting are provided in the Annexure enclosed herewith.

### RE: REPORT ON SCRUTINIZER

I, Nilesh A. Pradhan, Partner of M/s Nilesh A. Pradhan & Co., LLP, Company Secretaries, have been appointed as the scrutinizer by the Board of Directors of Accelya Solutions India Limited at their meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> May, 2021 for scrutinizing the remote electronic voting process ("**remote e-voting**") in a fair and transparent manner, for the purpose of ascertaining the requisite majority for the passing of special resolution for Approval of payment of remuneration to Ms. Neela Bhattacharjee in excess of 5% of the net profits of the Company pursuant to the Notice dated 20<sup>th</sup> May, 2021 issued under Section 110 and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013 (the "Act") (including any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof for the time being in force) read with Rule 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 ("Rules"), as amended from time to time, read with the General Circular Nos. 14/2020 dated April 8, 2020, 17/2020 dated April 13, 2020, 22/2020 dated June 15, 2020 and 39/2020 dated December 31, 2020 in relation to "Clarification on passing of ordinary and special resolutions by companies under the Companies Act, 2013 and the rules made thereunder on account of the threat posed by Covid-19" issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Government of India (the "MCA Circulars") and pursuant to other applicable laws and regulations, the Company is sending the Postal Ballot Notice in electronic form only. In compliance with regulation 44 of the Listing Regulations and pursuant to the provisions of sections 108 and 110 of the Act read with the Rules framed thereunder and the MCA Circulars, the Company has extended only the remote e-voting facility for its Members to enable them to cast their votes electronically.

The Notice dated 20<sup>th</sup> May,2021 along with statement setting out material facts under Section 102 of the Act in respect of the above mentioned resolution, as confirmed by the Company, was sent via email only to the Members whose names appeared in the Register of Members/List of Beneficial Owners as received from National Securities Depository Limited ("NSDL") and Central Depository Services (India) Limited ("CDSL") and whose e-mail addresses were available with the Company as on Friday,14<sup>th</sup> May,2021 ("Cut-off Date").

The Company has availed the e-voting facility offered by KFin Technologies Private Limited ("KFintech") for conducting remote e-voting by the shareholders of the Company.

The shareholders of the company holding shares as on "cut-off date" i.e.14<sup>th</sup> May,2021 were entitled to vote on resolution.

The e-voting period remained open from Saturday, 22<sup>nd</sup> May,2021 at 9:00 a.m. to Sunday,20<sup>th</sup> June,2021 at 5:00 p.m. and platform provided by "KFintech" was blocked thereafter and the votes cast under remote e-voting facility were then unblocked in the presence of two witness who were not in the employment of the Company.

I have scrutinized and reviewed the remote e-voting process and based on the data downloaded from the e-voting platform provided by "KFintech".

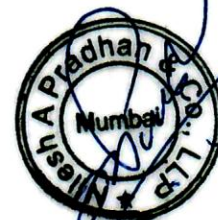
