ARBUDA SENA GATHERING

Chaudhary community says Vipul will decide which party to support

IN A show of strength before the assembly elections in Gujarat, nearly two lakh Anjana Chaudhary community members gathered at Charada village in Gandhinagar and pledged support to Vipul Chaudhary, former home minister and former chairman of Dudhsagar Dairy, who is currently in jail.

The influential community, which has a significant presence in over 30 assembly seats in North Gujarat, however, did not reveal their political allegiance for the upcoming polls and decided to wait for Vipul to step out of prison later this month.

Vipul was arrested in September 2022 for alleged irregularities worth Rs 800 crore during his tenure as Dudhsagar Dairy chairman.

Around two lakh members of the community from 1,253 villages who are largely into farming and milk production gathered under the banner of Arbuda Sena, formed by Vipul a year ago. The occasion was the 103rd birth anniversary of Mansinh Chaudhary.

KEJRIWAL SKIPS ARBUDA SENA EVENT

Ahmedabad: Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) convener and Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal on Tuesday skipped a rally organised by Arbuda Sena, an outfit of supporters of Vipul Chaudhary.

The AAP had earlier said Kejriwal would address the rally at Charada village in Gandhinagar district of poll-bound Gujarat but he did not turn up.

There were speculations that an announcement will be made of Vipul Chaudhary joining the AAP and supporting the party at the rally. PTI

but we will all follow his decision," said Moghji Chaudhary, a close aide of Vipul Chaudhary and a former chairman of Dudhsagar Dairy in the adjoining Mehsana district.

"He has not instructed us that he will fight polls. He is our chief and whatever decision is made by him, we will stand by it," said Moghijibhai adding that the community would like him to contest and represent them in the legislature.

"We are expecting that Vipulbhai will step out of jail on November 21," he said after the event concluded.

When asked why some speakers were not allowed to make political comments from the stage, Moghji said, "It was a social event to celebrate the birth anniversary of Mansinh Chaudhary. It was not a political platform and so if someone says anything that would be inappropriate. We have been operating this organisation for last two months in the absence of Vipul Chaudhary, and so it is our responsibility to see that nothing goes wrong."

Speaking at the event where a garlanded white turban was placed on a seat kept reserved for

Vipul Chaudhary at the centre of the dais, Moghji said, "Many people even tried to see that this gathering does not happen. I am confident that our lion (Vipul Chaudhary) will come out of (prison). Someone with a party's mandate is not our leader." He, however, did not name any party.

The Dudhsagar Dairy is being ruled by members associated with the BJP and in the past both Vipul Chaudhary and Moghji Chaudhary have agitated against the present leadership in the dairy, which is one of the largest in the country. After Vipul's arrest, the Congress rallied behind the former party member (Vipul had quit Congress in September 2007) and organised an event in his support at "Ma Arbuda Bhavan" campus in Mehsana in October 2022.

Leaders of Arbuda Sena from Banskantha, Patan, Sabarkantha, Mehsana and Gandhinagar also spoke at the event Tuesday and asked the community to stand united behind Vipul. "The Sena was not formed for politics. But with elections round the corner, the community cannot stay away from politics," said Shankar Chaudhary from Patan.

Bridge collapse highlighted cronyism in Gujarat: Cong

THE CONGRESS on Tuesday alleged that the Morbi bridge collapse incident highlighted the cronyism being perpetuated in Gujarat, alleging that the model of development being followed in the state was of "extreme failure".

The Opposition party alleged that the Gujarat model of development is "corrupted, distorted and concocted".

"The model is that you benefit a few industrialists and leave behind the rest and that leads to a lot of social and economic disparities," Congress spokesperson Anshul Avijit said at a press conference at the AICC headquarters here. Gujarat today is characterised by gross mismanagement and corruption, he alleged.

The Morbi incident highlighted something which was a degraded form of cronyism in which precedence was given to sheer profiteering; everything else was compromised and people's lives were sacrificed, he alleged.

"We want to ask the basic question, where is the SIT report regarding that terrible tragedy. The High Court of Gujarat took suo motu cognizance of the matter and asked the SIT to submit its report by November 14 but it has not done so far," Avijit said.

He alleged that the SIT in Gujarat is a complete eyewash when it comes to any investigation.

"There have been SITs which have been instituted for a number of cases there, they haven't reached any conclusion. This is the story of Gujarat and the Morbi tragedy highlighted that story of cronyism that a watchmaker is given an engineering contract," he added.

2 accused in Una flogging case booked for threatening victims

TWO ACCUSED in the Una flogging case have been booked for allegedly threatening to kill the Dalit victims if they did not arrive at a compromise in the case.

An FIR was lodged at the Una police station on a complaint filed by Vashram Sarvaiya who was one of the victims of the flogging and his father Balubhai against the two accused in the case Pramodgiri Goswami, Balwant Goswami and one unidentified person.

The accused have been booked under IPC sections 506 (criminal intimidation) and section 114 (abettor present when offence is committed) apart from sections of the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe (Prevention of Atrocities) Act 1989.

In his complaint, Vashram said that he and his cousin Ashok who was also among those publicly flogged by the accused in 2016, were traveling on a bike in Una town when Pramod and Balwant, along with an unidentified person intercepted them.

The three accused threatened them to arrive at a compromise, or kill them, and hurled casteist abuses at them, Vashram.

The FIR mentions that the accused also told the Sarvaiyas "to remember how they had been beaten before".

In July 2016, Vashram, his brother Ramesh and their cousins Bechar and Ashok were publicly stripped, tied to a four-wheeler vehicle, and flogged by a group of self-styled "gau rakshaks" for allegedly skinning the carcass of a

cow. Since then, the Sarvaiyas have given up skinning animal carcasses, taken to Buddhism, and are making a living out of farming and Manaki.

In July, the Gujarat High Court granted bail to the four key accused — Ramesh Jadav, Pramodgiri Goswami, Balwantgir Goswami and Rakesh Joshi — among 41 accused in the case. The bail was granted with restrictions on the four accused from entering Gir Somnath district except to attend the court.

Judge recuses from hearing Teesta bail plea, Sreekumar's bail extended

Ahmedabad: The court of Justice Samir Dave of Gujarat High Court on Tuesday recused itself from hearing Mumbai-based activist Teesta Setalvad's bail application in a case related to the 2002 riots.

On Monday, the high court granted extension of interim bail to retired DGP RB Sreekumar, by a period of 10 days. He was granted interim bail until November 15 through an order dated September 28.

Both Setalvad and Sreekumar are facing charges of allegedly fabricating evidence linked to the 2002 riots, with

Setalvad being granted interim bail by the Supreme Court until the Gujarat HC disposes of her regular bail plea.

Sreekumar had filed for regular bail before the Ahmedabad city sessions court, where the final verdict is reserved.

Sreekumar submitted before the court that he has not misused his liberty and considering his age, he may be either enlarged on interim bail for a period of three weeks or order may be passed by extending the earlier order.

The court of Justice Ilesh Vora took into consideration the two factors while granting the extension. ENS
